- **Petronas Twin Towers & KLCC** — The defining image of modern Malaysia — twin 88-floor steel-and-glass spires connected by a sky bridge on the 41st floor.
- **Batu Caves** — A series of vast limestone caves sheltering one of the most important Hindu shrines outside India.
- **Merdeka Square & Colonial KL** — The grand open square where Malaysia's independence flag was first raised, flanked by the colonial-era Sultan Abdul...
- **Chinatown (Petaling Street) & Central Market** — The covered Petaling Street market is KL's famous Chinatown — haggle for souvenirs, eat char kway teow at a hawker...
- **KL Tower (Menara KL)** — The 421-metre telecommunications tower on Bukit Nanas hill offers a 360° observation deck above the KL skyline — a...

BEST WALKS

- **Golden Triangle: KLCC to Bukit Bintang** ~2.5 km · 1–2 hrs · easy — Walk KL's glitzy core — from the Petronas Twin Towers through KLCC Park, along Jalan Ampang, and into the Bukit Bintang shopping and...
- **Historic Heart: Merdeka Square to Chinatown** ~1.5 km · 1 hr · easy — Stroll from the colonial grandeur of Merdeka Square past Masjid Jamek, through the Kasturi Walk market, and into the heart of...

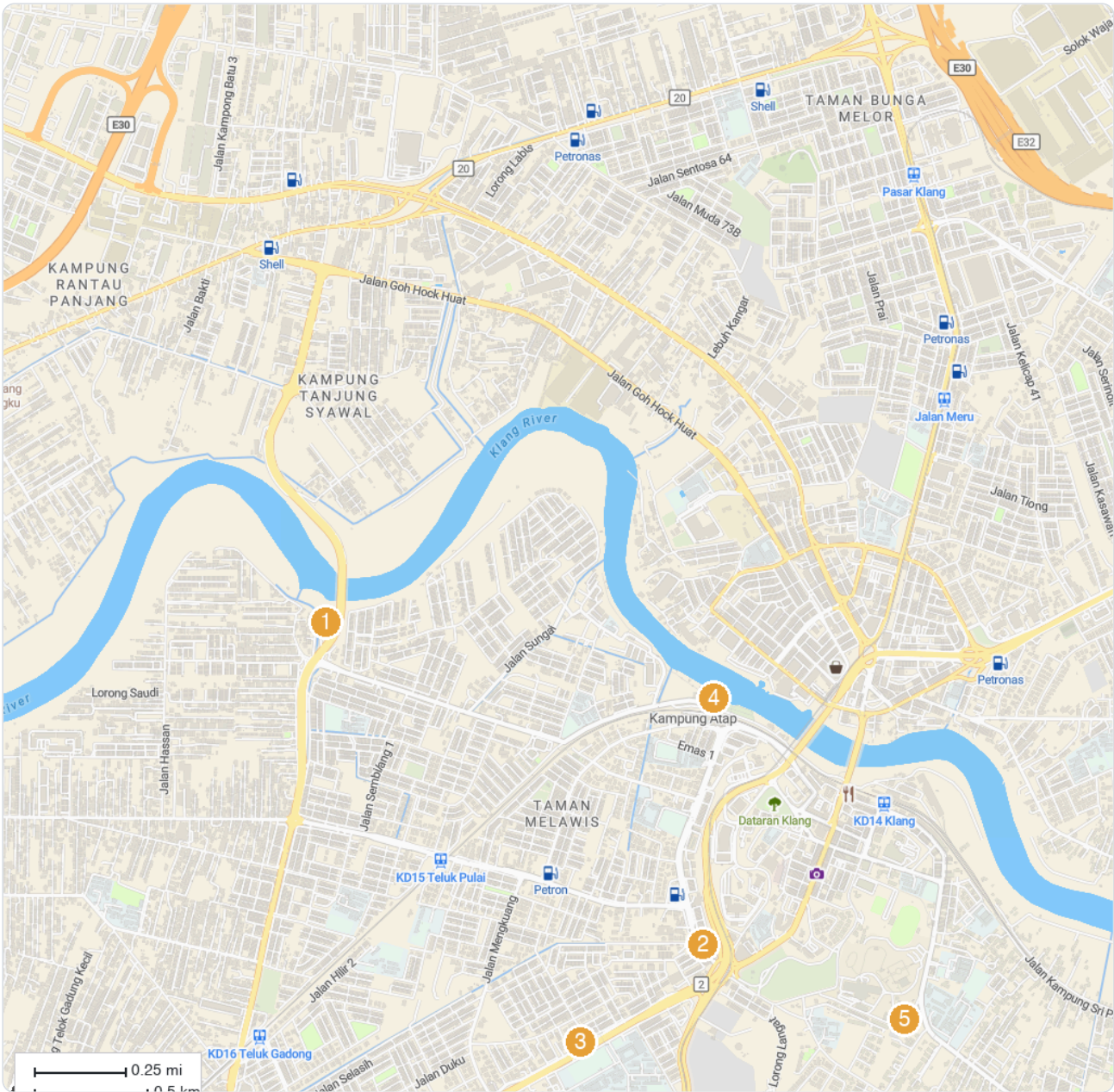
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Transfer time eats your day. Budget 1–1.5 hrs each way to KL. On a 9-hr call that leaves 6–7 hrs in the city — enough for two sights maximum. Don't try to do everything.
- Use Grab, not street taxis. Grab (the regional ride-share app) shows the price upfront and is far cheaper than unmetered taxis. Download it before you arrive.
- Dress modestly for religious sites. Batu Caves and the Blue Mosque require covered shoulders and knees. Sarongs are available
