GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier for ships ≤215 m; tender for larger vessels

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Benagil Sea Cave RIB Tour** — The famous cathedral cave at Benagil is one of the most photographed spots in Europe.
- Praia da Rocha Beach Day** — About 2.5 km from the pier (a 30-minute walk or a short taxi/bus ride) lies one of Portugal's finest beaches: wide...
- Ferragudo Village Water-Taxi Excursion** — Hop a water taxi (€3–5, 5 minutes) from the marina to Ferragudo — a whitewashed fishing village that feels untouched by...
- Silves Moorish Castle** — Twenty minutes inland, the red sandstone castle of Silves is the best-preserved Moorish fortification in Portugal.
- Sardine Lunch on the Riverfront** — Portimão is the sardine capital of the Algarve.

BEST WALKS

- Pier to Praia da Rocha & Fort of Santa Catarina** 2.5 km · 30 min · Flat · Free — Follow the paved riverside path south from the cruise terminal toward the beach.
- Riverfront Stroll to the Old Town** 2.5 km · 30 min · Flat · Free — Head north along the Ribeirinha promenade — a palm-lined riverside walkway with benches and cafes.

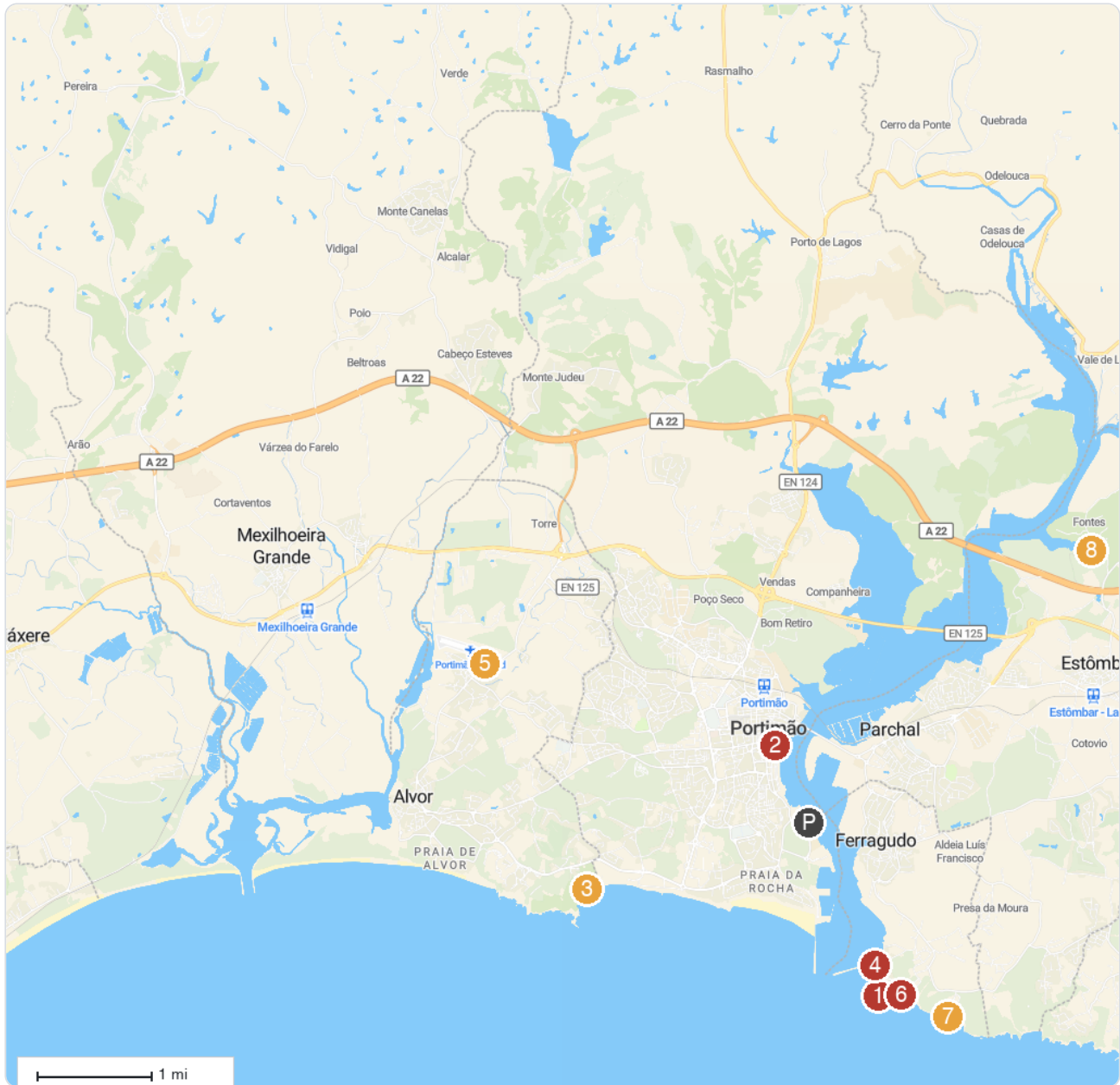
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Sun protection is essential. The Algarve sun is intense even in spring. The walks to the beach and city center have minimal shade — wear sunscreen, a hat, and bring water.
- Wear sturdy shoes. The old town uses traditional Portuguese calcada cobblestones — beautiful but slippery. Skin sandals or
