GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — river ships dock along the Waalkade quay; no tender

Best For: Roman history, medieval old town, riverside cycling

Walk to center: 5–10 min uphill to Grote Markt (~500 m)

Don't Miss: Valkhof Park ruins & De Oversteek bridge sunset tribute

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Roman Nijmegen & Valkhof Ruins** — Walk through Valkhof Park to see the 11th-century St.
 - **Old Town Walk: Grote Markt & Sint-Stevenskerk** — Explore the main market square with its 17th-century Boterwaag, climb the tower of the Gothic St.
 - **Waal Riverside Cycling** — Rent a bike on the Waalkade and follow the dike paths east into the Ooijpolder nature reserve, where wild Konik horses...
- **WWII Liberation: National Liberation Museum, Groesbeek** — A short taxi or bus ride from the dock, this museum near the German border tells the full story of Operation Market...
 - **Veur-Lent River Beach & Spiegelwaal** — Cross De Oversteek bridge to the Veur-Lent island for sandy river swimming beaches along the Spiegelwaal bypass channel...

BEST WALKS

- **Waalkade to Grote Markt & Valkhof Park** 1.5 km | 25–35 min | easy–moderate (uphill sections) — From the dock, walk along the Waalkade to the Velorama bicycle museum, then head up Burchtstraat into Valkhof Park for Roman ruins and...
- **De Oversteek Bridge & Veur-Lent** 3 km round trip | 40–50 min | easy — Walk west along the Waalkade to the De Oversteek bridge, where 48 lamp pairs light up one by one each sunset in tribute to US soldiers...
- **Kronenburgerpark & Medieval Walls** 1 km | 20 min | easy — Head west from Grote Markt to Kronenburgerpark, a landscaped English-style park with a pond, peacocks, and the 15th-century Kruittoren...

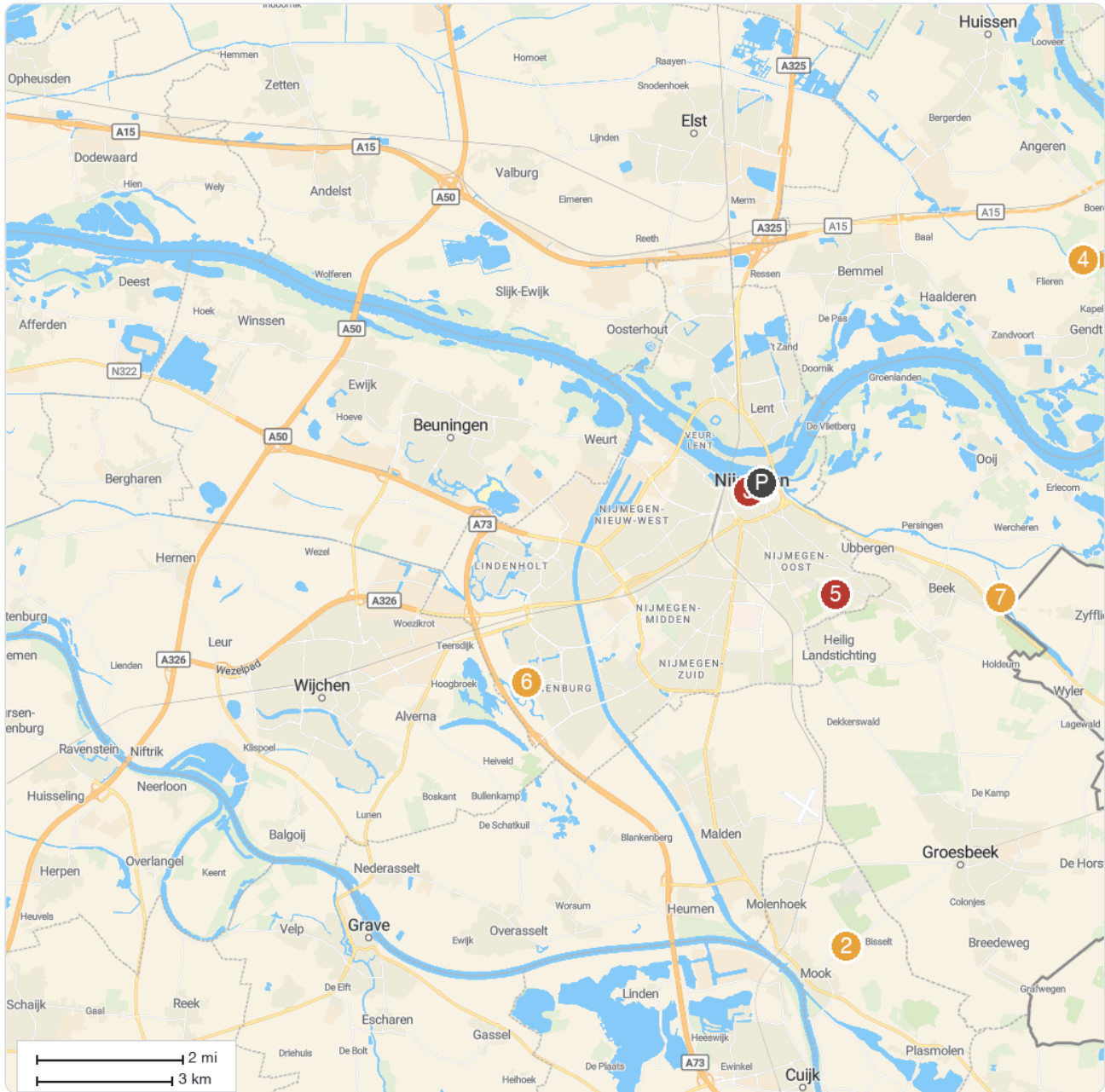
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
