GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Cruise Pier — ships dock at Marmaris Cruise Port on the eastern bay; no tender required

Best For: Bazaar shopping, castle views, Turkish hamam, Dalyan/Kaunos rock tombs day trip

Walk to centre: ~15–20 min (1.2 km) along Netsel Marina promenade to Old Town

Don't Miss: Marmaris Castle ramparts for panoramic harbour views

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Marmaris Castle & Archaeology Museum** — Rebuilt by Suleiman the Magnificent in 1522 before his Rhodes campaign, this compact hilltop fortress holds ancient...
- **Grand Bazaar & Old Town** — Hundreds of covered stalls selling spices, Turkish delight, ceramics, lamps, and leather.
- **İçmeler Beach Day** — A 15-minute dolmuş ride south brings you to a wider, cleaner beach backed by pine-covered mountains.
- **Dalyan River & Kaunos Rock Tombs** — Drive about 1.5 hours to Dalyan, then cruise the reed-lined river past the 4th-century BC Carian rock tombs of ancient...
- **Cleopatra Island (Sedir Adası) Boat Trip** — A scenic boat excursion across Gökova Bay to a small island famous for its rare, fine white oolitic sand — legend says...

BEST WALKS

- **Port to Castle Loop** 2.5 km · ~1 hr · Easy — Walk the marina promenade from the cruise terminal to the Old Town, climb the cobbled lane to Marmaris Castle for harbour views, then...
- **Atatürk Park Promenade** 3 km one-way · ~45 min · Flat — Head west along the seafront promenade past Atatürk Park, public beaches, and the town centre.

- Get lira at the terminal ATM. Euros and USD are accepted in the bazaar and restaurants, but you'll overpay on the exchange. Dolmus buses and local market stalls are lira-only.
