GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River quay — always docked, no tender. Old Town piers are steps from the center; the outlying Racklau berth is ~2 km downriver with shuttle.

Best For: Architecture, organ music, river scenery, Bavarian food & beer

Walk to center: 1–5 min from Altstadt piers; ~25 min (or free shuttle) from the Racklau berth

Don't Miss: Noon organ concert at Dom St. Stephan — book early, largest cathedral organ in the world

 Getting around:  Taxi  €10–€20 ·  Rideshare  Uber

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Dom St. Stephan Noon Organ Concert** — St. Ilz, and the blue-brown Danube visibly refuse...
- **Veste Oberhaus Fortress** — The 13th-century hilltop fortress looms over the river confluence with spectacular panoramic views and a well-curated...
- **Dreiflüsseck — Three Rivers Corner** — Walk to the peninsula's eastern tip where the milky-green Inn, the dark
- **Glass Museum Passau** — The world's largest collection of Bohemian glass — from Baroque to Art Nouveau — filling 35 rooms of the historic Hotel...
- **Danube Cycle Path Ride** — Passau sits at the start of the famous Donauradweg.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town Loop** 1.5 km · 30–40 min · Easy (mostly flat) — Stroll the heart of Passau's peninsula: the Baroque cathedral, the Rathaus flood markers, Höllgasse artists' alley, and out to the...
- **Fortress Hike** 1.2 km uphill · 20–25 min each way · Moderate — Climb the Ludwigsteig forest path from the old town up to Veste Oberhaus for sweeping views over all three rivers.
- **Mariahilf Pilgrimage Steps** 321 steps · 15 min · Moderate — Cross the Inn River bridge and climb the covered Wallfahrtstiege staircase to the pilgrimage church on the hill.

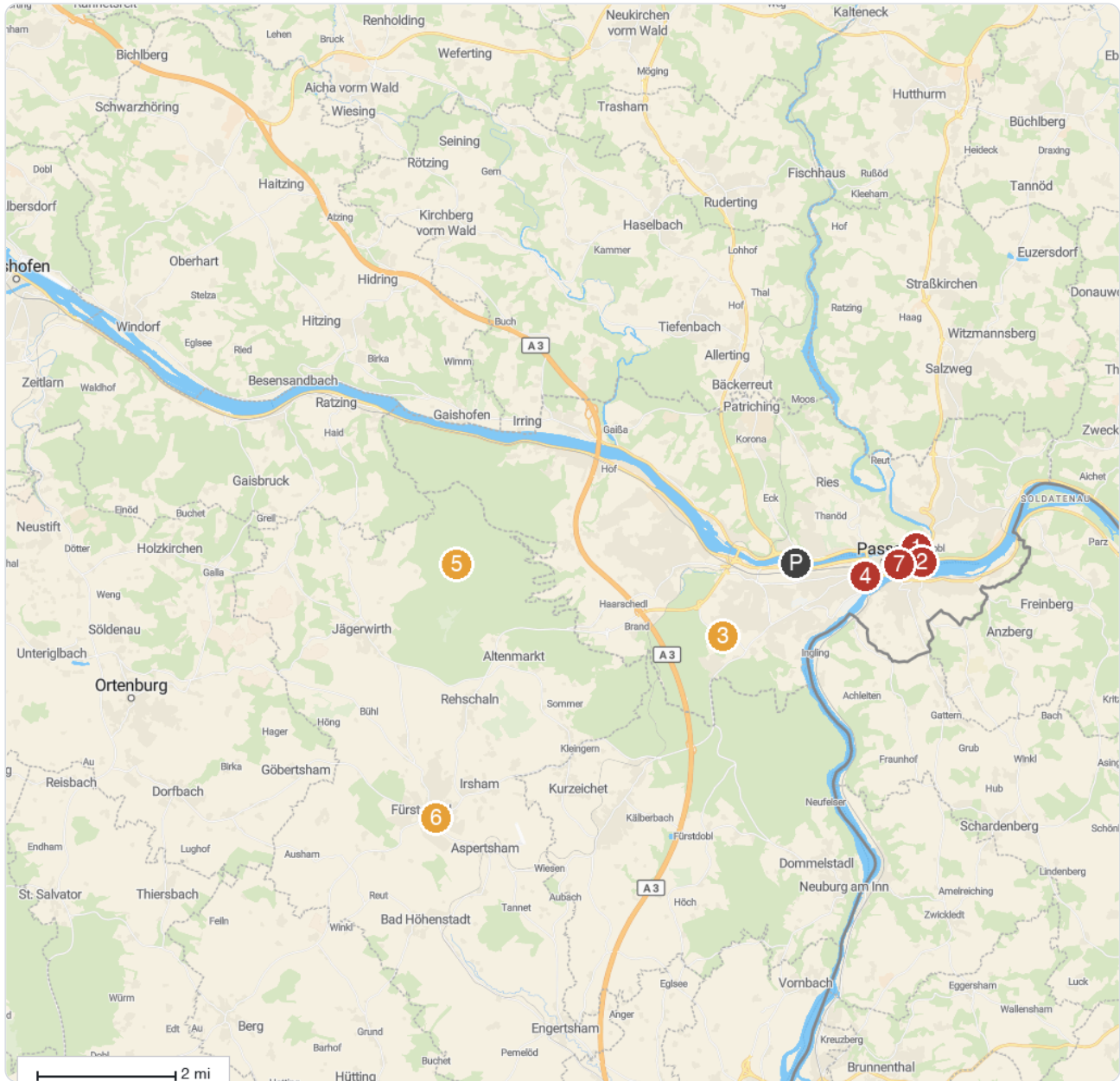
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
