- **Caerleon Roman Fortress & Baths** — One of Britain's most intact Roman legionary sites: a 2,000-year-old amphitheatre, exposed barracks, and the National...
 - **Cardiff City & Cardiff Castle** — Wales's capital is just 10 miles away — stroll the Victorian arcades, visit Cardiff Castle's ornate State Apartments...
 - **Wye Valley & Tintern Abbey** — Drive the Wye Valley AONB to reach Tintern Abbey, the romantic 12th-century ruin on the
- riverbank that inspired Turner...

 - **Tredegar House** — A magnificent late 17th-century mansion on the outskirts of Newport, seat of the Morgan family for 500 years.
 - **St Fagans National Museum of History** — Wales's most popular heritage attraction near Cardiff — over 40 historic buildings relocated to a 100-acre parkland...

BEST WALKS

- **Newport City Heritage Walk** 2.5 km | Mostly flat | 45–60 min — From the city centre, walk along the River Usk to Newport Transporter Bridge (a 1906 Edwardian engineering marvel), then loop back via...
- **Caerleon Roman Trail** 1.5 km loop | Flat | 45 min on-site — A self-guided walk around the Caerleon fortress site taking in the amphitheatre, legionary baths, and excavated barracks — then into...

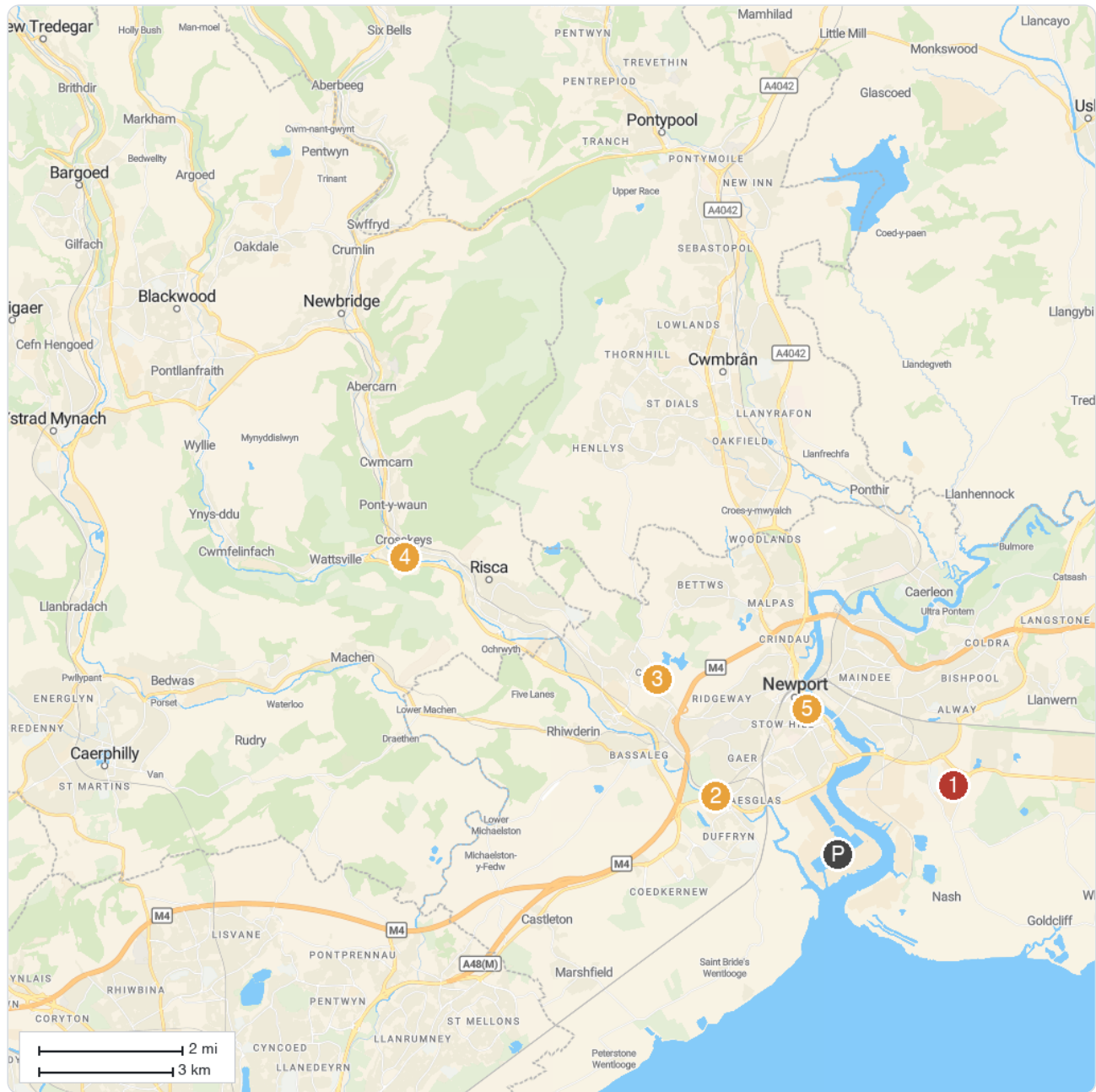
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
