GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier at West Harbour (Västerhamn), Quay 1–2 — no tender

Walk to center: ~900 m (12–15 min) straight up Esplanaden

Best For: Maritime history, cycling, Nordic food, relaxed walks

Don't Miss: Boarding the 1903 four-masted barque Pommern, right at the pier

 Getting around:  Taxi  €6–15 ·  Rideshare  not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Pommern & Maritime Museum** — Board the fully preserved 1903 four-masted barque Pommern — the only windjammer of her kind left in original condition...
 - **Kastelholm Castle Day Trip** — A 14th-century medieval castle in the Sund municipality where Swedish kings stayed and Eric XIV was imprisoned.
 - **Cycling the Archipelago** — Rent bikes at the pier and pedal Mariehamn's flat peninsula — or take a ferry to a nearby
- island for quiet roads, apple...

 - **Maritime Quarter & East Harbour** — Stroll to Sjökvarteret for living wooden boatbuilding workshops, a blacksmith, a sailor's chapel, and craft shops — all...
 - **Åland Pancake & Local Flavors** — Try the iconic Ålandspannkaka (thick oven-baked pancake with stewed prunes and cream), cold-smoked salmon, local...

BEST WALKS

- **West to East Harbour via Esplanaden** 2.5 km round trip | 30–40 min | Easy — Walk straight up Esplanaden from the cruise pier under a canopy of linden trees, past the town square, St.
- **Lilla Holmen Beach Loop** 1 km | 15 min | Easy — From the East Harbour, cross the footbridge to Lilla Holmen — a small island with a sandy beach, pirate-ship playground, free-roaming...

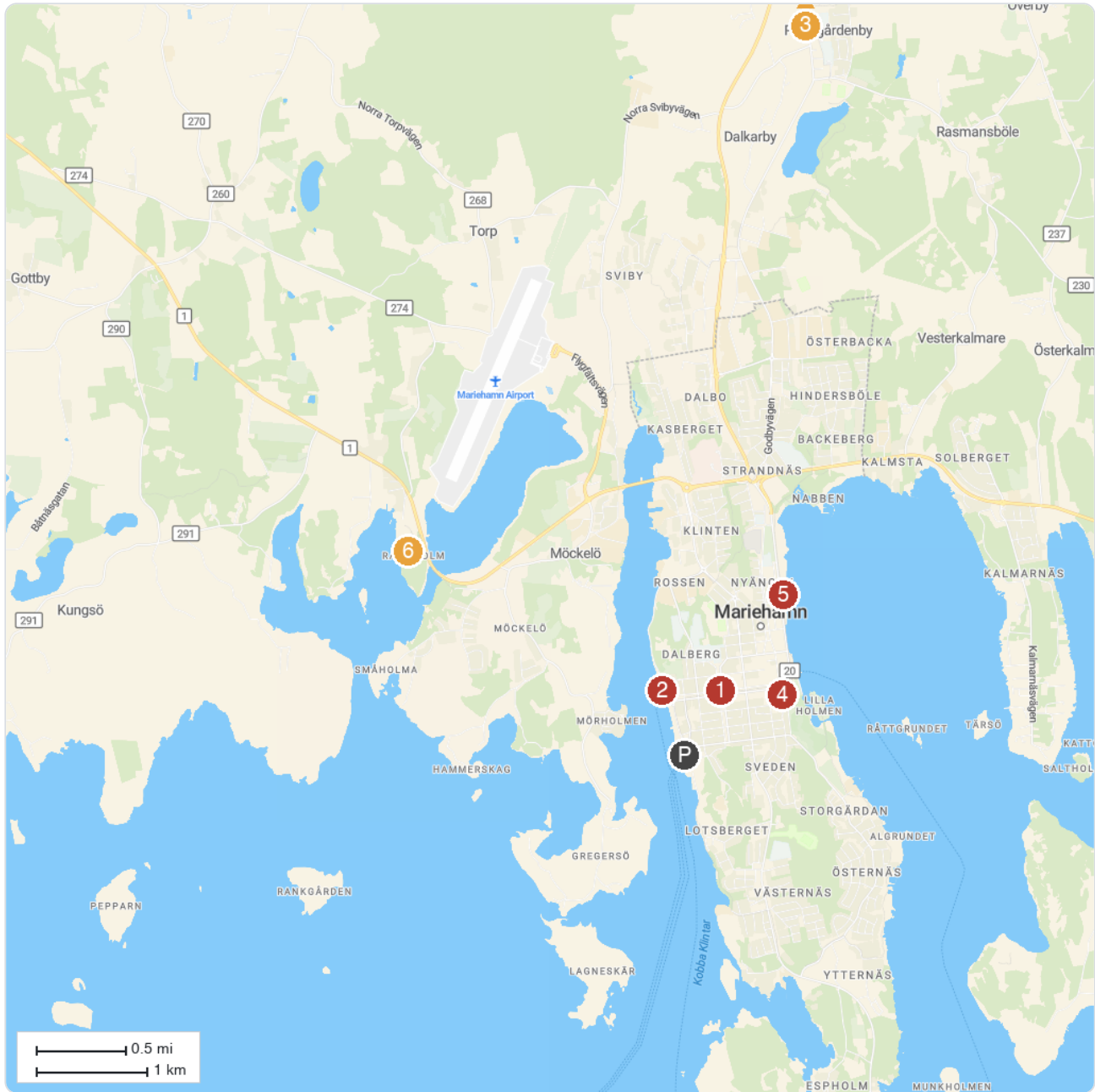
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
