GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Cruise Quay, Nyborg Havn (~1 km to town center)

Walk to center: 10-15 min (flat, scenic harbor walk)

Best For: Medieval history, Danish architecture, cycling, the Great Belt Bridge

Don't Miss: Brunsviger cake from a local bakery — Funen's signature sugar-glazed pastry

Getting around: **Taxi** 100–130 DKK (€13–17) · **Rideshare** Uber

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Nyborg Castle & Ramparts** — Walk to Denmark's oldest royal castle (12th century) where the Danehof — medieval parliament — met from the mid-13th...
- Borgmestergården Museum** — A beautifully preserved 17th-century half-timbered merchant's house in the heart of town, now a local history museum.
- Nyborg Destilleri Tour & Tasting** — Denmark's largest craft distillery occupies a restored railway workshop near the harbor.
- Day Trip to Odense** — The birthplace of Hans Christian Andersen is a direct 15-minute train ride from Nyborg Station (15-min walk from pier).
- Great Belt Bridge Viewpoint & Beach** — Cycle or walk east along the coast to Fyns Badestrand, a Blue Flag sandy beach right beside the Great Belt Bridge.

BEST WALKS

- Harbor to Castle & Ramparts** 1.5 km · 20-25 min · Easy — Walk north from the cruise quay along the harbor promenade, turn into the old town via Kongegade, pass the half-timbered houses to...
- Coastal Walk to Great Belt Beach** 2.5 km each way · 30 min · Easy (flat coastal path) — Head east from the harbor along the coastal path to Fyns Badestrand, a Blue Flag beach at the foot of the Great Belt Bridge.

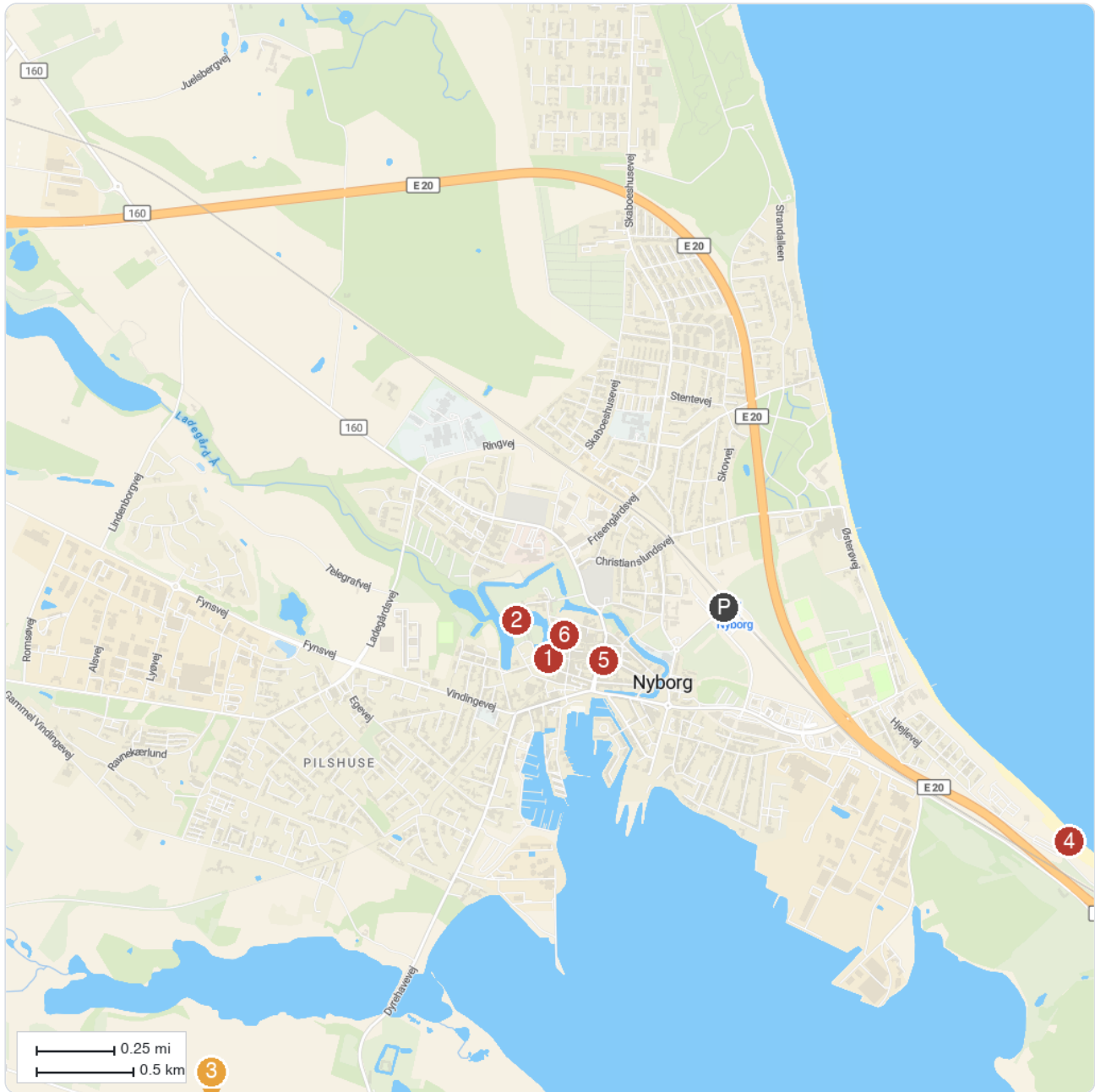
