GETTING ASHORE

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Sancerre Wine & Village Tour** — Head to the hilltop town of Sancerre, one of France's most celebrated wine appellations.
- **Canal du Berry Towpath Cycling** — Rent a bike and follow the flat, traffic-free towpath along the Canal latéral à la Loire.
- **La Charité-sur-Loire Day Trip** — The Cluniac priory town of La Charité-sur-Loire — a UNESCO World Heritage site on the Santiago de Compostela pilgrimage...
- **Village Stroll & Local Market** — When market day falls on your call, the small village square fills with local producers selling cheese, charcuterie...

BEST WALKS

- **Canal du Berry Towpath Walk** 1-3 km · Flat · 30-90 min — Follow the gravel towpath in either direction from the quay.
- **Village Centre Loop** 1 km · Easy · 20-30 min — A short loop from the quay takes in the village church, the small central square, and a classic Berry streetscape of stone houses and...

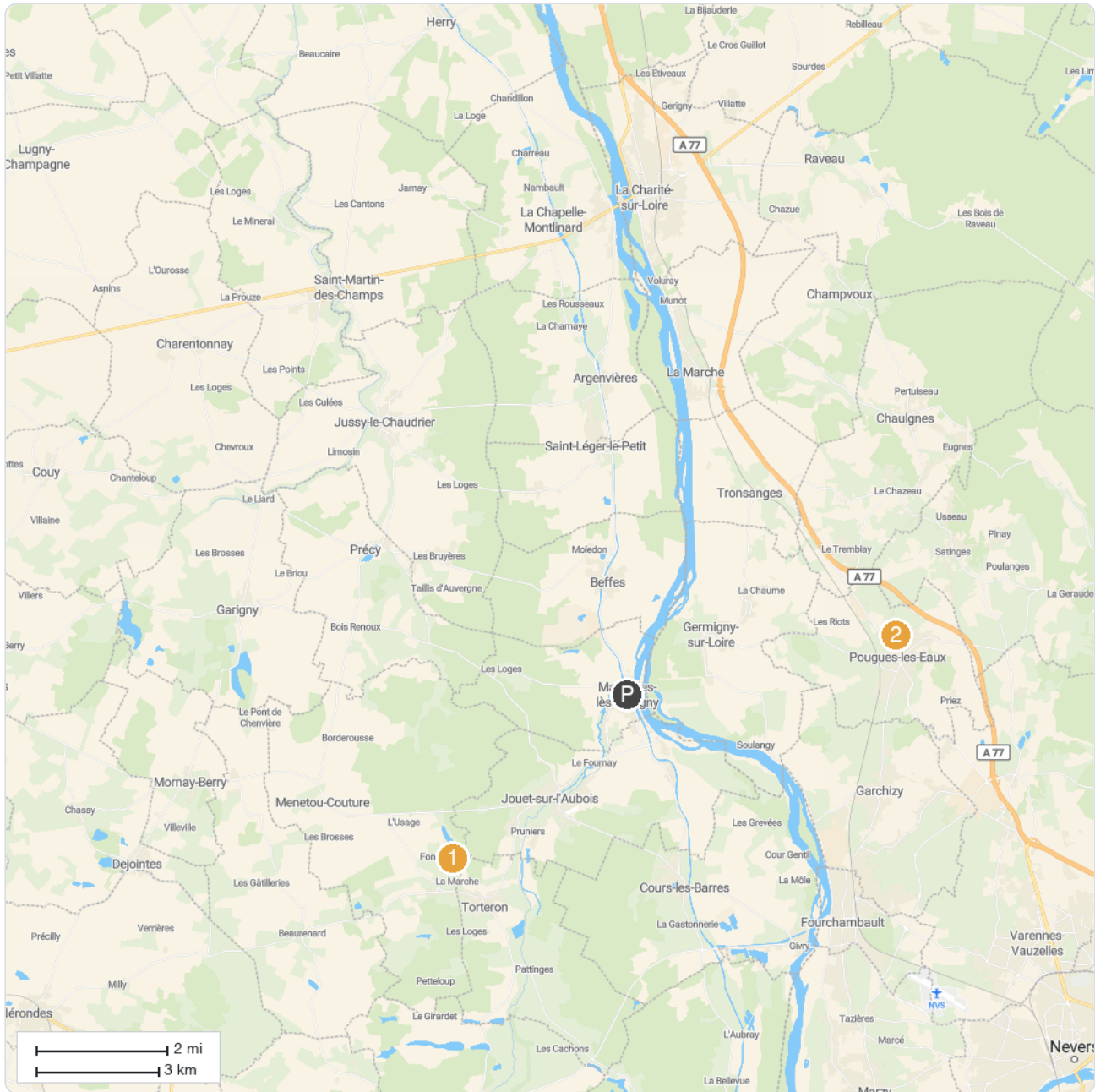
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring cash. Village services are limited, so draw euros before you arrive or use your ship's exchange rather than counting on finding an ATM.
- Sancerre is the real draw. If your ship offers a Sancerre excursion, take it — the village alone is pleasant but brief.
- Bikes beat walking here. The towpath stretches for kilometres and is ideal for cycling. Many ships supply bikes or can arrange rentals.
