TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Hunter Valley Wine Tour** — Australia's oldest wine region produces world-class Semillon and Shiraz.
- **Fort Scratchley Historic Site** — A 19th-century harbor fort that fired on a Japanese submarine in WWII — the only Australian fort to engage an enemy...
- **Bathers Way Coastal Walk** — A 6 km clifftop coastal pathway from Nobby's Headland south to Merewether Beach.
- **Blackbutt Reserve** — A free-entry nature reserve 15 minutes from the CBD where you can see koalas, kangaroos, emus, and wombats in a natural...
- **Harbour & Ocean Boat Tour** — High-speed ocean rafting tours depart near the shuttle drop-off, heading out of the harbor to see sea caves, rugged...

BEST WALKS

- **Honeysuckle to Nobby's Beach & Fort Scratchley** 4 km return | 1.5–2 hrs | Flat then uphill — Walk the harbor foreshore east from Honeysuckle past Queens Wharf, along the beach path to Nobby's Breakwall, then climb the headland...
- **Newcastle Memorial Walk & Bogey Hole** 3 km | 1 hr | Coastal clifftop — From Strzelecki Lookout, follow the spectacular 450-metre clifftop Memorial Walk — including its 160-metre steel bridge lined with...

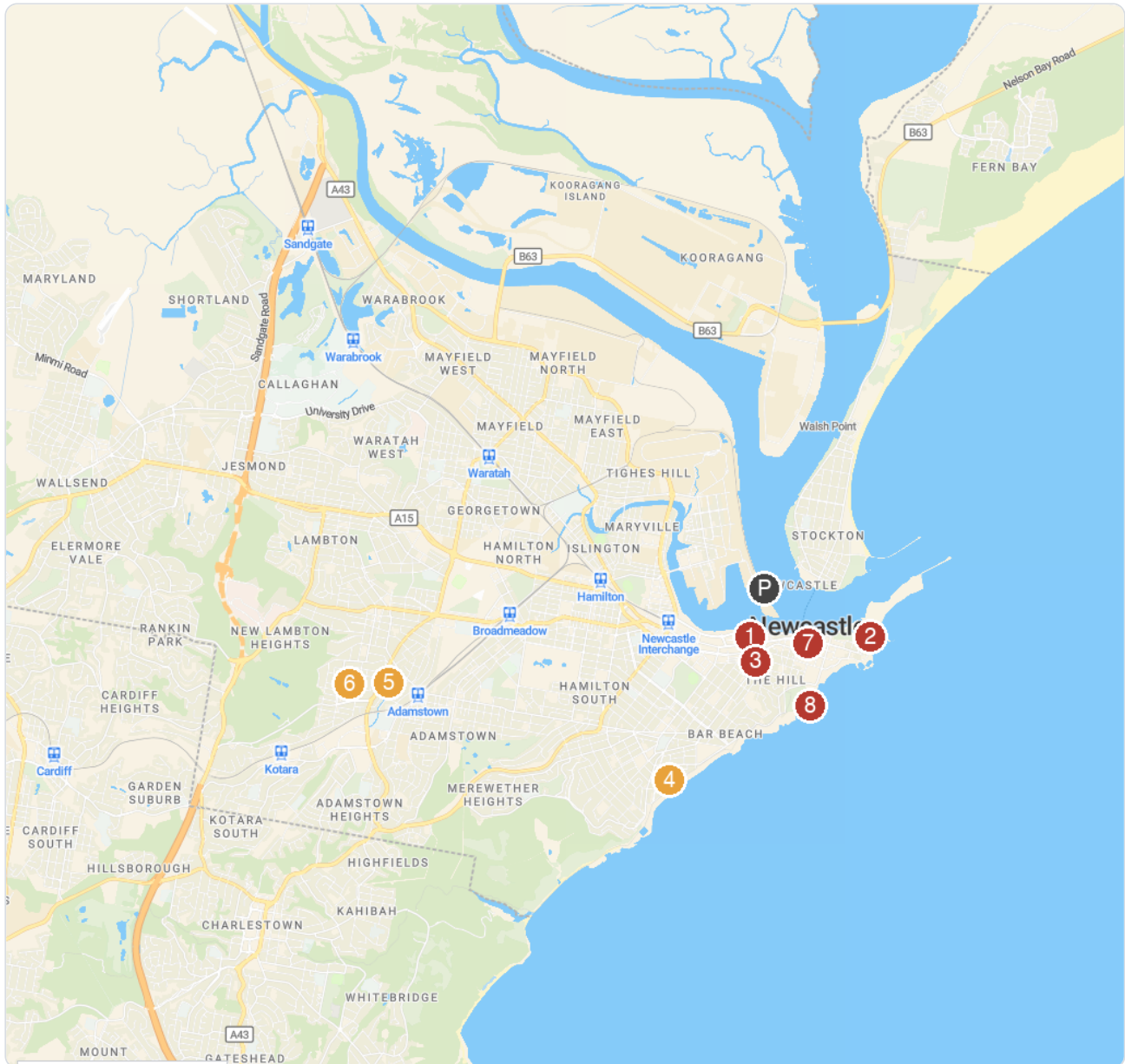
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Shuttle is mandatory. The Channel Berth is inside a secure working port — you cannot walk to the city. Join the shuttle queue early on busy call days; lines can build up.
- Card-only country. Australia is nearly cashless. Tap-to-pay works everywhere — cafes, taxis, light rail, ferry. You won't need AUD
