GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Berth at Matsugae International Cruise Terminal (most ships) or Dejima Wharf (smaller vessels); no tendering

Best For: History, culture, walking, peace memorials, Japanese-Western architecture

Walk to center: Matsugae Pier is ~1-2 km to downtown; 15-20 min walk or short tram ride

Don't Miss: Atomic Bomb Museum + Peace Park, Glover Garden, Oura Church (UNESCO)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Atomic Bomb Museum & Peace Memorial Park** — Ground zero of August 9, 1945.
- **Glover Garden & Oura Church** — A hillside open-air museum showcasing the mansions of 19th-century foreign merchants, including the Former Glover House...
- **Dejima Island** — Nagasaki's fan-shaped artificial island was Japan's sole window to the West during the Edo period — a Dutch trading...
- **Mount Inasa Night Views** — Ranked among Japan's three greatest night views, Inasa's summit gives a panoramic sweep of the city and harbour...
- **Shinchi Chinatown & Nagasaki Chanpon** — Nagasaki Chinatown is one of Japan's three major Chinatowns.

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to Glover Garden Walk** 3-4 km · 1.5-2 hrs · Moderate (uphill finish) — From the Matsugae pier, head south along the waterfront to Dejima Island, continue through Chinatown to the base of Glover Garden.
- **Peace Park to Urakami Cathedral** 2 km · 45 min · Easy — Start at Peace Memorial Park, visit the Atomic Bomb Museum, then walk north to the Urakami Cathedral (Urakami Tenshudo) — rebuilt...

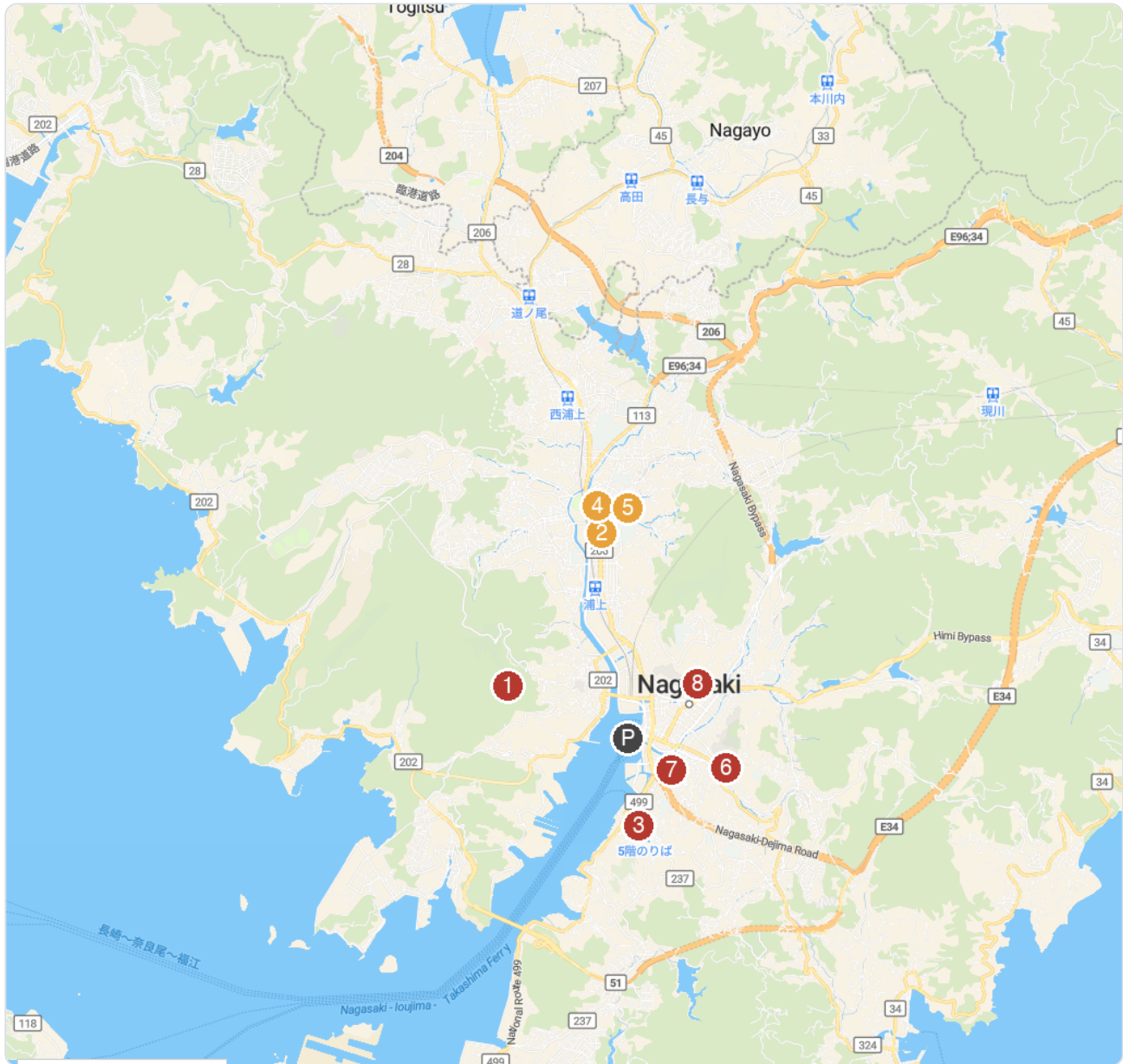
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
