- **Notre-Dame Basilica & Old Montreal** — The Gothic Revival interior of Notre-Dame Basilica is jaw-dropping — gold leaf, cobalt blue vaulting, and thousands of...
- **Mount Royal Park** — Frederick Law Olmsted's mountain park at the center of the island offers panoramic views of the city skyline and St.
- **Old Port & Bonsecours Market** — The Old Port waterfront is right at your ship.
- **French-Canadian Food Tour** — Sample poutine, smoked meat sandwiches (the real thing — Schwartz's is legendary), bagels, and local craft beer.
- **Pointe-à-Callière Archaeology Museum** — Built over the actual 17th-century foundations of the city's first settlement, this world-class museum lets you walk...

BEST WALKS

- **Old Montreal Heritage Walk** 2 km · Easy · 1.5-2 hrs — Start at the Iberville Terminal on De la Commune Street, walk west to Place Jacques-Cartier, turn up to Rue Saint-Paul for shops and...
- **Old Port Waterfront Loop** 1.5 km · Easy · 45 min — Follow the Old Port promenade east from the terminal past Clock Tower Pier (Tour de l'Horloge), taking in the St.

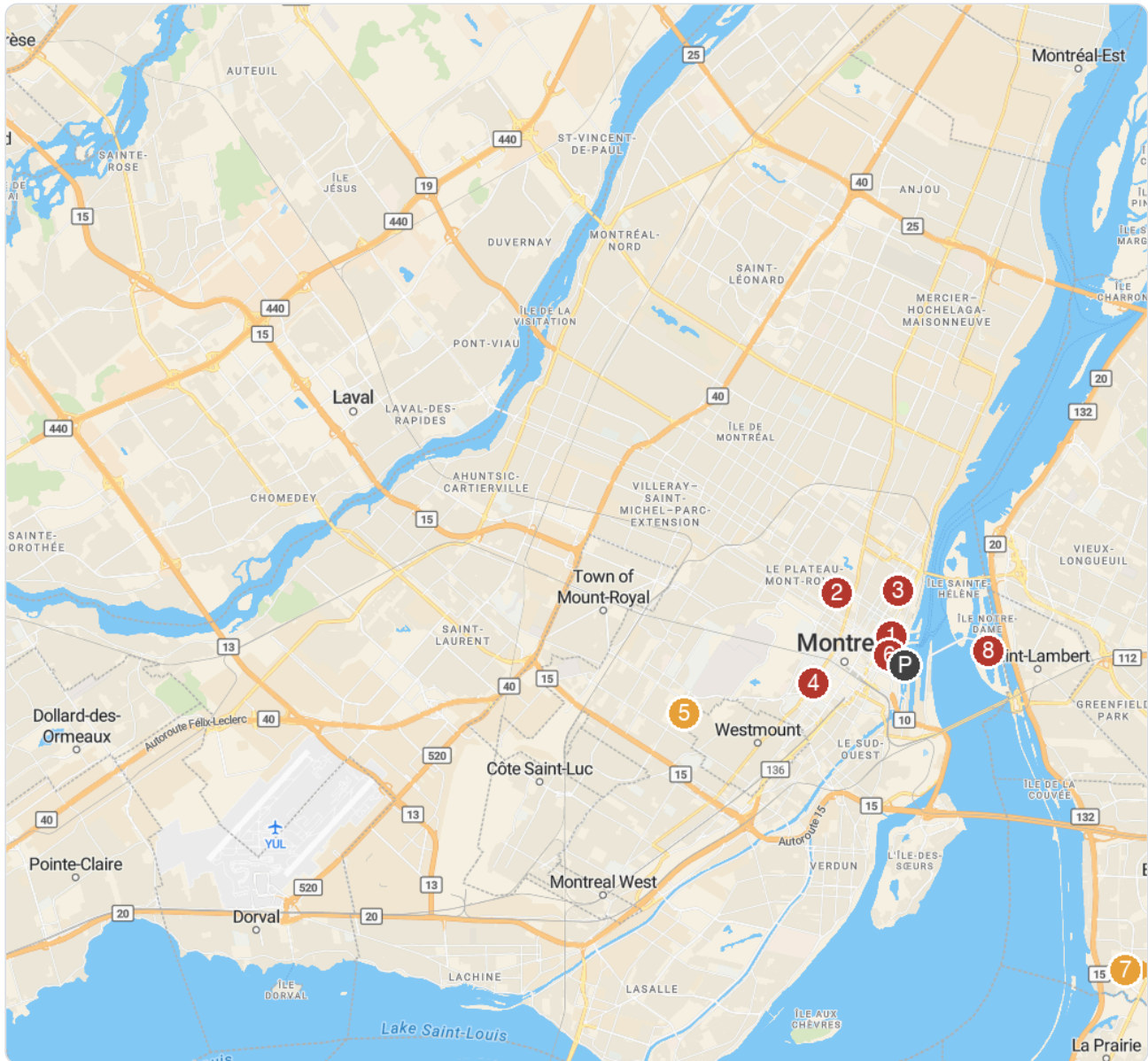
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- 3** St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church Historic Catholic church known for its beautiful architecture and art.
- 5** Saint Joseph's Oratory of Mount Royal Massive basilica and national shrine, Canada's largest church.
- 7** Cache-A-L'Eau Outdoor water play area for children in the Old Port.
- P** Cruise port / terminal

- 2** Musée des Fusiliers Mont-Royal Regimental museum showcasing the Fusiliers Mont-Royal military history.
- 4** Montreal Museum of Fine Arts Major art museum featuring diverse collections from around the world.
- 6** Notre-Dame Basilica of Montreal Historic Gothic Revival basilica, famous for its stunning blue interior.
- 8** Casino de Montréal Large casino offering gaming, dining, and entertainment on an island.
