- **Tjibaou Cultural Centre** — Renzo Piano's iconic Kanak cultural centre on the Tina peninsula — ten soaring wooden 'cases' housing Kanak art...
- **Amédée Island Lighthouse Day Trip** — A classic South Pacific excursion: boat out to tiny Amédée Island with its 19th-century lighthouse, snorkel the coral...
- **Anse Vata & Baie des Citrons** — Noumea's two most popular swimming beaches, lined with cafés, restaurants, and watersports.
- **UNESCO Lagoon Sailing or Snorkeling** — New Caledonia's lagoon is a UNESCO World Heritage Site — one of the largest coral reef systems on Earth.
- **Aquarium des Lagons & City Walk** — The Aquarium des Lagons showcases the extraordinary marine biodiversity of New Caledonia's reef, including nautiluses...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to Place des Cocotiers** ~1.5 km · 30 min · easy — Walk from the Gare Maritime along the waterfront esplanade, past the Aquarium des Lagons, and into Place des Cocotiers — the leafy...
- **Mont Coffyn Lookout** ~3 km · 1 hr · moderate — A short uphill walk or taxi ride to the Mont Coffyn lookout delivers panoramic views over Noumea, the lagoon, and the surrounding...

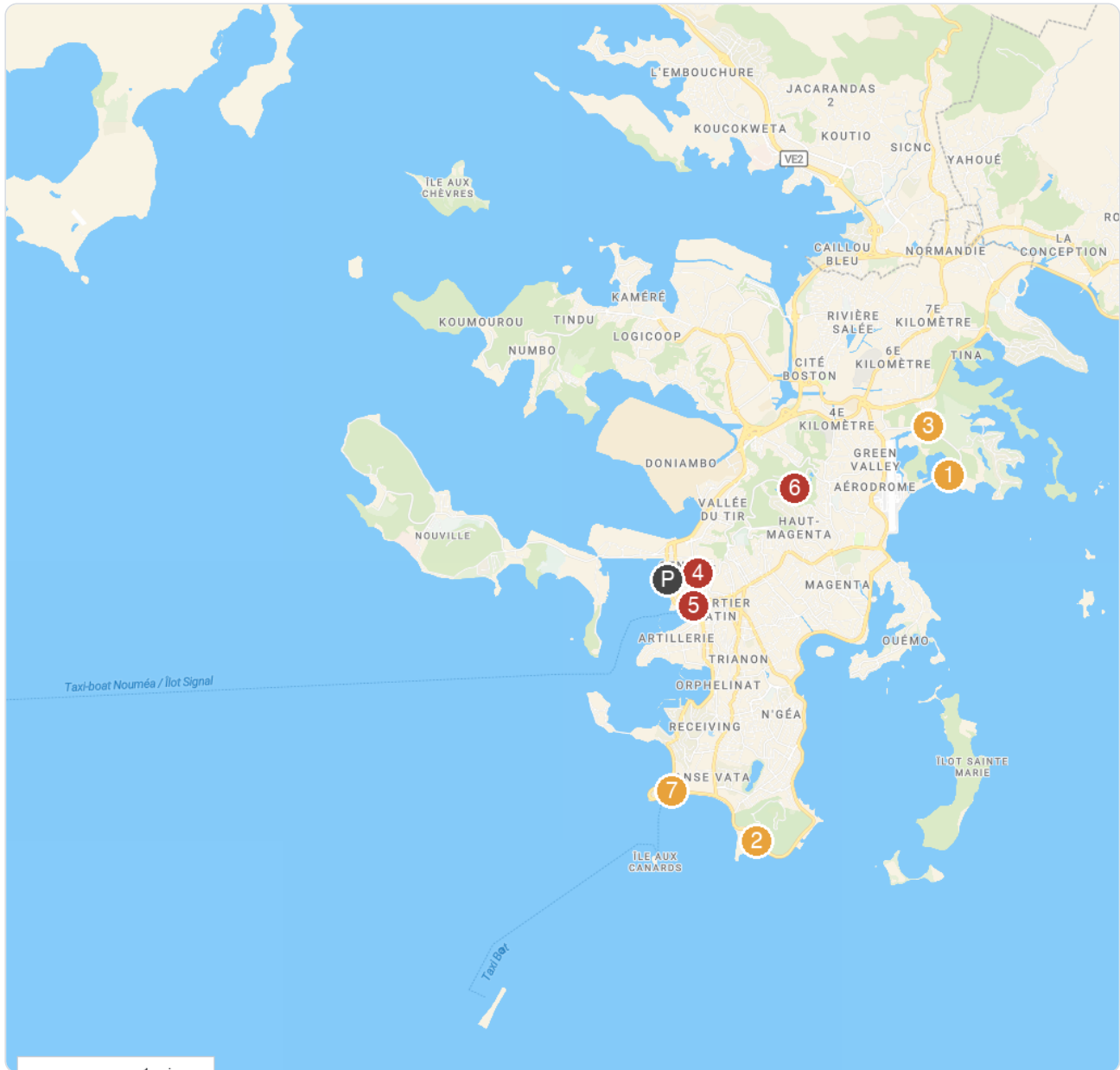
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
