- **Addo Elephant National Park** — Home to over 600 African elephants plus buffalo, lion, rhino, and hippo, Addo is 72 km from port and absolutely worth...
- **Kragga Kamma Game Park** — A compact private reserve just 20 minutes from port with rhino, giraffe, zebra, cheetah, and more.
- **Bayworld Museum Complex** — A beachfront complex in Humewood combining the Port Elizabeth Museum (natural and cultural history) and the historic...
- **Beachfront Boardwalk & Hobie Beach** — PE's kilometre-long beachfront boardwalk runs from Humewood to Hobie Beach — one of the best swimming beaches on the...
- **Donkin Reserve & Victorian Heritage Walk** — The hilltop Donkin Reserve overlooks the city and harbour with a distinctive stone pyramid built in 1820.

BEST WALKS

- **Donkin Reserve to Market Square** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy — Start at the Donkin Reserve on the hill for panoramic harbour views, then walk down through the Victorian terrace rows to Market...
- **Kings Beach to Hobie Beach Boardwalk** 2 km · 40 min · Flat — A classic beachfront stroll along the Indian Ocean.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use Rand, not USD. South Africa is excellent value when you exchange to ZAR. Airport-style bureaux near the terminal are fine; avoid unofficial street exchangers.
- Addo is a full day — book in advance. It fills up fast on ship days. Only go with a ship-organised tour or pre-confirmed private operator with guaranteed port return.
- Use Bolt, not street taxis. The Bolt rideshare app works well in PE and pricing is transparent. Download it before you arrive and top
