GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in the Argolic Gulf; short 5-10 min ferry to the harbor pier

Best For: History lovers, walkers, foodies, and day-trippers to Mycenae & Epidaurus

Walk to center: Tender drops you steps from the Old Town; Syntagma Square ~5 min on foot

Don't Miss: Palamidi Fortress panorama & gelato from Antica Gelateria di Roma

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Palamidi Fortress** — The crown of Nafplio — a colossal Venetian citadel (1711-14) perched 216 m above the town.
- Ancient Mycenae** — Thirty minutes by taxi, the Bronze Age citadel of Agamemnon is one of Greece's most important sites.
- Ancient Epidaurus Theatre** — The 4th-century BC theatre at Epidaurus has acoustics so perfect that a coin dropped on stage is audible in the top row.
- Nafplio Old Town & Archaeological Museum** — Syntagma Square, the city's Venetian-era heart, is ringed by historic mansions.
- Bourtzi Castle Boat Trip** — Small wooden boats ferry passengers the short distance to Bourtzi — the iconic Venetian water fortress (begun 1471)...

BEST WALKS

- Old Town & Arvanitia Promenade** 3 km · ~1 hr · Flat to gently hilly · Paved throughout — From the tender pier, stroll into the Old Town and through Syntagma Square, pausing at the Church of Agios Spyridon (look for the...
- Acronafplia Ramparts** 2 km · ~45 min · Moderate uphill · Free entry — From the Old Town, wind up past the hotels carved into the old citadel walls to reach Acronafplia's free hilltop ruins — Nafplio's...

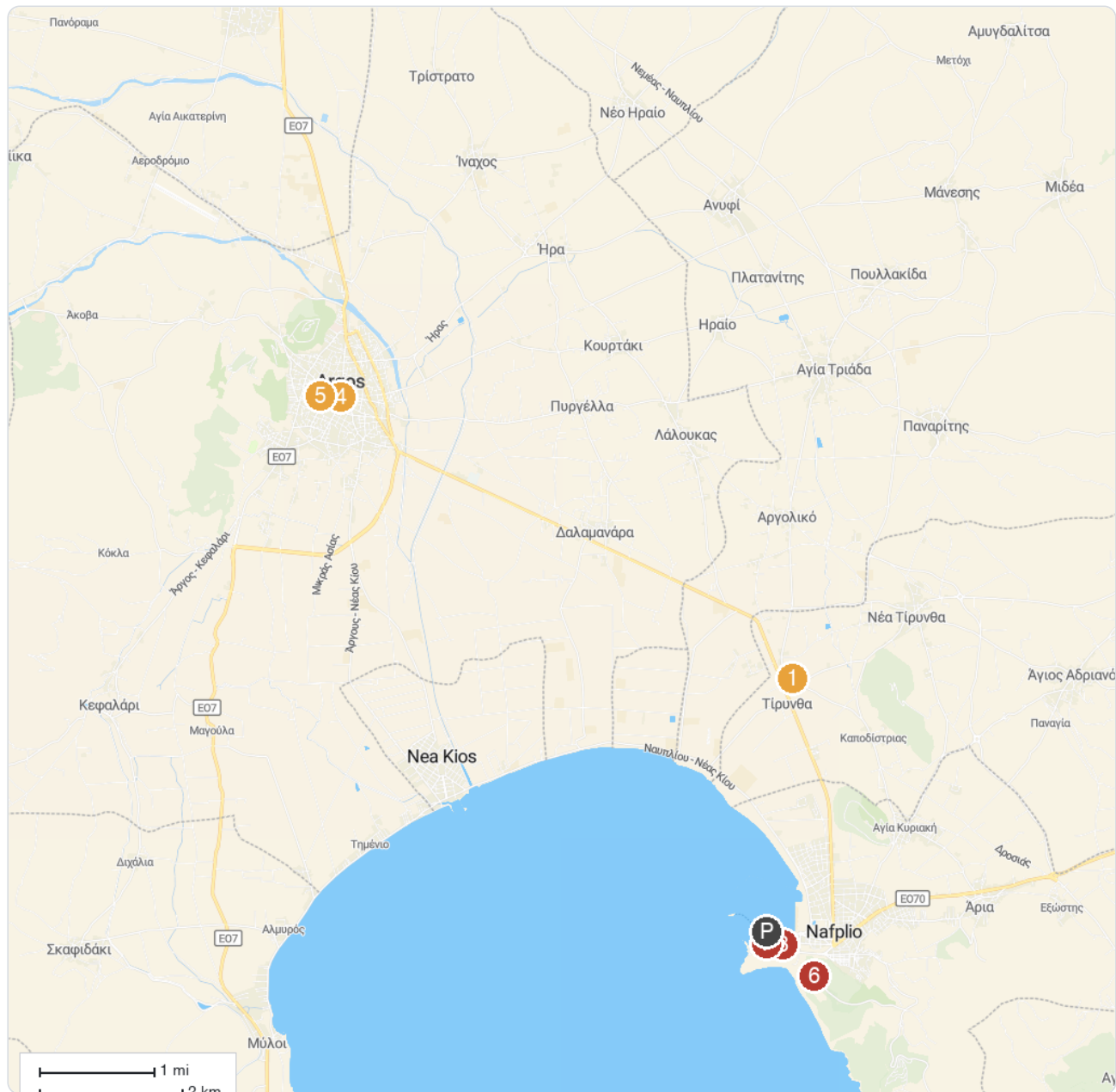
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
