Docking: World Cruise Center, San Pedro (Berths 92-93); all ships dock pier-side

Don't Miss: Battleship USS Iowa Museum — literally steps from the pier

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Battleship USS Iowa Museum** — The 'Battleship of Presidents' is moored a short walk from the cruise terminal.
- **Hollywood Walk of Fame & TCL Chinese Theatre** — The classic LA pilgrimage — celebrity handprints at TCL Chinese Theatre, the Walk of Fame, and the Hollywood Sign...
- **Santa Monica Beach & Pier** — Ride the famous Ferris wheel on the Santa Monica Pier, stroll the beach, and explore the Third Street Promenade.
- **Whale & Dolphin Watching Cruise** — Blue whales, humpbacks, fin whales, and dolphins frequent the waters off San Pedro.
- **Beverly Hills & Rodeo Drive** — Window-shop the world's most famous luxury street, cruise past celebrity mansions, and grab a photo at the Beverly...

BEST WALKS

- **San Pedro Waterfront Walk** 2 miles | Easy | 45-60 min — From the cruise terminal, walk along the waterfront past the USS Iowa, through the West Harbor development, and along the promenade to...
- **Point Fermin & Angels Gate Park** 1.5 miles | Easy | 45 min — Take the trolley or a short rideshare to Point Fermin Park for cliffside ocean views, the 1874 Point Fermin Lighthouse, and the Korean...

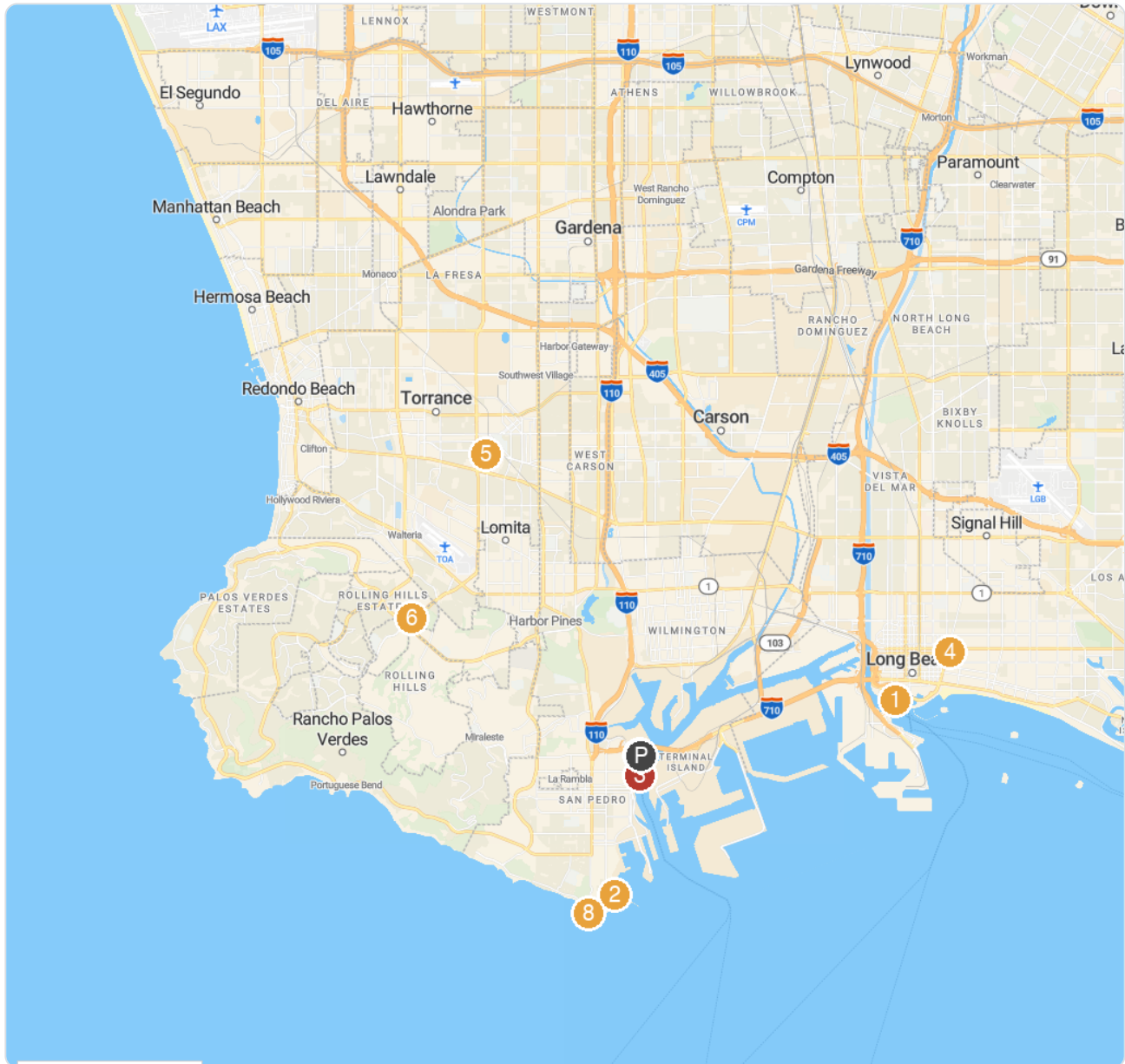
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Budget extra time for traffic. LA is notorious for gridlock. If your ship departs at 5 PM, aim to be back by 4 PM — add a full hour buffer if going to Hollywood or further.
- Start with the USS Iowa. It's steps from your ship and can absorb 2-3 hours easily — save it as your backup if tours run long, or

- 2** Cabrillo Marine Aquarium Small aquarium focused on Southern California marine life.
- 4** Museum of Latin American Art (MOLAA) Museum dedicated to modern and contemporary Latin American art.
- 6** South Coast Botanic Garden Beautiful botanical garden built on a former landfill.
- 8** Point Fermin Park Historic park with lighthouse and stunning ocean views.
