GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Prince George Wharf — walk off the ship into downtown Nassau in under 2 minutes

Best For: Atlantis Resort day passes, Blue Lagoon Island, colonial history, duty-free shopping, Bahamian conch cuisine

Walk to center: Straw Market: immediate; Parliament Square: 5-7 min; Queen's Staircase: 15-20 min

Don't Miss: Arawak Cay (the Fish Fry) — cracked conch and conch salad served from colorful shacks a short jitney ride west of the pier

Getting around: **Taxi** \$6 for 2 passengers to city center; \$3/extra passenger · **Rideshare** not available

 - Pearl Island Beach Resort Day Pass** — A smaller, less-crowded private island alternative with pristine snorkeling just

 - Snorkeling at the Sea Gardens Reef** — Boat trips to Nassau's shallow reef gardens take 20 minutes and put you above healthy coral heads, sergeant majors...
 - Colonial Nassau Walking Tour** — Parliament Square's pastel Georgian government buildings, the Pirates of Nassau Museum (an interactive deep-dive into...

BEST WALKS

- Downtown Nassau Heritage Loop** 2-3 hrs · ~3.5 km · Moderate · Mostly flat with some uphill near the fort — Nassau's best colonial sights in a single loop from the pier.
- Bay Street Waterfront & Junkanoo Beach Stroll** 1.5 hrs · ~2.5 km · Easy · Flat waterfront walk — A relaxed walk west from the pier along Nassau's main commercial strip.

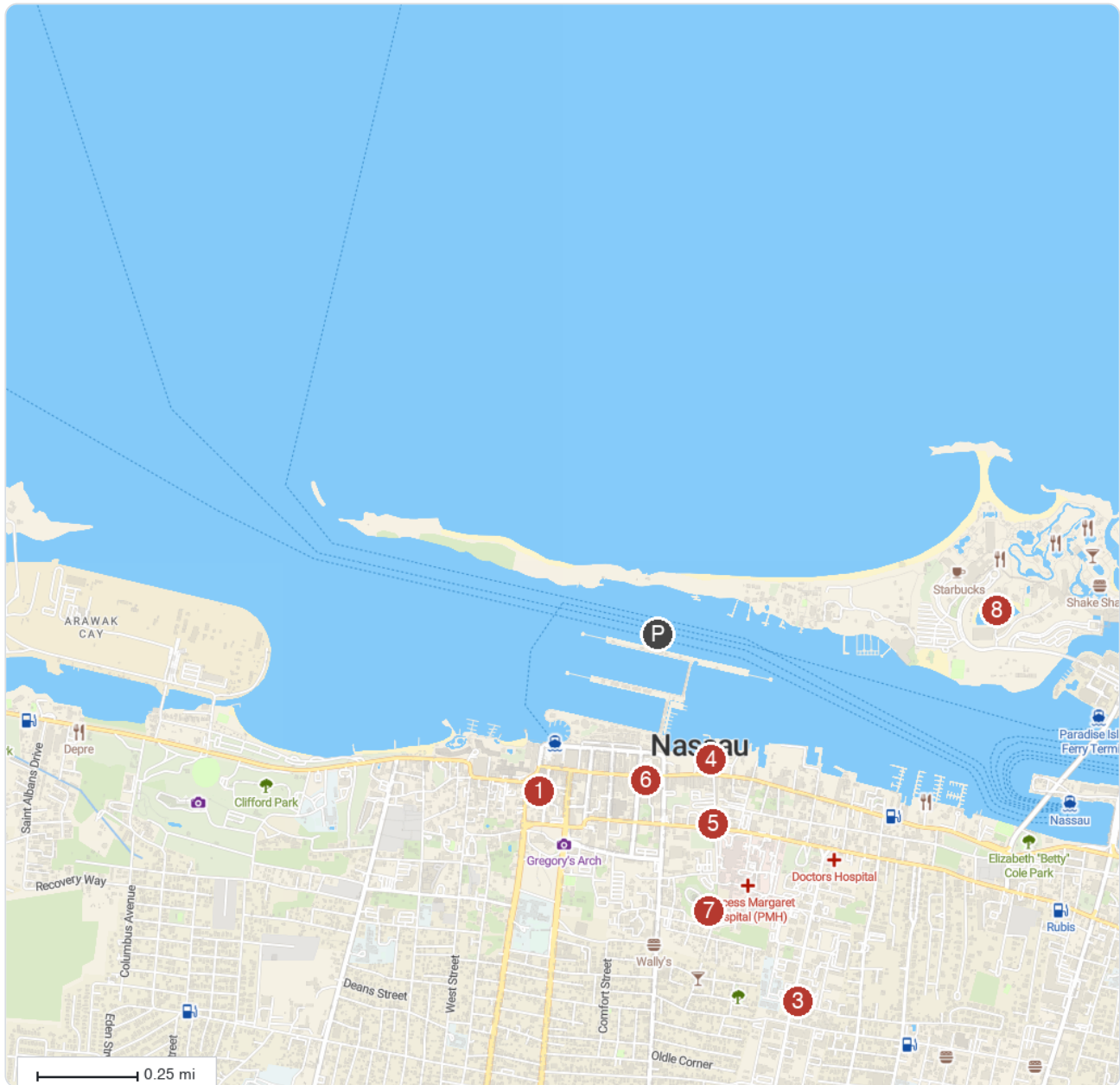
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
