Docking: Mombasa Cruise Terminal, Kilindini Harbour — all cruise lines dock; no tender

Best For: History buffs, safari seekers, beach lovers, Swahili cuisine

Walk to center: 3–4 km to Old Town; taxi or tuk-tuk required

Don't Miss: Fort Jesus (UNESCO), Mombasa Tusks, Haller Park giraffes

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Fort Jesus & Old Town Walk** — Explore the 1593 Portuguese fortress — a UNESCO World Heritage Site — then wander Mombasa Old Town's carved-door...
- **Tsavo East National Park Safari** — Full-day drive to Tsavo East for Kenya's iconic red elephants, lions, cheetahs, and Aruba Dam waterhole.
- **Haller Park Nature Walk** — A reclaimed limestone quarry in Bamburi turned wildlife sanctuary about 10 km north of the port.
- **Wasini Island Dolphin & Snorkel Trip** — Boat south to Kisite Mpunguti Marine Park for dolphin watching and snorkeling over coral reefs, then a Swahili seafood...
- **Mombasa Old Town Spice & Food Tour** — Join a local guide through Marikiti Market, sample Swahili street food like mahamri and samaki wa kupaka, and browse...

BEST WALKS

- **Fort Jesus to Old Town** 1–2 km | 1–2 hrs | Easy | History & culture — Start at Fort Jesus on Ndia Kuu Road, explore the fort and its museum, then head north into Old Town's maze of Swahili streets.
- **Moi Avenue & the Tusks** 1 km | 30 min | Easy | City landmark — A short stroll along Moi Avenue past the iconic aluminum Mombasa Tusks — built in 1956 to mark Princess (later Queen) Elizabeth's 1952...
