TOP THINGS TO DO

- **V-2 Rocket Museum (HTM Peenemünde)** — The headline attraction: the Historisch-Technisches Museum occupies the former WWII power station that fueled the...
- **U-461 Soviet Submarine Museum** — A Juliett-class Soviet ballistic-missile submarine — the largest conventional sub in the world — sits in the harbor and...
- **Karlshagen Beach by Train** — Usedom is home to some of Germany's finest Baltic beaches.
- **Zinnowitz Seaside Resort** — Hop the train south to Zinnowitz, a graceful 19th-century Seebad (seaside resort) with ornate beach villas and a famous...
- **Bicycle Ride on the Baltic Bike Path** — Rent a bike at the harbor and explore the flat Usedom coastal path.

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor to History Walk** 1.5 km · 20 min · Flat & paved — A simple linear walk from the pier through the harbor waterfront to the Historical Technical Museum.

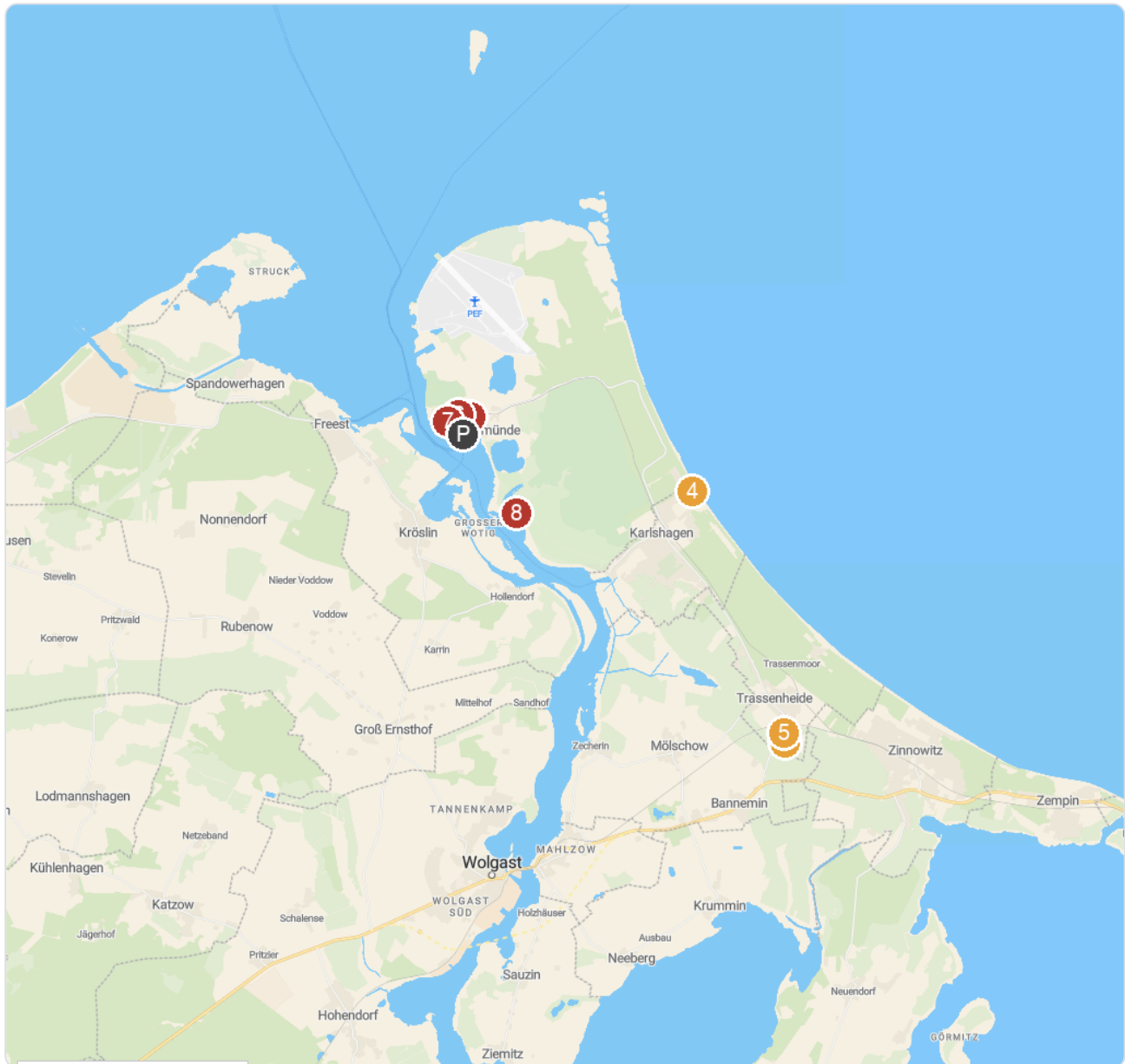
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Carry cash. Northern Germany is still very cash-dependent — Fischbrötchen stalls, train tickets, and smaller museum cafés often don't accept cards.
- Stay on marked paths. The forests and dunes around Peenemünde were heavily bombed in WWII. Unexploded ordnance (Munitionsbelastung) signs are real warnings — heed them and don't...
- The UBB train is your friend. Hourly service runs along the whole island. It's cheap, punctual, and opens up Karlshagen, Zinnowitz, and other resorts for beyond-walking ranges.
