GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Estació Marítima (Moll de Ponent), ~3-5 km from old town; shuttle, Bus 1, water taxi, or waterfront walk

Best For: Cathedral, hidden patios, Sóller vintage train, beaches, Mallorcan tapas

Walk to centre: 35-45 min on foot along the promenade, or 10 min by taxi/shuttle (~€12-€15)

Don't Miss: La Seu Cathedral at golden hour + Can Joan de S'Aigo pastry cafe (est. 1700)

Getting around: **Taxi** €11–12 · **Rideshare** Uber, Bolt · **Hop-on hop-off** City Sightseeing

TOP THINGS TO DO

- La Seu Cathedral & Almudaina Palace** — Palma’s Gothic cathedral rises directly above the sea with one of the world’s largest rose windows and a...
 - Sóller Vintage Train & Tram** — Board the 1912 wooden Red Lightning train from Palma’s Plaça d’Espanya station and wind through orange-grove valleys...
 - Serra de Tramuntana Scenic Drive** — This UNESCO World Heritage mountain range delivers dramatic coastal cliffs,
- ancient olive groves, and stone villages.

 - Old Town Patios & Arab Baths** — Explore the Casc Antic’s lanes to discover hidden aristocratic courtyards (patios mallorquines) open to visitors.
 - Caves of Drach** — East-coast cave complex near Porto Cristo with spectacular stalactites and Lake Martel, one of the world’s largest...

- Waterfront to Cathedral & Old Town Loop** ⌚ 1.5-2 hrs · 🚶 Easy · 📷 Best photo walk — Start at Plaça de la Reina and follow the seafront Passeig des Born to La Seu Cathedral.
- Passeig des Born & Santa Catalina** ⌚ 1-1.5 hrs · 🚶 Easy · 🍷 Food & culture — Stroll the elegant Passeig des Born lined with mansions and boutiques, stop at the Casal Solleric (free art gallery in a Baroque...
- Bellver Castle Hilltop** ⌚ 2 hrs · 🚶 Moderate (uphill) · 🏰 Panoramic views — Take Bus Line 46 or a taxi to the base, then walk up to Bellver Castle — a rare circular Gothic castle from 1311 with sweeping views...

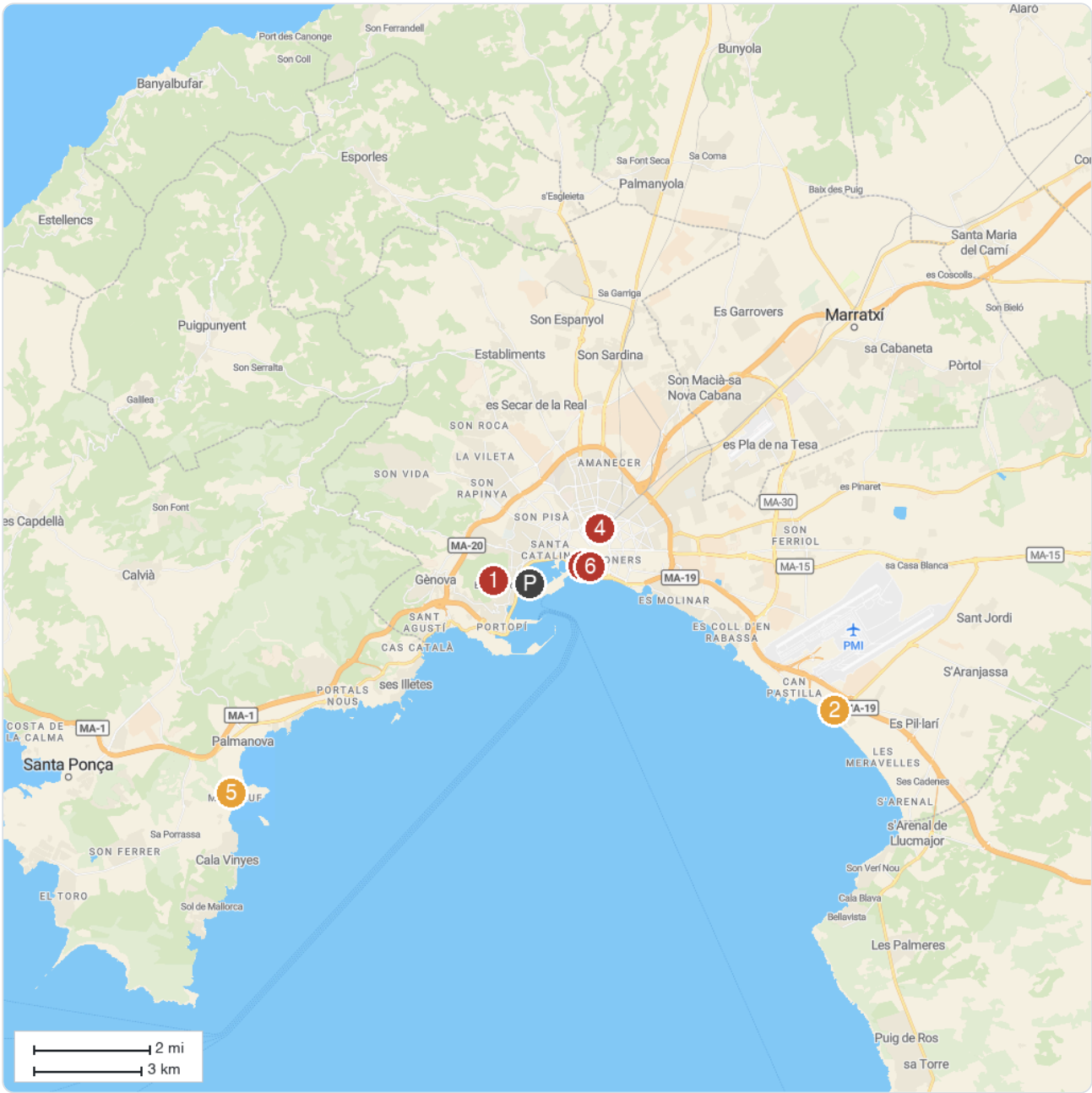
