TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Melbourne City Highlights & Laneways** — Explore Federation Square, Melbourne's famous street-art laneways (Hosier Lane, Croft Alley), the historic Queen...
- **Wildlife Encounter — Moonlit Sanctuary or Werribee Zoo** — See kangaroos, wallabies, koalas, and Tasmanian devils up close.
- **Great Ocean Road & Twelve Apostles** — One of the world's great coastal drives.
- **Yarra Valley Wine & Gourmet Food** — Victoria's oldest wine region is around an hour from the city.
- **Sovereign Hill Gold Rush, Ballarat** — An open-air living museum in Ballarat (~90 min west) recreating the 1850s Victorian gold rush — pan for gold, watch a...

BEST WALKS

- **Bay Trail: Station Pier to St Kilda** ~6 km one-way | ~70 min | Flat, paved path — Follow the sealed Bay Trail south-east from the pier along Port Phillip Bay, passing Lagoon Pier and the foreshore to St Kilda Beach...
- **CBD Laneways Walking Loop** 3 km loop | ~90 min with stops | Flat city streets — Take the #109 tram to the Free Tram Zone, then walk: Federation Square → Flinders Street Station → Degraes Street → Hosier Lane...

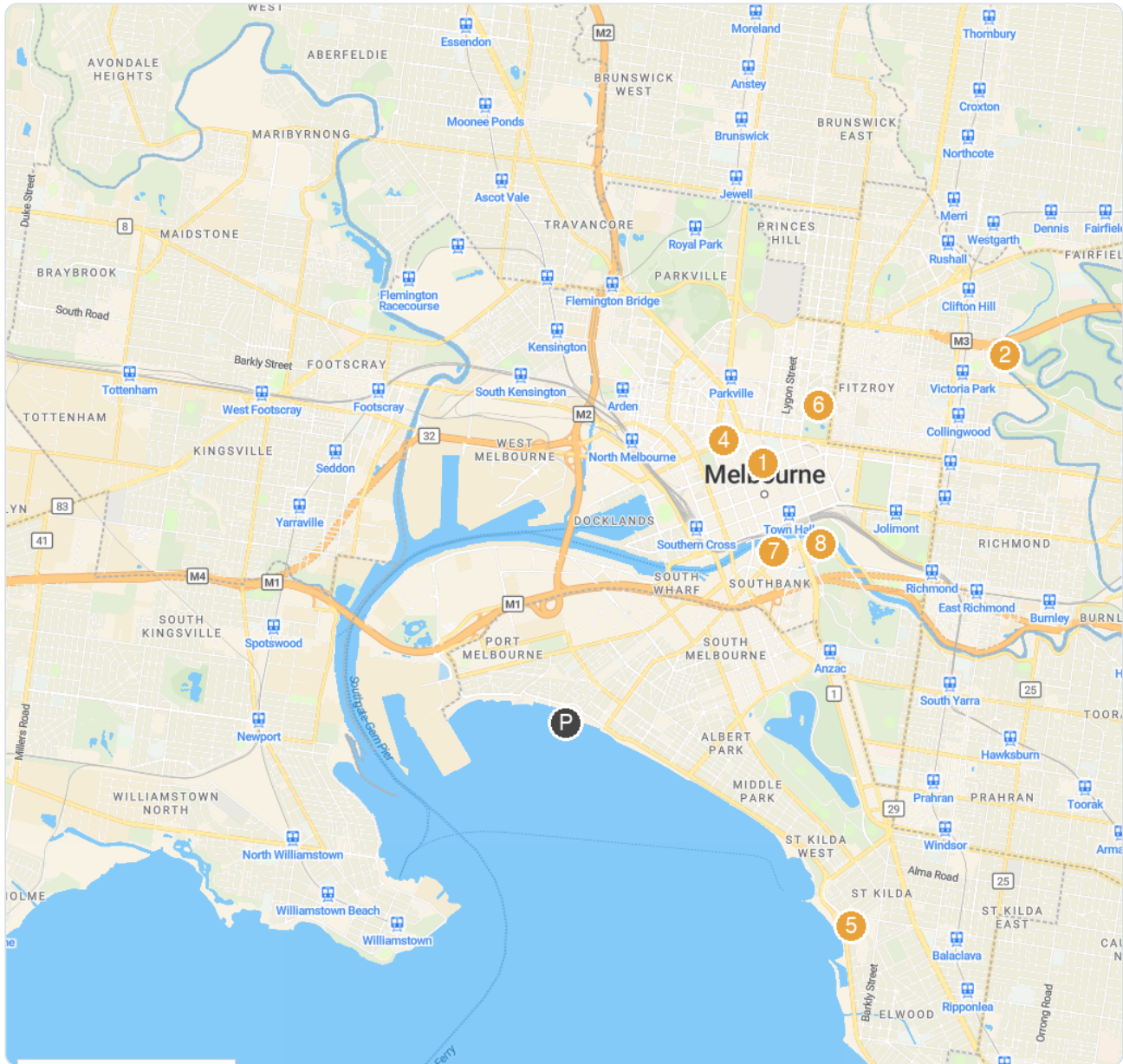
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Get a Myki card at the terminal — the A\$15 Explorer pack covers unlimited public transport all day. Once inside the CBD free tram zone, no Myki needed.
