GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender (large ships) or small-ship dock at Pomena / Polače

Walk to park: 10 min from Pomena pier; 30–40 min walk or 5-min shuttle from Polače

Don't Miss: Boat to St. Mary's Monastery on Veliko Jezero

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Bike the Veliko Jezero Loop** — Rent a bicycle in Pomena and follow the flat, paved, car-free trail around Malo Jezero and Veliko Jezero.
- **Boat to St. Mary's Benedictine Monastery** — A solar-powered park boat crosses Veliko Jezero to the tiny islet of Sveta Marija, where a 12th-century Benedictine...
- **Roman Palace Ruins at Polače** — Step off the pier in Polače and walk straight into the remnants of a 5th-century Roman palace — roofless walls, a...
- **Swim the Lakes at Mali Most** — The narrow channel connecting the two lakes creates a gentle tidal current.
- **Hike Montokuc Summit** — A steep but shaded trail (about 45 min from Pristanište) leads to a fire watchtower at the top of Montokuc hill, with...

BEST WALKS

- **Pomena to Mali Most (Small Bridge)** 1.5 km · 20 min · Easy · Flat paved path — Walk from the Pomena harbor through shaded pine forest along the shore of Malo Jezero to Mali Most, the narrow channel between the...
- **Polače Village & Roman Ruins Walk** 500 m · 15 min · Easy · Waterfront — From the Polače pier, walk the waterfront to explore the 5th-century Roman palace ruins, the early Christian basilica, and the...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Buy your park ticket at the pier. The National Park entry fee (€15–25) is mandatory for the lakes and monastery. It includes the boat to St. Mary's Island and the electric shuttle...
- Rent a bike in Pomena immediately. Bikes go fast on busy days. The lakeside trails are flat, car-free, and the best way to see the park in a half day. Cost: €15–20.
