GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Port Hercule — larger ships anchor and tender ashore; ships up to ~250m berth at Quai Rainier III

Best For: Glamour, history, F1 fans, designer shopping, jaw-dropping views

Walk to center: 10 min on foot to Casino Square; 15 min to Prince's Palace

Don't Miss: The Oceanographic Museum and the Casino de Monte-Carlo exterior

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Casino de Monte-Carlo & Casino Square** — The Belle Époque casino is the symbol of Monaco.
- Prince's Palace & Old Town (Monaco-Ville)** — Perched on the Rock, the Prince's Palace hosts the daily changing of the guard at 11:55 AM.
- Musée Océanographique de Monaco** — Founded by Prince Albert I in 1910, this cliffside museum has a world-class aquarium, marine research exhibits, and...
- Formula 1 Circuit Walking Tour** — Monaco hosts the most famous F1 street race in the world.
- Eze Village & Côte d'Azur Day Trip** — The medieval perched village of Eze, about 6 km from Monaco, offers fragrant gardens, stone alleys, and panoramic views...

BEST WALKS

- Port to Casino Square Loop** 1.5 km · 30-45 min · Easy — The classic Monaco stroll.
- The Rock (Monaco-Ville) Walk** 2 km · 1-1.5 hrs · Moderate — Take bus 1 or 2 (or walk uphill) to Monaco-Ville, the Old Town on the Rock.
