TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Calanques National Park Boat Tour** — The creamy white limestone fjords east of Marseille are one of France's great natural spectacles.
- **Basilique Notre-Dame de la Garde** — Marseille's gilded hilltop basilica — 'La Bonne Mère' — is the city's spiritual anchor and its best viewpoint.
- **Aix-en-Provence Half-Day** — Thirty minutes by train or bus, Aix is a world apart — fountained boulevards, Cézanne's studio, excellent markets, and...
- **MuCEM & the Historic Harbour** — The Museum of European and Mediterranean Civilisations (MuCEM) is a landmark building right at the port entrance...
- **Bouillabaisse & Vieux-Port Lunch** — The Vieux-Port's quayside restaurants serve the real thing — bouillabaisse (book ahead), grilled sea urchin, and tielle...

BEST WALKS

- **Vieux-Port to Notre-Dame de la Garde** 3.5 km · 1.5–2 hrs · Moderate (steep finish) — Start at Quai des Belges at the foot of the Old Port, walk through the Panier quarter (Marseille's oldest neighbourhood), pass the...
- **Vieux-Port & MuCEM Waterfront Stroll** 2 km · 45 min · Easy — A flat, scenic walk along the north shore of the Vieux-Port from Quai des Belges to Fort Saint-Jean and the MuCEM museum.

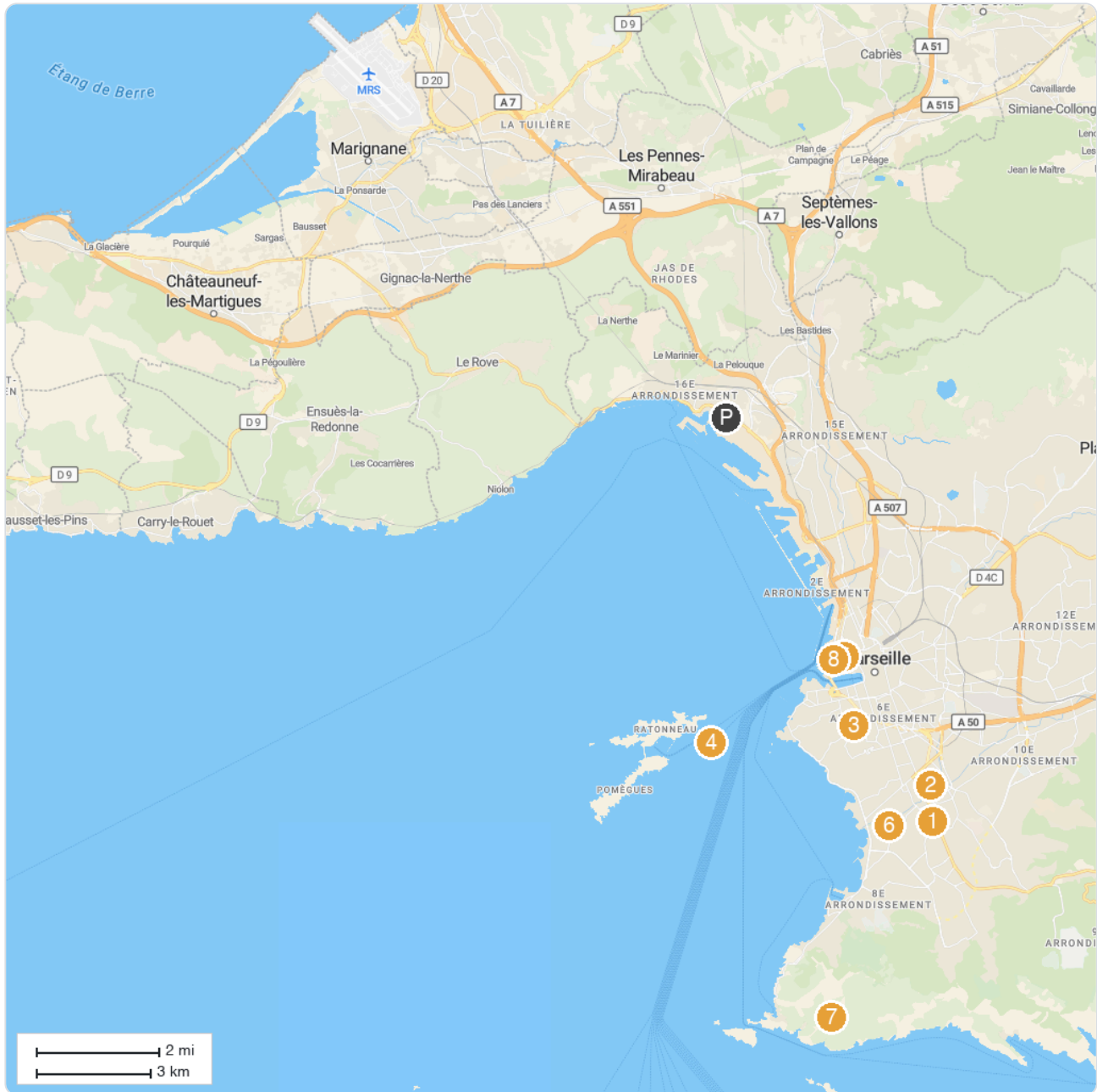
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book bouillabaisse in advance. Authentic versions at Chez Fonfon, Le Miramar, or Péron must be ordered ahead — they don't serve it to walk-ins on busy port days.
- Watch your belongings around La Canebière, the fish market, and busy tourist spots. Marseille is lively but opportunistic theft is real — zip up bags and avoid showing valuables.
