GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Waitohi Wharf (central) or Waimahara Wharf (Shakespeare Bay, shuttle provided)

Best For: Scenic Sound cruises, Marlborough wine tours, coastal walks, wildlife

Walk to Centre: 0-5 min from Waitohi Wharf; ~10 min shuttle + walk from Waimahara

Don't Miss: The sail-in through Queen Charlotte Sound — be on deck early

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Queen Charlotte Sound Scenic Cruise** — Glide through the deep, bush-fringed bays and coves of Queen Charlotte Sound with commentary on wildlife and history.
- **Marlborough Wine & Sauvignon Blanc Tour** — Picton is the gateway to Marlborough — New Zealand's most celebrated wine region.
- **Motuara Island Bird Sanctuary** — A water taxi takes you to this predator-free island sanctuary where you can spot South Island robin, saddleback, and...
- **Edwin Fox Maritime Museum** — See the Edwin Fox — one of the world's oldest surviving merchant sailing ships (built 1853) and the only surviving...
- **Queen Charlotte Track Day Walk** — Water taxis drop you at Ship Cove (Meretoto) — Captain Cook's favourite New Zealand anchorage — for a guided or...

BEST WALKS

- **Foreshore Promenade & Town Stroll** 1-2 km • 20-30 min • Flat • Free — Walk the picturesque waterfront from the cruise wharf along the marina to Picton town centre.
- **Bob's Bay Track** 2 km return • 45 min • Easy-moderate • Free — A short but rewarding bush walk from Picton town to secluded Bob's Bay — a quiet, sheltered cove with clear water and native forest.
- **Harbour Lookout Walk** 1.5 km return • 30 min • Moderate (uphill) • Free — A short uphill track from the town centre rewards you with wide views over Picton Harbour, the Marlborough Sounds, and your ship.

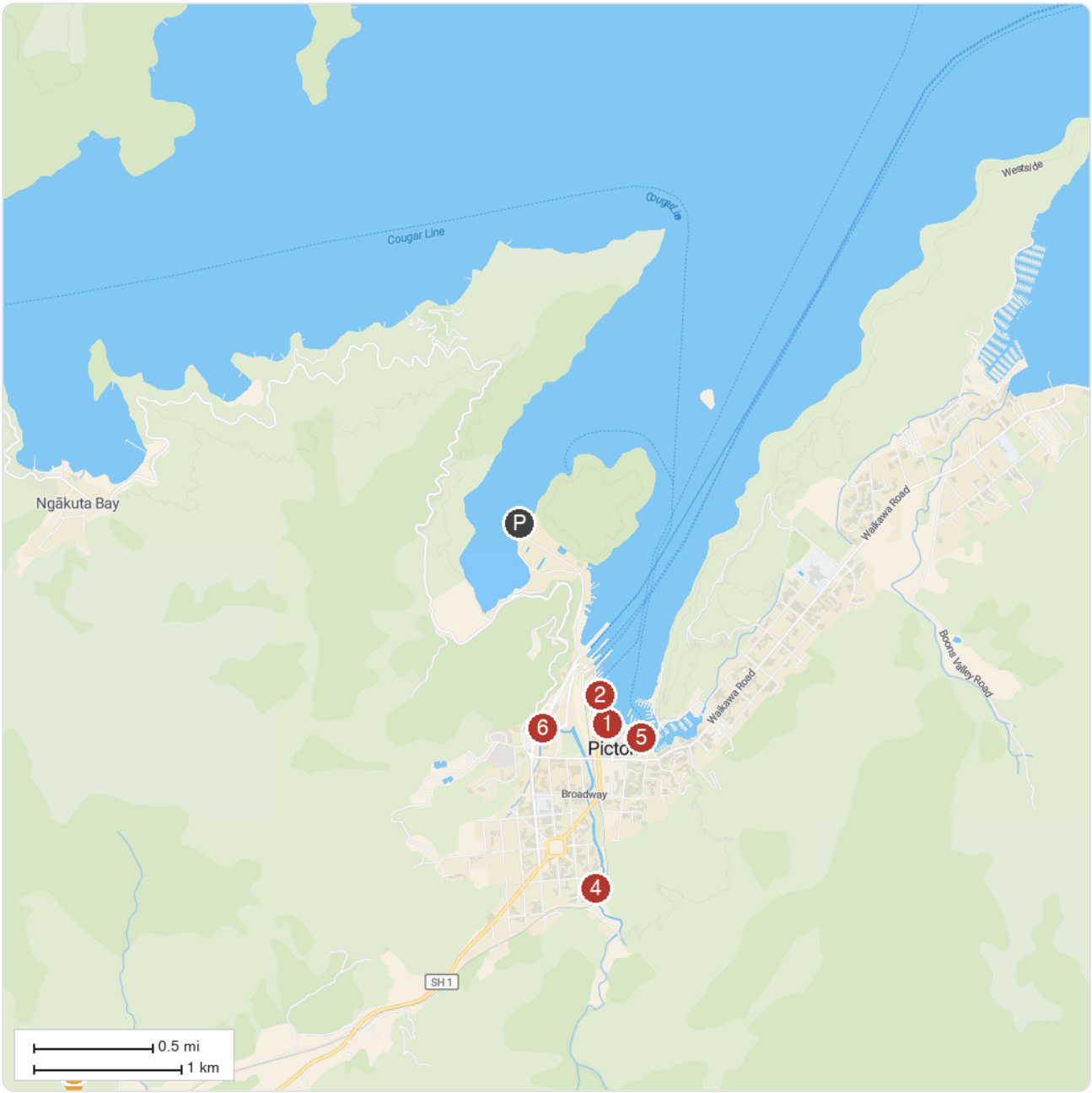
