- **Ciudad Vieja Walking Tour** — The colonial old town — Plaza Independencia with the Artigas mausoleum and the Palacio Salvo, the Metropolitan...
- **Mercado del Puerto Parrilla Lunch** — The iron-and-glass market hall by the port, packed with parrilla grills serving Uruguay's legendary asado (barbecue).
- **The Rambla & Parque Rodó** — Stroll or cycle a stretch of the Rambla — said to be the world's longest continuous waterfront promenade — out to leafy...
- **Colonia del Sacramento Day Trip** — A longer drive west to the UNESCO-listed Portuguese colonial town of Colonia — cobbled streets, a lighthouse, and the...

BEST WALKS

- **Ciudad Vieja & Plaza Independencia** ~2.5 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — From the port through the old town's lanes to Plaza Matriz and the cathedral, ending at grand Plaza Independencia with the Palacio...
- **Rambla waterfront promenade** ~3 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — The breezy seafront promenade along the Río de la Plata, popular with joggers, mate-sippers, and cyclists — head toward Parque Rodó...
- **Calle Sarandí & Mercado del Puerto** ~2 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — The pedestrian spine of the old town from Plaza Independencia down Sarandí to the antiques market at Plaza Matriz, finishing at the...

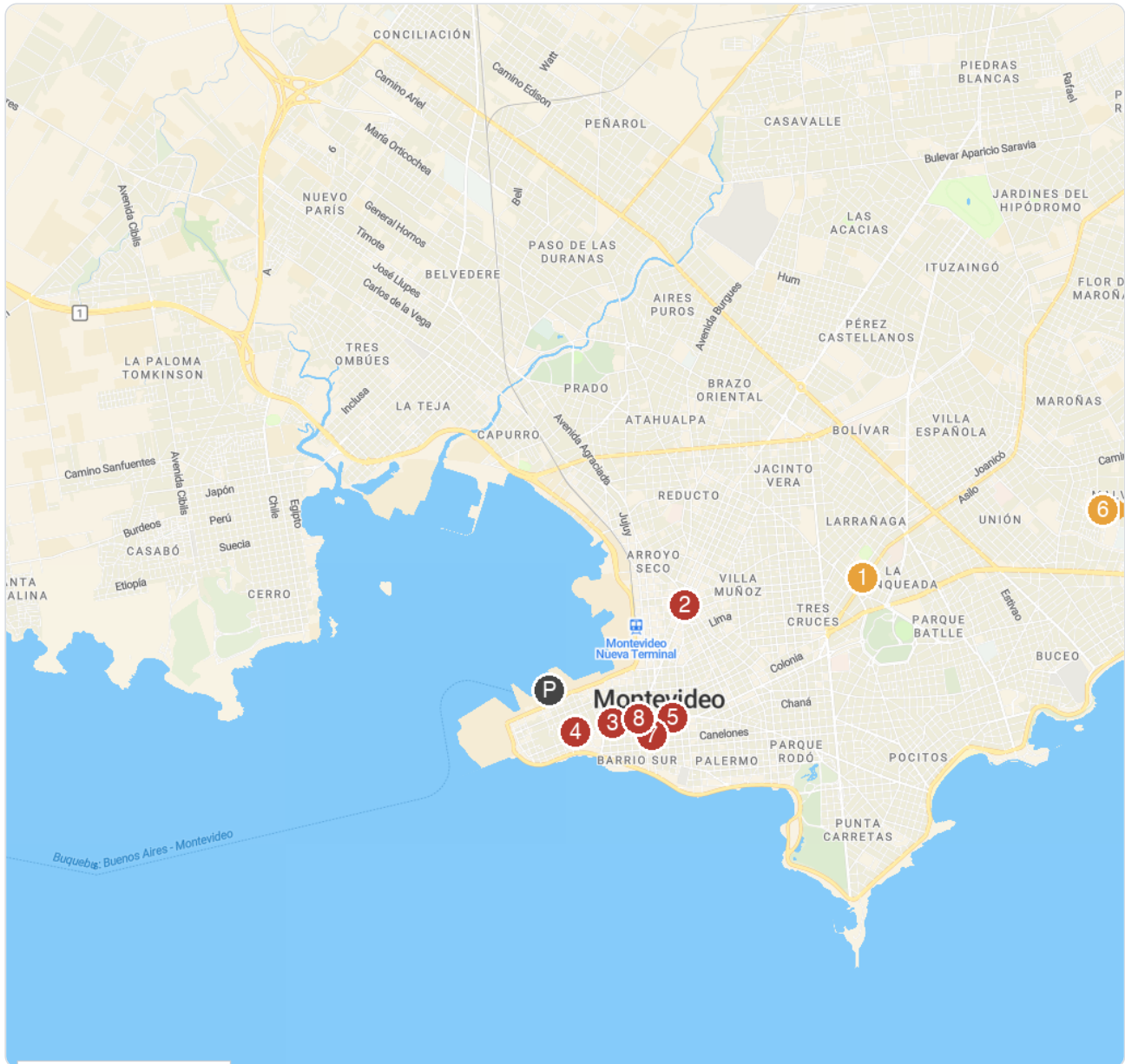
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- 1 Our Lady of Sorrows Holy Land** Religious park with replicas of biblical sites and a sanctuary.
- 3 Salvo Palace** Iconic historic skyscraper with unique architecture, once South America's tallest.
- 5 Fountain of the Padlocks** Romantic fountain where couples attach padlocks for eternal love.
- 7 Department of Historical Studies** University department for historical research and academic studies.
- P Cruise port / terminal**

- 2 Palacio Legislativo** Uruguay's impressive legislative palace, home to the Parliament.
- 4 Museo Gurvich** Art museum showcasing the works of Uruguayan artist José Gurvich.
- 6 Espacio Ciencia** Interactive science museum for all ages, exploring various disciplines.
- 8 Montevideo Exhibition Center** Modern venue hosting exhibitions, conventions, and various public events.
