Walk to center: 5 min from Ann Street Pier tender landing to Thames St & Bowen's Wharf

- **The Breakers & Gilded Age Mansions** — Tour The Breakers, Cornelius Vanderbilt II's 70-room Italian Renaissance palazzo on Bellevue Avenue — the grandest of...
 - **Cliff Walk** — New England's first National Recreation Trail: a 3.5-mile path hugging the Atlantic shoreline with jaw-dropping ocean...
- **Newport Harbor & Narragansett Bay Boat Tour** — Narrated sailing or motor tours of Newport Harbor take you past Rose Island Lighthouse, Fort Adams, and the...
 - **Fort Adams State Park** — The largest coastal fortification in the United States, Fort Adams guards the entrance to Narragansett Bay.
 - **International Tennis Hall of Fame** — Housed in the historic Newport Casino (a National Historic Landmark on Bellevue Avenue), this museum holds over 1,900...

BEST WALKS

- **Downtown Waterfront Stroll** 1 mile • 30 min • Easy — From Ann Street Pier, wander along America's Cup Avenue to Bowen's Wharf, Bannister's Wharf, and historic Thames Street — lined with...
- **Cliff Walk (Northern Section)** 2 miles round-trip • 1 hr • Moderate — Start at the Cliff Walk at Easton's Beach entrance (Memorial Blvd) for the most dramatic mansion-meets-ocean scenery.
- **Bellevue Avenue Mansion Mile** 1.5 miles one-way • 45 min • Easy — Stroll or take a rideshare to the top of Bellevue Avenue and walk south past The Elms, Rosecliff, Marble House, and Belcourt of...

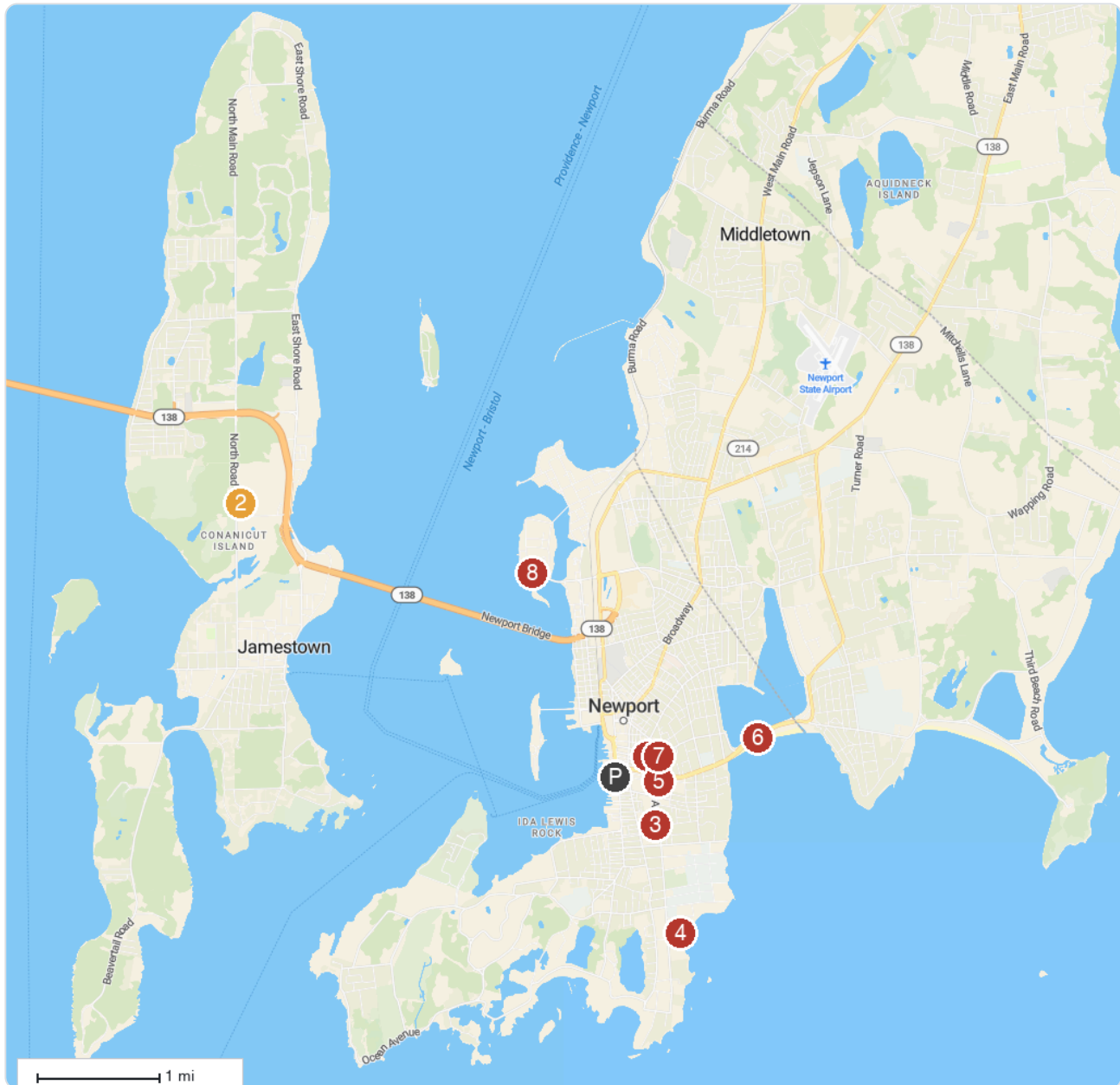
