TOP THINGS TO DO

- Otranto Cathedral & Martyrs Chapel** — The entire nave floor is covered by an extraordinary 12th-century mosaic — a 'medieval visual encyclopaedia' depicting...
- Aragonese Castle** — This hulking 15th-century fortress dominates the harbor, built by the Aragonese after the Ottoman siege.
- Cava di Bauxite (Red Lake)** — A disused open-air bauxite mine about 2.5 km south of the port where a vivid emerald lake has formed against striking...
- Baia dei Turchi Beach** — Six kilometres north of Otranto, this wild pine-fringed beach is where the Ottoman fleet landed in 1480 — today the...
- Day Trip to Lecce** — Known as the 'Florence of the South', Lecce is 35–40 minutes away and packed with lavish Baroque architecture carved...

BEST WALKS

- Old Town & Cathedral Loop** 1–1.5 hrs · Easy · 1.5 km · Flat — From the harbor, follow the lungomare to Porta Alfonsina and enter the old town.
- Coastal Walk to the Bauxite Lake** 2.5 hrs round trip · Moderate · 5 km · Some uneven ground — Head south along the coastal path from the port toward Punta Palascia.
