

# Nuremberg, Bavaria, Germany

Bavaria's second city carries a dual identity — a fairy-tale medieval Altstadt rebuilt stone by stone after WWII, and the sobering courtroom where Nazi leaders faced justice. Few river cruise stops pack this much history into a single day.

## GETTING ASHORE

**Docking:** Docked on the Main-Danube Canal, ~5.5 km south of the Old Town

**Best For:** Medieval architecture, WWII history, Bavarian food, Christmas market (December)

**Getting to Center:** Cruise line shuttle (most lines; free or low-cost) or taxi ~15 min / €15–20

**Don't Miss:** Drei im Weckla (3 sausages in a roll) from a street kiosk at Hauptmarkt

## TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Memorium Nuremberg Trials (Courtroom 600)** — The actual courtroom where the International Military Tribunal tried Nazi leaders in 1945–1946.
- **Imperial Castle (Kaiserburg)** — The skyline-defining fortress that served as the seat of Holy Roman Emperors for centuries.
- **Old Town Walk: Hauptmarkt to Weissgerbergasse** — Start at the Gothic Schöner Brunnen fountain (spin the brass ring!), walk a couple of minutes to St.
- **Nazi Party Rally Grounds & Documentation Center** — The unfinished Congress Hall, designed to hold 50,000, now houses a sobering museum documenting the Third Reich's rise...
- **Albrecht Dürer's House** — One of Germany's finest Renaissance artists lived here from 1509 until his death.

## BEST WALKS

- **Hauptmarkt to Kaiserburg Loop** ~2 km · 45-60 min · Easy with one steep climb — Start at the Hauptmarkt, admire the Schöner Brunnen fountain and spin the brass ring for luck.
- **Way of Human Rights to Germanic National Museum** ~1 km · 20 min · Flat — A short, meaningful stroll along the outdoor installation of 30 white pillars, each inscribed with an article of the Universal...

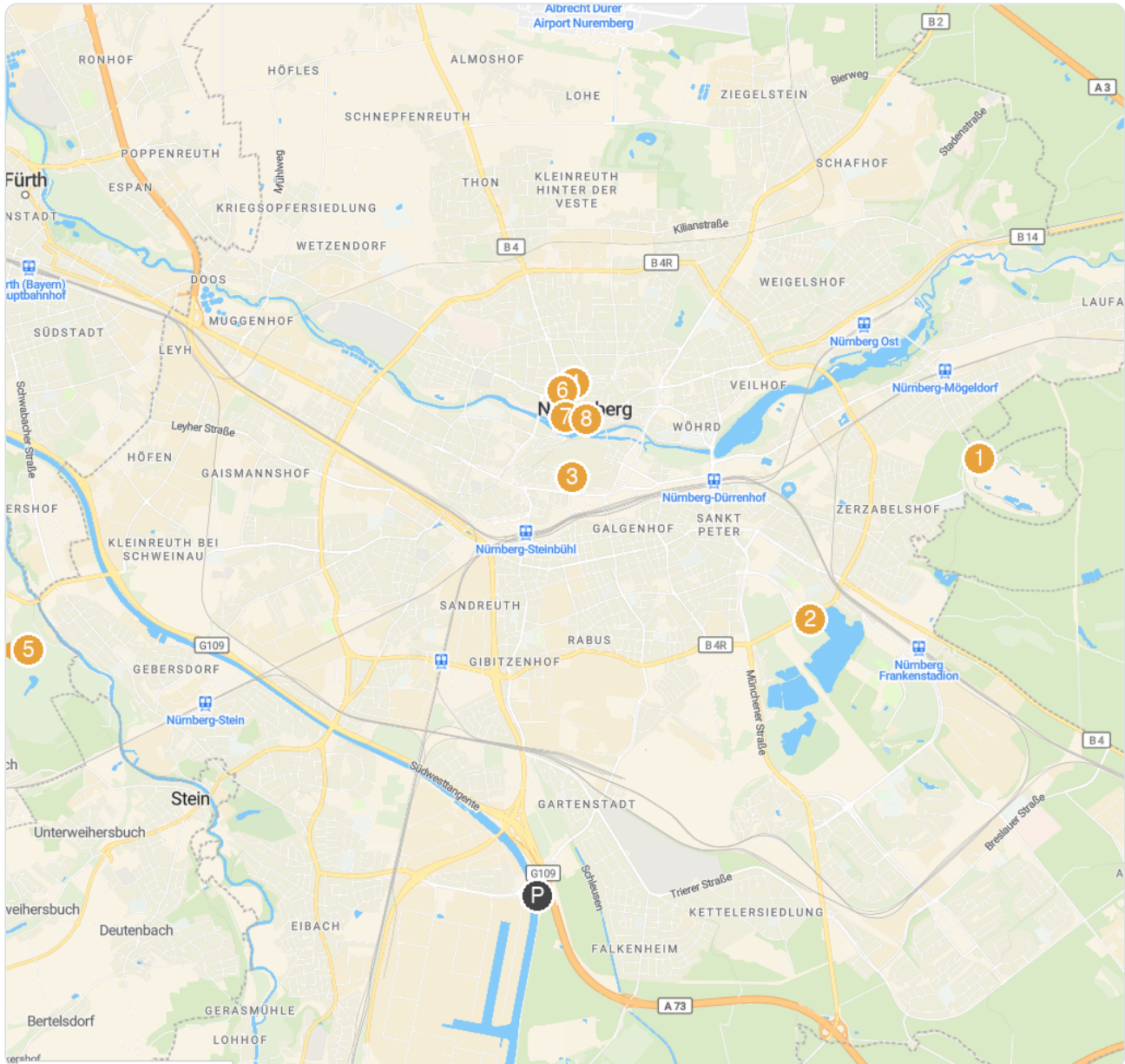
## KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
