GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Mumbai International Cruise Terminal, Ballard Pier Extension — alongside berth, no tender

Best For: UNESCO cave temples, colonial architecture, street food, bazaars

Walk to Center: Not walkable from terminal — 10–15 min taxi/Uber to Gateway of India (₹200–400)

Don't Miss: Ferry to Elephanta Caves from Gateway of India (1 hr each way)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Gateway of India & Elephanta Caves** — Take a short taxi to the Gateway of India (1924 basalt arch on the waterfront), then board the hour-long public ferry...
- Colonial Fort District Heritage Walk** — South Mumbai's Victorian Gothic precinct — Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (UNESCO), the High Court, Oval Maidan...
- Colaba Causeway & Taj Mahal Palace** — Stroll the famous street market for spices, textiles, and silver jewellery (bargain hard), then step inside or onto the...
- Mumbai Street Food Tour** — Vada pav (Mumbai's beloved spiced-potato slider), pav bhaji, bhel puri on Chowpatty Beach, and fresh sugarcane juice.
- Dharavi & Dhobi Ghat Community Tours** — Responsible guided tours of Dharavi (one of Asia's largest urban communities) and Dhobi Ghat (the vast open-air...

BEST WALKS

- Colaba Waterfront to Fort Heritage Loop** 3–4 km · 1.5–2 hrs · Easy — Start at the Gateway of India, walk north along the harbour promenade past the Taj Mahal Palace Hotel, continue through Colaba...
- Oval Maidan Precinct Walk** 1.5 km · 45 min · Easy — A compact loop around the Oval Maidan taking in the Rajabai Clock Tower, Bombay High Court, and the Mumbai University Library — all...

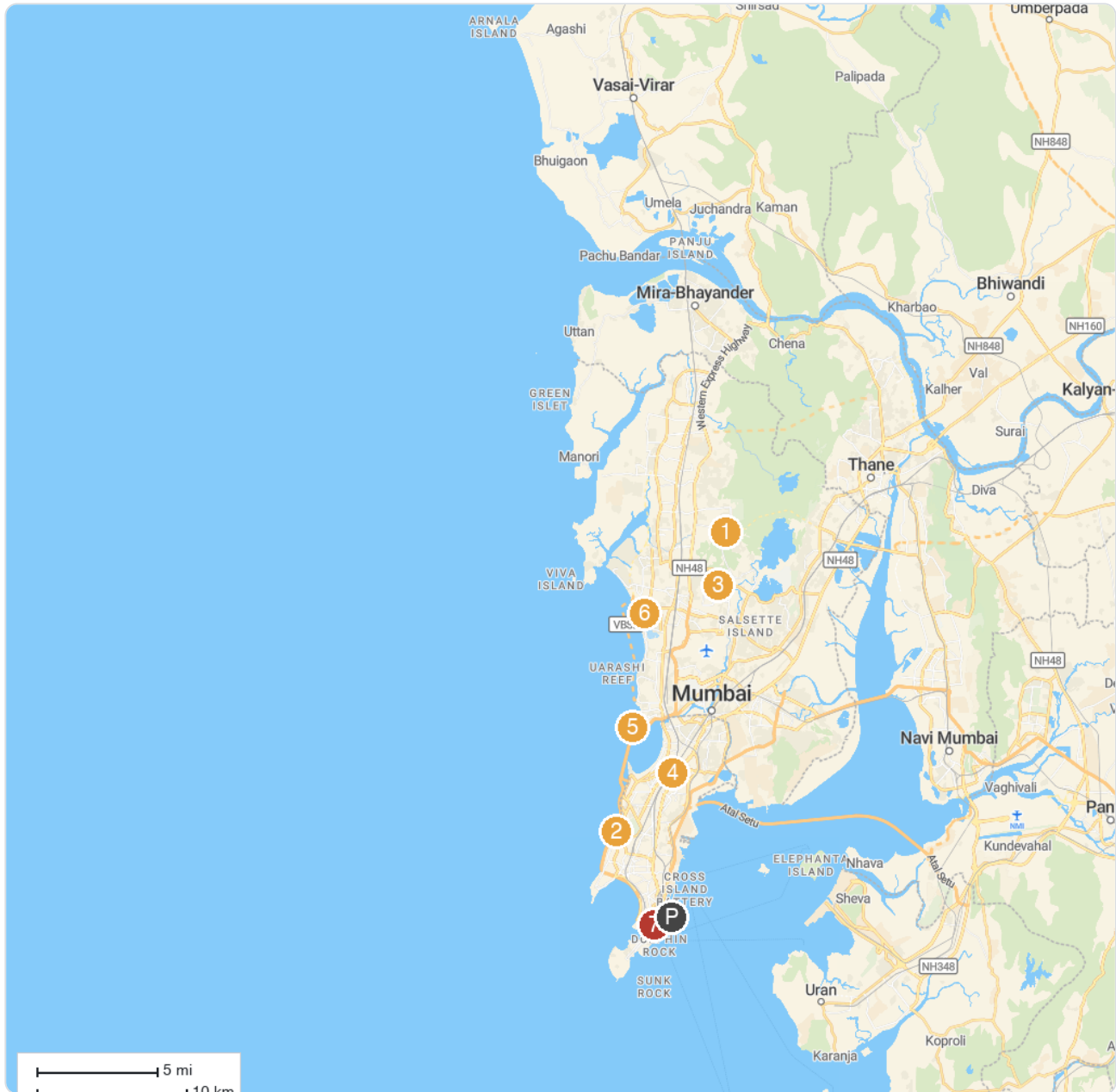
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
