- **Eiffel Tower & Trocadéro** — Ride the lift to the second floor (or summit) for panoramic views, then cross Pont d'Iéna for the classic Trocadéro...
 - **Louvre Museum** — The world's largest art museum houses the Mona Lisa, Venus de Milo, and thousands more.
 - **Palace of Versailles Day Trip** — Louis XIV's opulent palace and its formal gardens sit 30 minutes by RER C from central Paris.
- **Musée d'Orsay & Impressionists** — Housed in a Beaux-Arts railway station, the Orsay holds the world's finest collection of Impressionist and...
 - **Marais & Le Bon Marché Food Walk** — Wander the medieval Marais quarter — Place des Vosges, the Jewish Quarter's falafel shops on Rue des Rosiers, and the...

BEST WALKS

- **Left Bank Riverside Walk** 5 km · ~1.25 hr · Flat — Follow the Seine east from the dock past the Eiffel Tower, Pont Alexandre III, and the Musée d'Orsay to the Tuileries Garden opposite...
- **Île de la Cité & Notre-Dame** 3 km · ~1 hr · Easy — Cross to the islands at the heart of Paris — Île de la Cité for Notre-Dame Cathedral (reopened 2024, exterior dazzling), the...

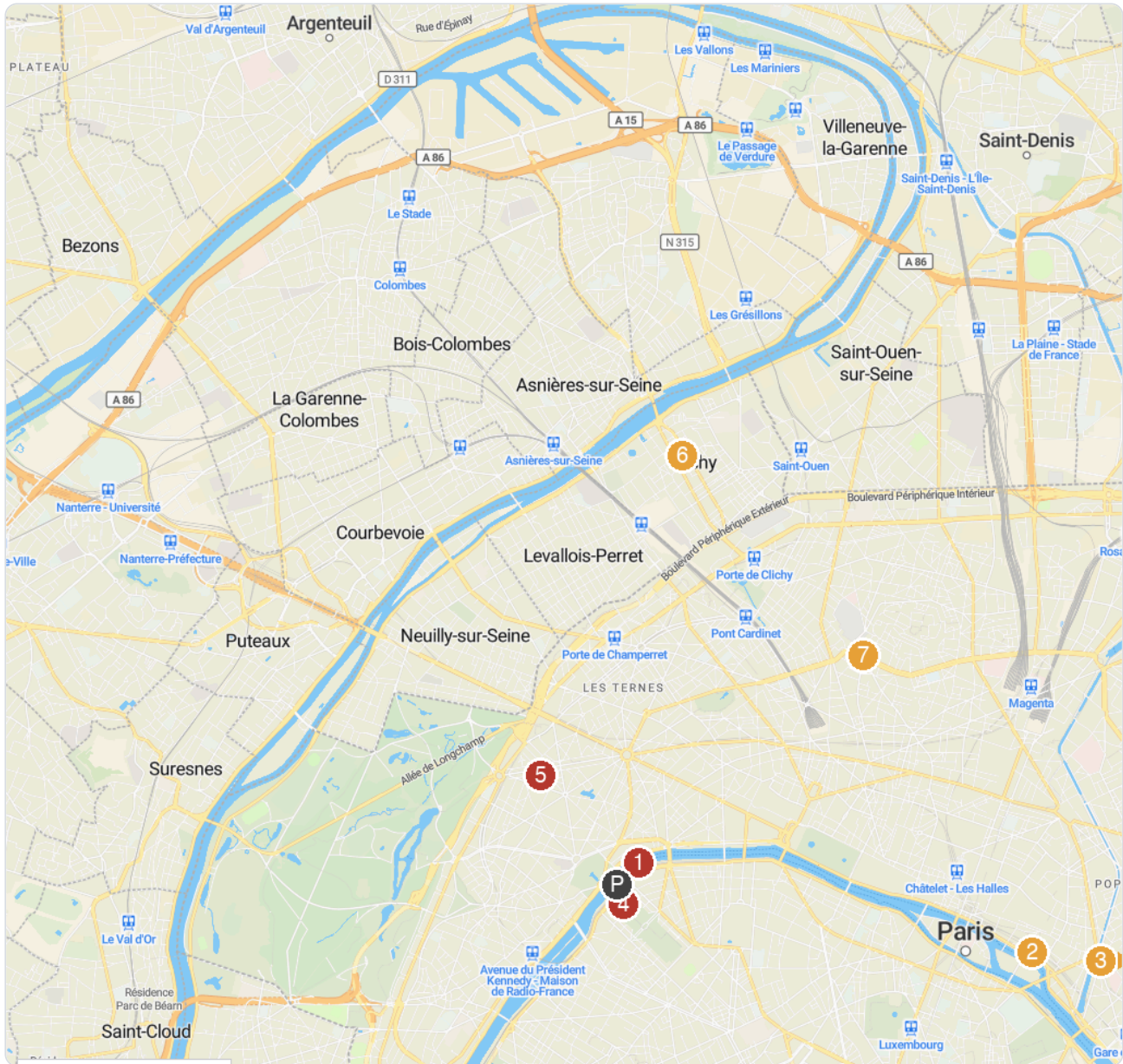
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book big attractions in advance. The Eiffel Tower, Louvre, and Versailles all require timed-entry tickets — walk-up queues in summer can mean 2+ hour waits or sold-out days.
- Metro beats walking for cross-city trips. A single-ride t+ ticket costs €2.15; a 1-day Navigo Easy pass covering zones 1-5 (covers Versailles) runs ~€20.60.
