GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — ships anchor offshore; boats land at Cascade or Kingston Pier depending on conditions

Best For: History, snorkelling, hiking, and unique Pitcairn-descendant culture

Walk to centre: Shuttle bus required (10–15 min) from either pier to Burnt Pine village

Don't Miss: Kingston & Arthur's Vale Historic Area (KAVHA) — UNESCO World Heritage convict settlement

Getting around:  Taxi  ~AUD 7–15 per trip ·  Rideshare  not available ·  Hop-on hop-off  Hop-on hop-off

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Kingston UNESCO Heritage Walk** — Explore Kingston and Arthur's Vale Historic Area (KAVHA), part of the UNESCO-listed Australian Convict Sites World...
 - Emily Bay Snorkelling & Glass-Bottom Boat** — Emily Bay Lagoon is the island's most sheltered spot — calm turquoise water ideal for snorkelling over coral gardens.
 - Mount Pitt & Mount Bates Summit Hike** — Trek through dense Norfolk pine forest in the National Park to reach Mount
- Bates (319 m), the island's highest point...

 - Bounty Folk Museum & Fletcher's Cyclorama** — Dive into the HMS Bounty mutineer story at the privately-run Bounty Folk Museum, then see the dramatic Fletcher's...
 - Norfolk Island National Park Birdwatching** — The island is one of the few habitats of the critically endangered Norfolk Island Green Parrot.

BEST WALKS

- Kingston Foreshore & KAVHA Loop** ~2 km | Easy | 45–60 min — From Kingston Pier, walk the foreshore past the Quality Row Georgian buildings, the old gaol, convict cemeteries, and down to Emily...
- Burnt Pine Village Wander** ~1 km | Easy | 30 min — The island's commercial hub is compact.

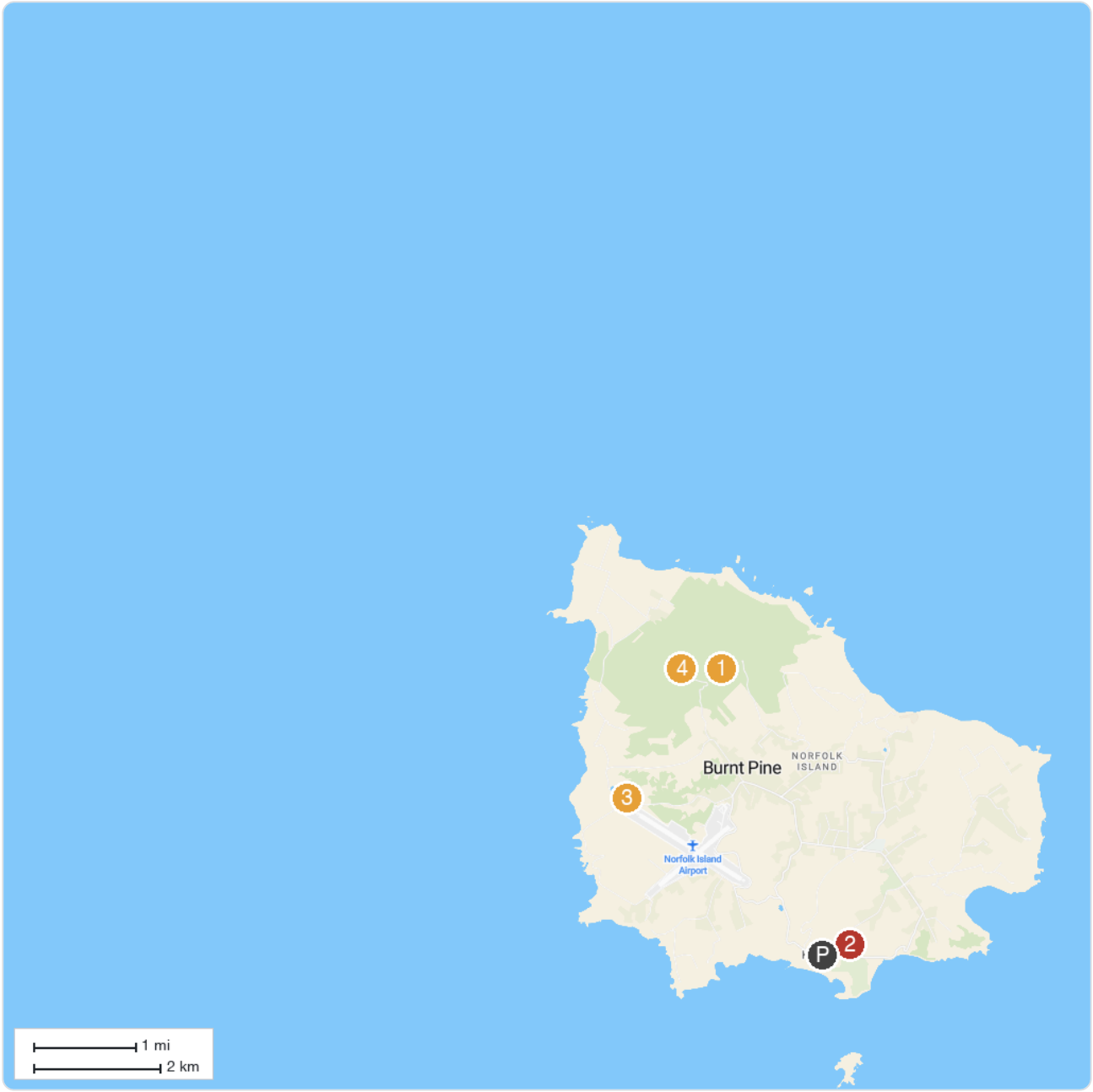
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender conditions change fast. Always check the ship's daily notice the night before — rough swells can delay or cancel landings entirely.
- Hire transport ashore. Scooters, hire cars, and guided bus tours are available from Burnt Pine — the island's roads are driveable
