GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Large ships dock at Saint-Nazaire, 60 km from Nantes city center; river cruise ships dock directly on the Loire quay

Best For: Art lovers, history buffs, foodies, Jules Verne fans

City Transfer: 45-60 min by shuttle or taxi; or taxi to Gare de Saint-Nazaire then 35-min TER train

Don't Miss: The Grand Elephant at Les Machines de l'Île — a 40-ft mechanical beast you can ride

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Les Machines de l'Île** — The former shipyards of the Île de Nantes are now home to a steampunk fantasy world inspired by Jules Verne and da Vinci.
- **Château des Ducs de Bretagne** — A beautifully preserved 15th-century ducal fortress in the heart of Nantes.
- **Follow the Green Line** — A literal green stripe painted on Nantes's sidewalks connects every major artistic, historic, and cultural site in the...
- **Passage Pommeraye & Le Bouffay** — Nantes's 19th-century covered arcade is one of France's most beautiful — a triple-story glass-roofed gallery with grand...
- **Trentemoult Village & Navibus** — Hop the Navibus river ferry across the Loire to Trentemoult, a former fishermen's village with narrow lanes of brightly...

BEST WALKS

- **The Green Line: Castle to Machines** 2-3 km · 45-60 min · Easy — Start at the Château des Ducs de Bretagne, walk through the historic center via Passage Pommeraye and Place Graslin, continue through...
- **Feydeau District & Quays** 1 km · 20-30 min · Easy — Stroll through the historic Feydeau neighborhood — once an island, its 18th-century buildings lean slightly outward on their wet-sand...

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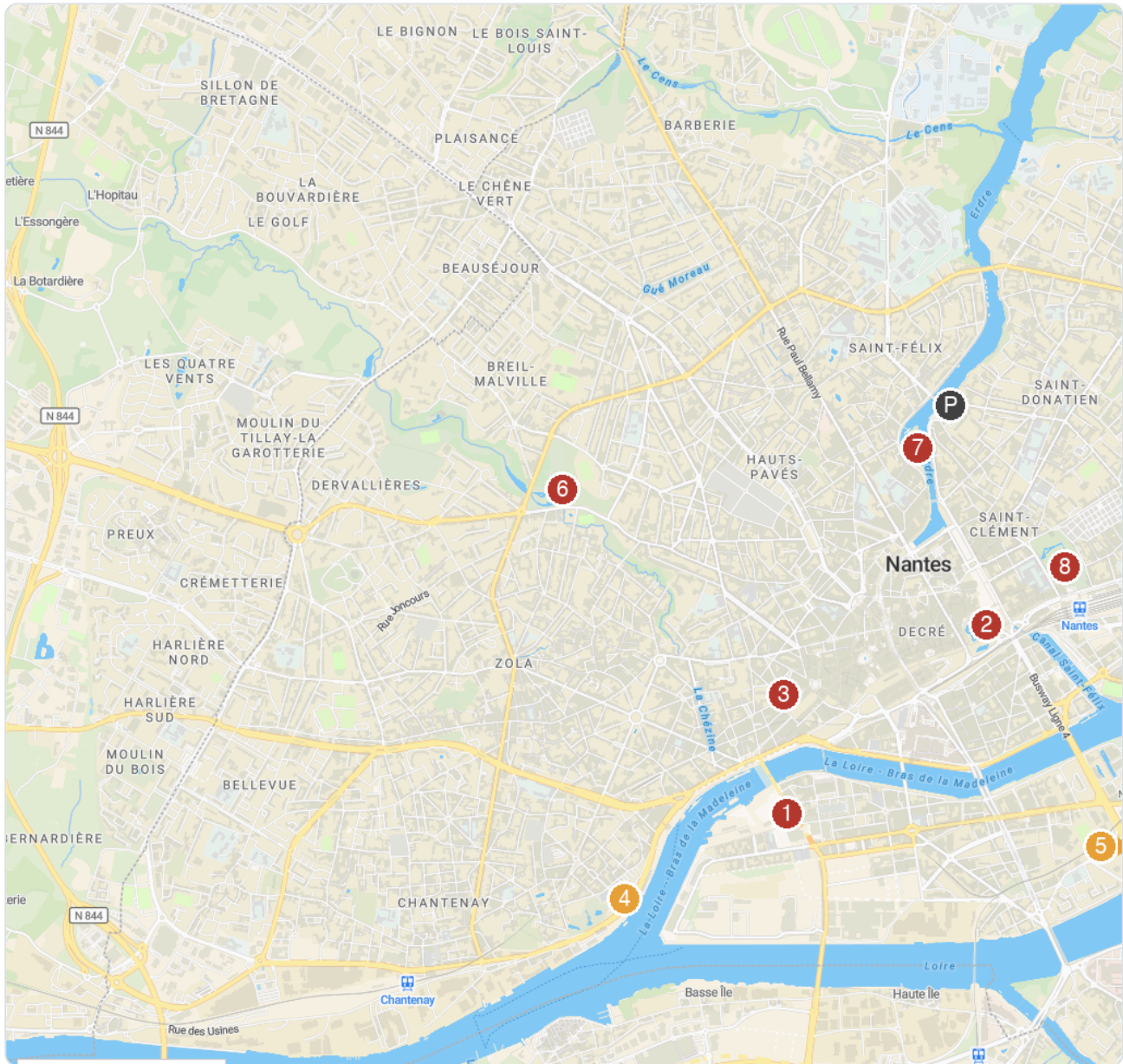
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Train beats taxi: From Saint-Nazaire, the TER train to Nantes takes just 35 minutes and costs a few euros — far cheaper than the €60-80 taxi. Get a taxi to the Gare de...
- Weekends = free transit: Public transport in Nantes (tram, bus, Navibus ferry) is completely free on weekends. Otherwise buy a 1-
