A quiet fjord town with outsized Viking roots — home to the largest Viking ship ever found in Norway and the ancestral heartland of the iconic Fjord Horse. Easily walkable from the SeaWalk pier.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: SeaWalk floating pier (220 m); ships moor bow-to-shore and the pier extends to the hull, passengers walk ashore — no tender boats

Walk to center: 5 min flat to Eidsgata historic street

Best For: Viking history, Fjord Horse encounters, peaceful Norwegian town atmosphere

Don't Miss: Stepping aboard the reconstructed Myklebust Ship at Sagastad Viking Center

Getting around: Taxi NOK 1,000–1,300 to Loen (~56 km) · Rideshare not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Sagastad Viking Center** — The centrepiece of Nordfjordeid — a modern museum built around the 30-metre reconstructed Myklebust Ship, the largest... 360° views.
- Norwegian Fjord Horse Centre** — Norway's national centre for the beloved Fjord Horse breed.
- Loen Skylift & Mount Hoven** — A 20-minute cable car ride ascends 1,011 metres above Loenfjorden for jaw-dropping
- Briksdal Glacier** — Visit Briksdalsbreen, an arm of the Jostedalsbreen ice cap.
- Hike to Trollenykjen Viewpoint** — A well-marked trail leads up to Trollenykjen (881 m) with panoramic 360° views over Eidsfjorden, the town, and your...

BEST WALKS

- Viking & Fjord Horse Loop** 3.5 km · 1.5 hrs · Easy, flat — From the SeaWalk pier, walk into town along the fjord promenade, explore Eidsgata, continue to Sagastad Viking Center, visit the...
- Town & Church Stroll** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — Quick loop for those with limited time — pier to Eidsgata shops and Minibakeriet bakery, then up to Eid Church and back along the...
