TOP THINGS TO DO

- **National Naval Aviation Museum** — One of the largest aviation museums in the world, with 150+ restored aircraft including the Blue Angels' famous diamond...
- **Pensacola Beach Day** — Head across the bridge to Santa Rosa Island for some of the whitest, softest sand in the USA — pure quartz that squeaks...
- **Fort Pickens & Gulf Islands National Seashore** — A massive 19th-century brick fort on the tip of Santa Rosa Island that once held Apache leader Geronimo.
- **Historic Pensacola Village** — One ticket covers several museums in the Seville Historic District, including the T.T.
- **Gulf Coast Seafood & Palafox Street** — Walk Palafox Street, one of America's great main streets, then settle in at The Fish House or Atlas Oyster House for...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to Palafox Street Loop** 1.5 miles · 30-40 min · Flat · Easy — From Plaza de Luna, walk north along the waterfront past the Maritime Park, then up to Palafox Street for shops, galleries, and lunch.

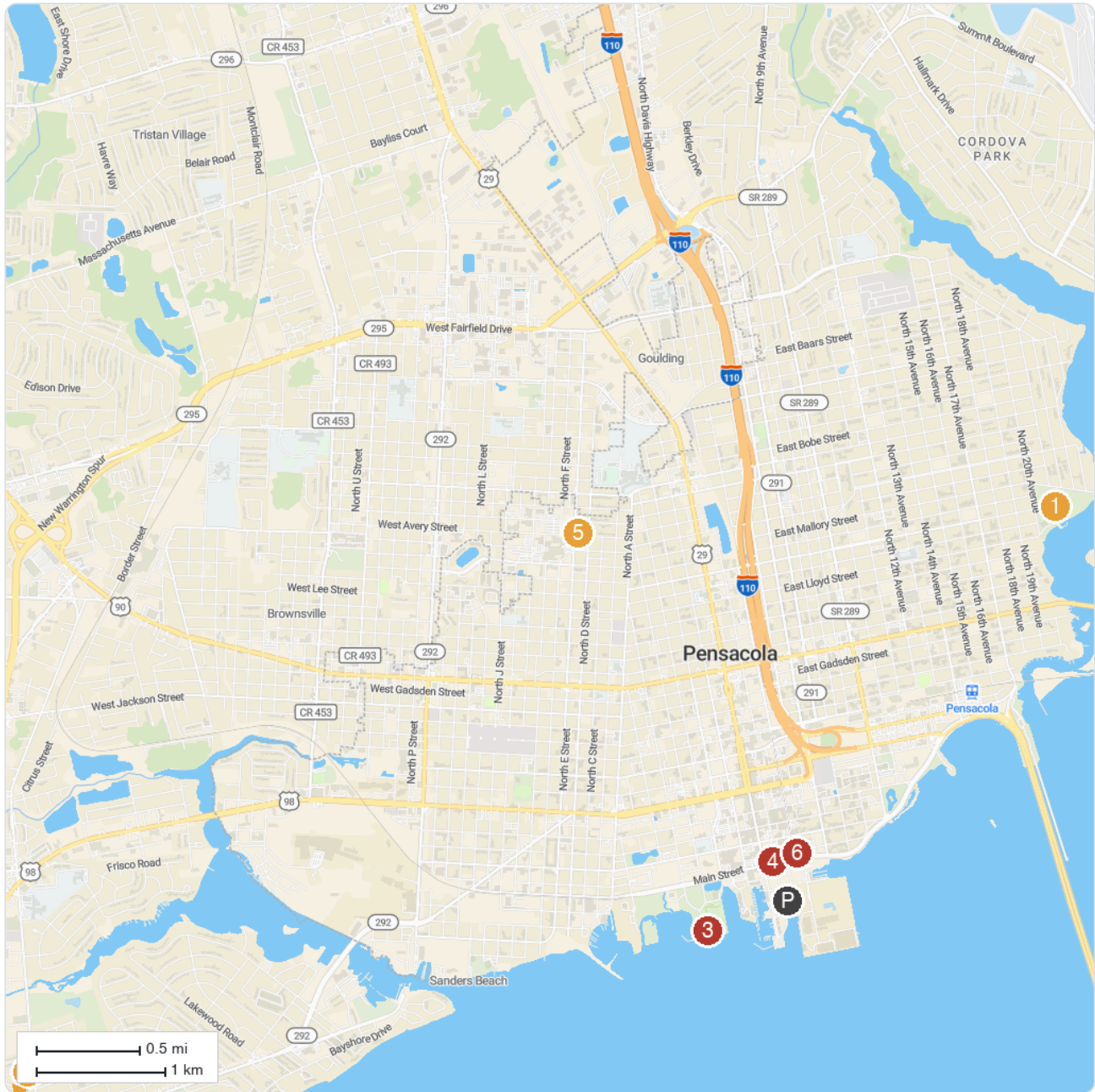
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Military base ID check: The Naval Aviation Museum and Pensacola Lighthouse are on NAS Pensacola. Bring a REAL ID-compliant driver's license or passport — non-US citizens should...
- Beaches require a ride: Pensacola Beach is 6+ miles across the bay — not walkable. Uber/Lyft are reliable and run about \$15-20 each way. Budget time for the round trip.
- White sand means double the UV: The quartz sand reflects sunlight intensely. Apply more sunscreen than you think you need and bring a hat — burns happen fast here.
