TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Vigeland Sculpture Park** — The world's largest sculpture park by a single artist — 200+ bronze and granite figures by Gustav Vigeland, crowned by...
- **Oslo Opera House & Roof Walk** — Climb the sloping Italian marble roof of the iconic Opera House and look out over the Oslofjord — one of Europe's great...
- **Bygdøy Museums (Fram, Kon-Tiki, Folk Museum)** — Amundsen's polar vessel Fram, Heyerdahl's Kon-Tiki raft, and a 160-building open-air folk museum with a genuine...
- **Akershus Fortress** — Medieval castle and royal chapel right at the cruise pier — 700 years of Norwegian history, a WWII Resistance Museum...
- **Oslofjord Sightseeing Cruise** — A relaxed 2-3 hour boat trip among the islands and summer cabins of the inner Oslofjord — a different angle on the city...

BEST WALKS

- **Akershus to the Opera House** ~3 km · 1.5 hrs · flat — From medieval Akershus Fortress above the pier, walk along the harbour past City Hall and the buzzing Aker Brygge waterfront, then...
- **Karl Johans gate — the Royal Mile** ~2 km · 1 hr · easy — Oslo's grand main avenue from Central Station up to the Royal Palace, past the cathedral, parliament, and National Theatre.
- **Tjuvholmen & Astrup Fearnley** ~1.5 km · 45 min · easy — The stylish waterfront tip of Aker Brygge — contemporary art museum, a small harbour beach, and some of Oslo's best outdoor dining...

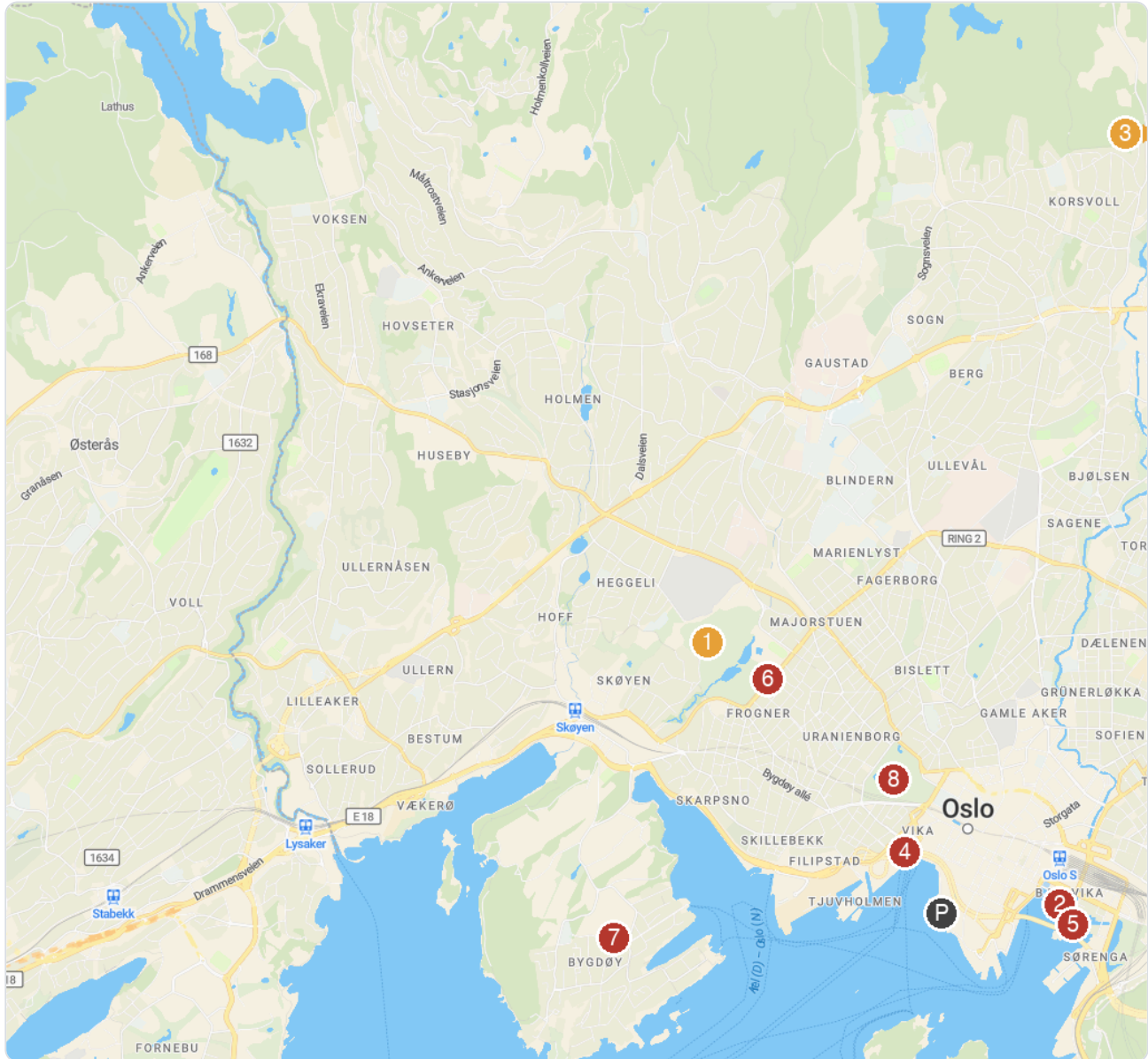
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
