GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Commercial pier — ships dock directly, no tender required

Walk to center: ~20 min on foot following Blue Line, or 10-min taxi

Best For: Colonial history, beach days, pulmonia rides, seafood

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Old Mazatlán & Plazuela Machado** — Stroll cobblestone streets past restored 19th-century facades to Plazuela Machado — the lively heart of the historic...
- El Faro Lighthouse Hike** — Hike 1.4 miles up Cerro del Crestón to one of the highest natural lighthouses in the world.
- Stone Island (Isla de la Piedra)** — A short panga (boat) ride from the port lands you on a long, uncrowded beach.
- Deer Island (Isla de Venados)** — Part of an ecological reserve, Deer Island has clear water for snorkeling and unspoiled beaches.
- Cliff Divers & Malecón** — Watch local divers plunge into the Pacific from the rocky shoreline — a Mazatlán tradition.

BEST WALKS

- Blue Line: Port to Plazuela Machado** 1.5 km · 20 min · Flat — Follow the blue tile line embedded in the pavement from the cruise terminal gate through the city streets into the heart of Old...
- Historic Center Loop** 2 km · 45-60 min · Easy (cobblestones) — From Plazuela Machado, walk to the Angela Peralta Theater (just off the plaza), then north to the Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate...

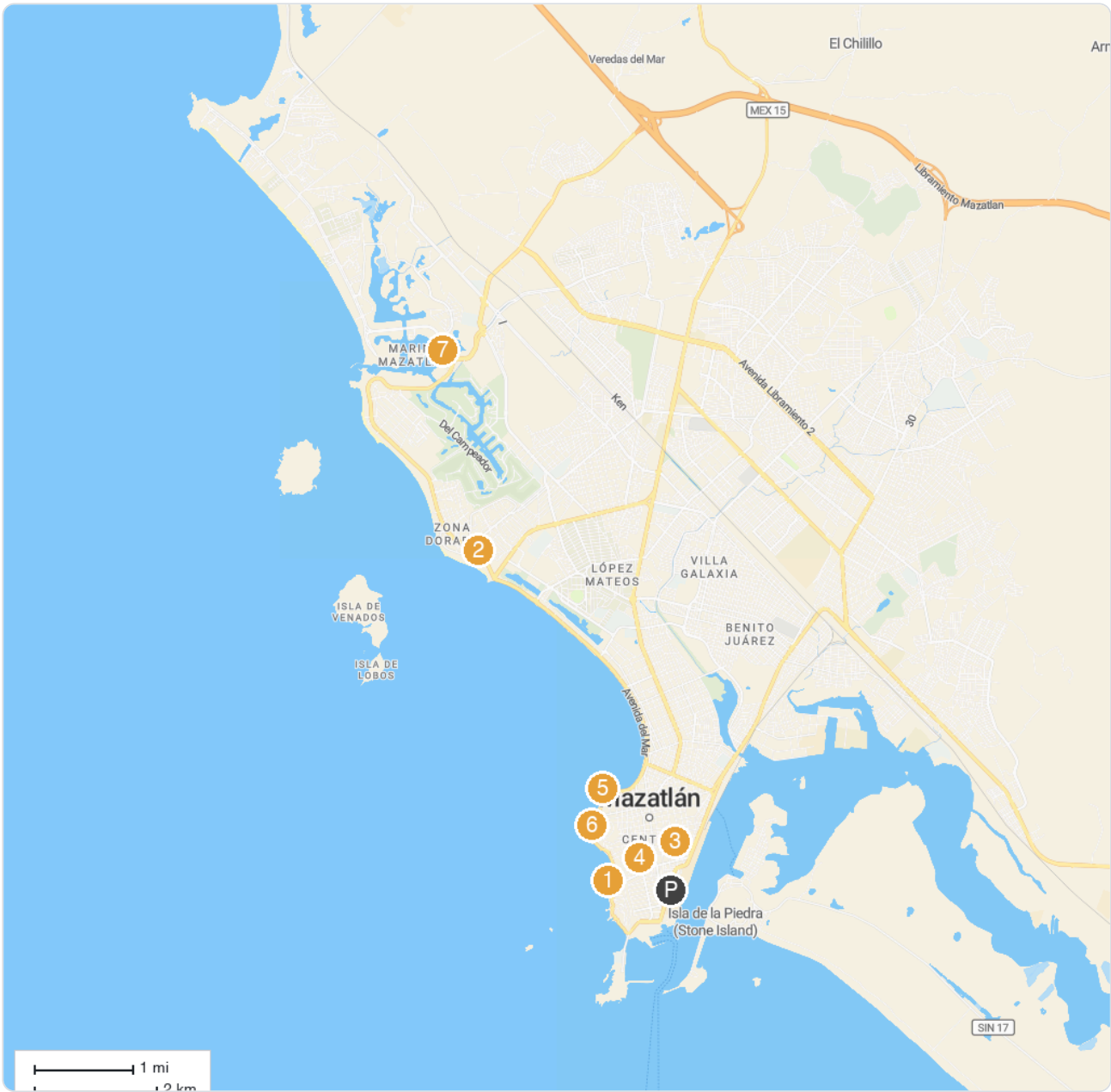
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use pesos, not dollars. Merchants accepting USD give unfavorable rates. ATMs are available in the historic center. Many cruise-adjacent vendors quote in USD — shop in town for...
- Pulmonías are the move. These open-air taxis are iconic in Mazatlán. Negotiate the fare before you get in — roughly 60-100 pesos to the historic center from the terminal gate.
