GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Shukutsu, Sakimori, or Chuo Wharf depending on ship size; no tendering

Best For: Day trips to Noboribetsu Hell Valley or Lake Toya, Cape Chikyu cliffs, unique local food

Walk to center: Not practical — 4.5 km industrial roads; free shuttle usually runs to JR Muroran Station

Don't Miss: Muroran curry ramen (the original) and the pork yakitori — totally unlike the rest of Japan

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Noboribetsu Hell Valley (Jigokudani)** — Hokkaido's most famous hot spring resort.
- Lake Toya & Mount Usu** — A stunning volcanic caldera lake with an active stratovolcano looming above.
- Cape Chikyu Scenic Cliffs** — Muroran's signature sight — a white lighthouse on a 120-metre cliff above the Pacific, where the horizon visibly curves...
- Muroran Yakitori & Curry Ramen Crawl** — Muroran has two utterly unique dishes: curry ramen (the city's invention, with thick spiced broth) and 'yakitori' made...
- Itanki Singing Sand Beach** — A wild, cliff-framed beach where dry, clean quartz sand 'squeaks' underfoot — one of Japan's rare singing sands.

BEST WALKS

- Cape Chikyu & Tokkarisho Loop** 2.5 km loop · Easy · 45-60 min · Taxi to start — Take a taxi to Cape Chikyu Lighthouse, walk the cliff-edge path to Tokkarisho Lookout for vertigo-inducing ocean views, then return to...
- Hakucho Bridge Viewpoint Stroll** 1 km · Flat · 20 min · Near Chuo Wharf — If docked at Chuo Wharf, walk to Miyakoshi Park for the best free view of the Hakucho (Swan) Bridge — eastern Japan's largest...

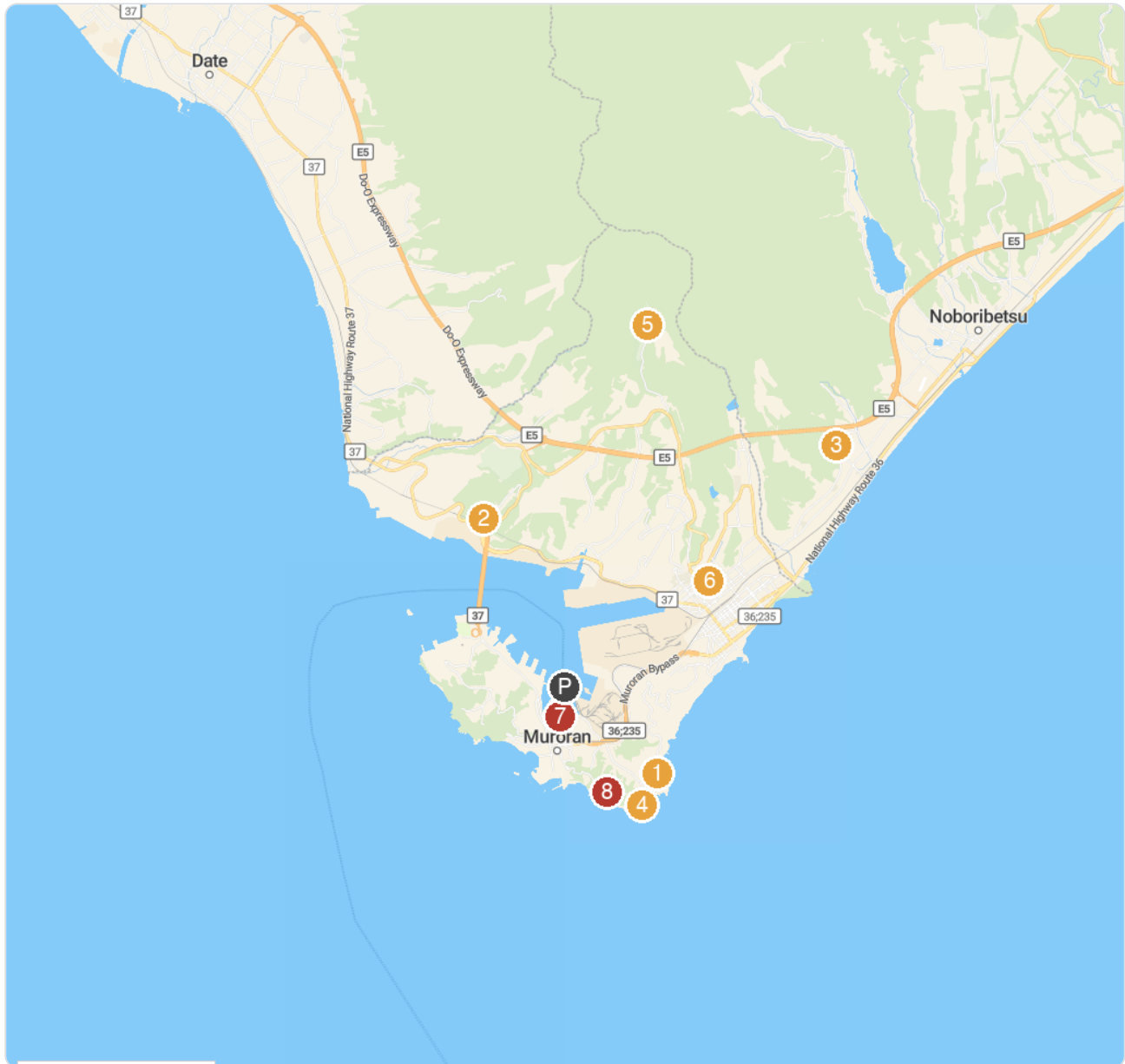
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
