GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pauillac-Trompelooup pier (opened 2024, up to 320 m vessels); very large ships may tender to central Quai Léon Perrier

Walk to centre: ~20 min walk or short taxi/shuttle from the new pier; tender dock is right in town

Best For: Wine lovers, château visits, Bordeaux day trips, cyclists

Don't Miss: Village de Bages — a beautifully restored wine hamlet with bakery, bistro, and bike hire

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Route des Châteaux by Bike** — Hire an e-bike from Village de Bages or the tourist office and pedal the flat D2 road past Pichon Baron, Pichon...
- **Grand Cru Château Tour & Tasting** — Pre-booked visits to Château Lynch-Bages, Mouton Rothschild (with its famous artist-label museum), or Château Pichon...
- **Bordeaux City Day Trip** — A 50 km drive or one-hour train ride delivers you into a UNESCO World Heritage city.
- **Citadel of Blaye by Ferry** — A short ferry across the Gironde reaches Blaye's massive 17th-century Vauban fortification — a UNESCO monument with...
- **Pauillac Lamb & Wine Lunch** — Pauillac AOC lamb (milk-fed, extraordinarily tender) paired with a Médoc Cru Classé is one of France's great regional...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront Promenade to Village de Bages** 4 km round-trip · flat · ~1 hr · easy — Head south along the riverfront quay past the Lafayette monument (commemorating the Marquis de Lafayette, who set sail for the...
- **Town Centre Stroll** 1–2 km · 30 min · very easy — From the quay walk a few blocks inland to the Église Saint-Martin, a 19th-century neo-classical church with a remarkable boat ex-voto...

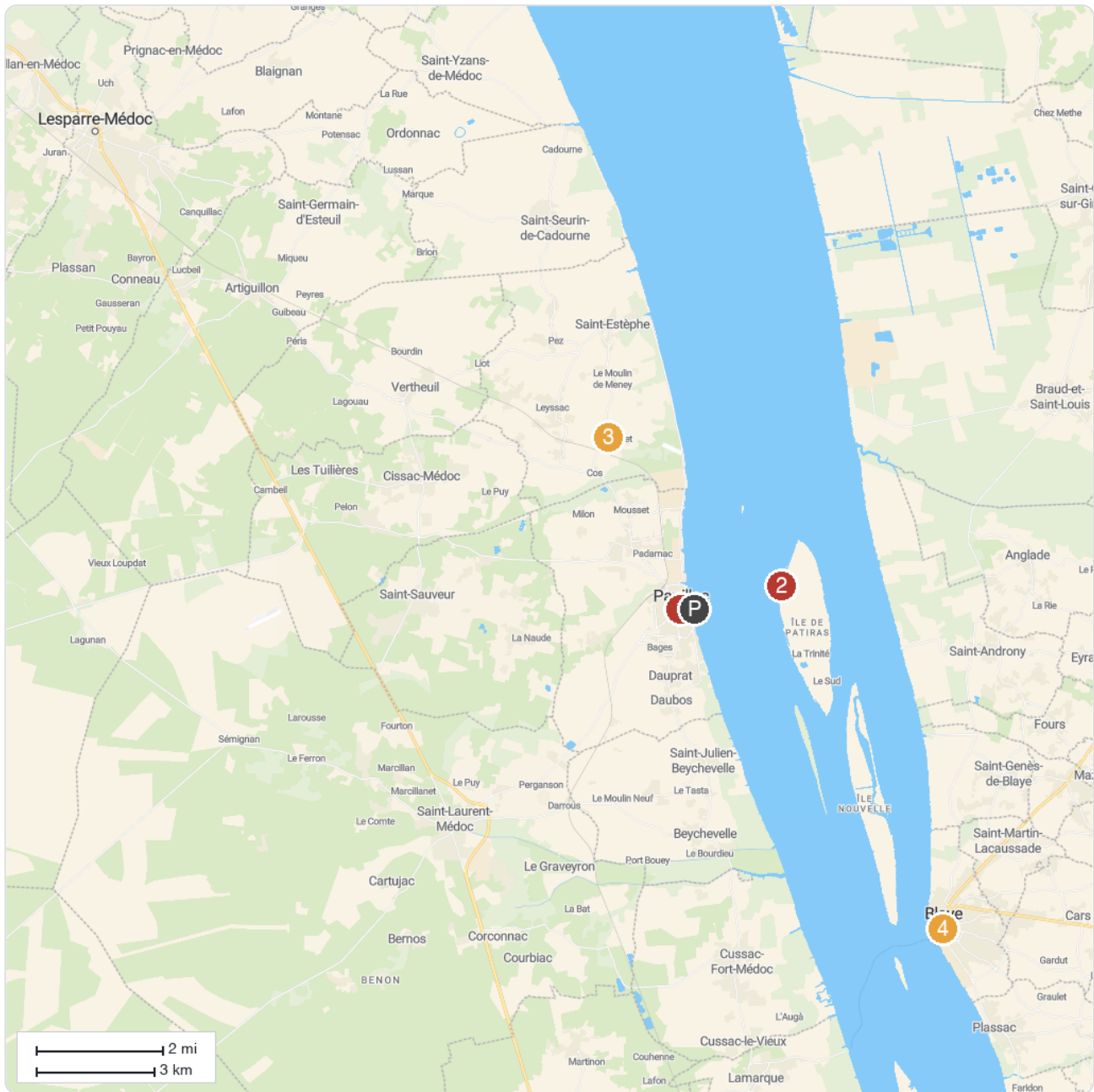
