GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in the bay; boats drop passengers at the town harbor (Limanaki)

Best For: Beach days, castle views, Venetian old town, Epirus cuisine

Walk to center: 0 min — tender pier lands you directly on the harbor promenade

Don't Miss: The Panagia Islet and a water taxi to Valtos Beach

- Venetian Castle of Parga** — A free 10–15 min uphill walk rewards with sweeping panoramas over the bay, Valtos Beach, and the Panagia Islet.

 - Ali Pasha Castle (Anthousa)** — Built by the Ottoman ruler Ali Pasha on a commanding hilltop 5 km outside town to

 - Valtos Beach Day** — A wide arc of golden-pebble sand with crystal-clear Ionian water, beach bars, and water sports rentals.
 - Parga Old Town & Olive Oil Tasting** — Wander the Tourkopazaro — narrow cobblestone lanes climbing toward the castle, draped in bougainvillea and lined with...

BEST WALKS

- Harbor to Venetian Castle** 1.5 km round trip | 30–45 min | Moderate (steep steps) — From the Limanaki tender pier, walk along the waterfront promenade, then follow the cobblestone steps winding up through the old town...
- Krioneri & Piso Krioneri Beaches** 0.5 km one way | 5–10 min | Easy (flat) — Step off the tender and walk 3 minutes to Krioneri Beach, the town beach facing the Panagia Islet.
