GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Dedicated passenger pier on the Drava River promenade — no tender

Best For: Baroque history, Slavonian food & wine, wetland wildlife (Kopački Rit)

Walk to centre: 5–10 min to Gornji Grad; 15–20 min to Tvrd̂a fortress

Don't Miss: Tvrd̂a (Baroque citadel), Kopački Rit Nature Park boat tour, Fiš Paprikaš stew

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Tvrd̂a Baroque Citadel** — The best-preserved ensemble of Habsburg Baroque architecture in Croatia.
- Kopački Rit Nature Park** — One of Europe's largest river wetlands, just 15 minutes from the pier.
- Europska Avenija Architecture Walk** — Osijek holds one of Southeast Europe's finest collections of Secessionist (Art Nouveau) palaces, built 1890–1910.
- Slavonian Food & Wine Tasting** — Slavonia is Croatia's gastronomic heartland — sample EU-protected Kulen sausage, slow-cooked Čobanac stew, and...
- Kompa Ferry & Copacabana River Beach** — Cross the Drava on the Kompa — a hand-cranked cable ferry that uses only the river current.

BEST WALKS

- Promenade to Tvrd̂a** 2 km · 20 min · Easy — Head east from the pier along the Drava Promenade past the illuminated Pedestrian Bridge, then into the cobblestone streets of the...
- Upper Town Art Nouveau Circuit** 1.5 km · 20 min · Easy — Walk west from the pier to the Co-Cathedral of St.

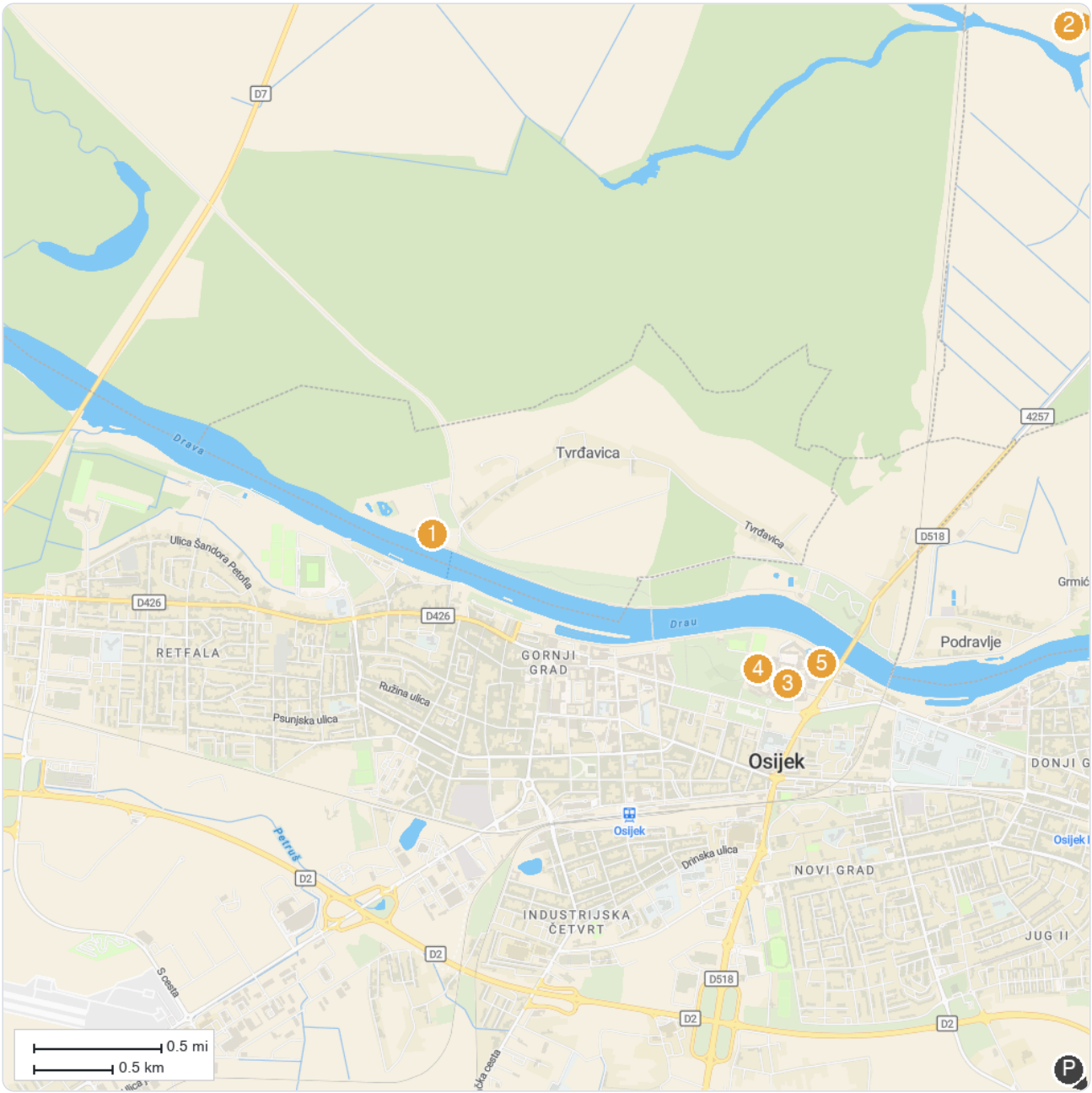
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Euro since 2023. Croatia adopted the Euro in January 2023. Cards are accepted widely, but carry a little cash for the Kompa ferry, tram tickets (~€1.50), and market stalls.
- Mosquitoes in summer. Proximity to the Kopački Rit wetlands means heavy mosquito activity June–August, especially at dusk. Pack repellent if visiting then.
