TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Gutenberg Museum (Interim Exhibition)** — The world's finest collection of early printing history, including two original 42-line Gutenberg Bibles.
- **Mainz Cathedral (Dom St. Martin)** — One of Germany's finest Romanesque cathedrals, built from 975 AD and rebuilt after fires into a unique mix of...
- **St. Stephen's Church & Chagall Windows** — This Gothic church is famed for nine stunning stained-glass windows designed by Marc Chagall in his twilight years...
- **Rhine Wine Tasting** — Mainz sits at the heart of the Rheinhessen wine region, Germany's largest.
- **Roman Mainz — Museum of Ancient Seafaring** — Mainz was the Roman fortress city of Mogontiacum.

BEST WALKS

- **Riverfront to Cathedral & Gutenberg Museum** 1.2 km | 15 min | Flat | Core sights — The essential Mainz stroll: from the Rhine embankment up through the old town to the Dom, then a short walk to the Gutenberg Museum...
- **Cathedral to Chagall Windows** 1.5 km round trip | 20 min | Flat | Art & architecture — From the Dom, walk southwest through the Altstadt lanes past Kirschgarten square to St.

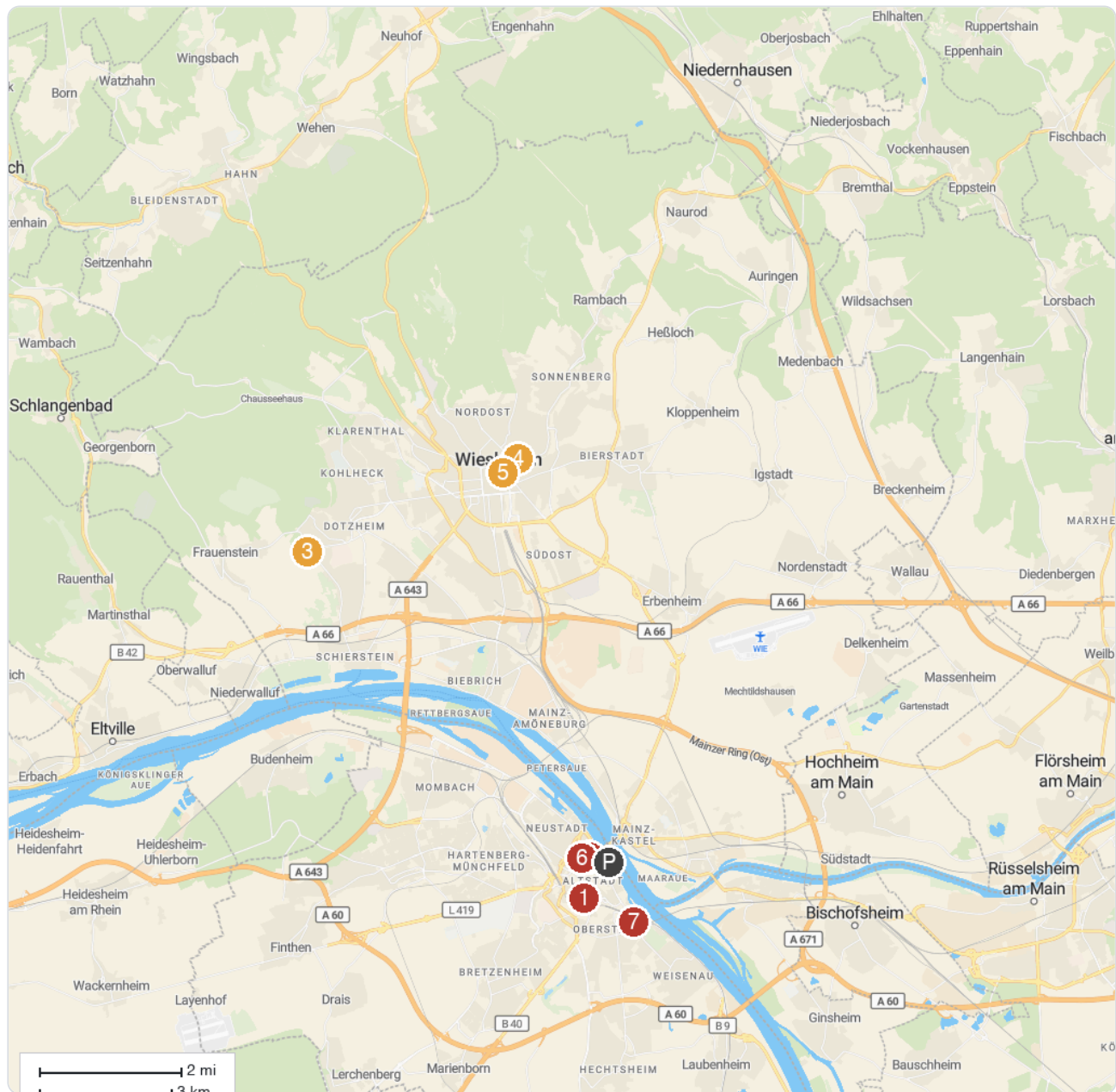
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Gutenberg Museum has moved. The main building is under renovation; visit the interim 'Gutenberg Museum MOVED' at the Natural History Museum, Reichklarastraße 1. Check current...
- You don't need a shuttle or taxi. The river pier is a flat 10–15 minute walk from the Cathedral and Marktplatz. Comfortable shoes on cobblestones are all you need.
