- **Portland Food Cart Pods** — Portland invented the food cart pod culture.
- **International Rose Test Garden** — Portland is the 'City of Roses' for good reason.
- **Willamette River Jet Boat Tour** — High-speed jet boats depart from downtown Portland on the Willamette and Columbia Rivers, reaching speeds of 45 mph...

BEST WALKS

- **Tom McCall Waterfront Park Stroll** 2 miles · Flat · 45 min — Start downtown along the Willamette and follow the paved riverside path through Tom McCall Waterfront Park, past the Salmon Street...
- **Pearl District & Powell's Loop** 2.5 miles · Flat · 1 hr — From downtown, walk into the Pearl District — Portland's upscale arts neighborhood filled with galleries, cafes, and boutiques.

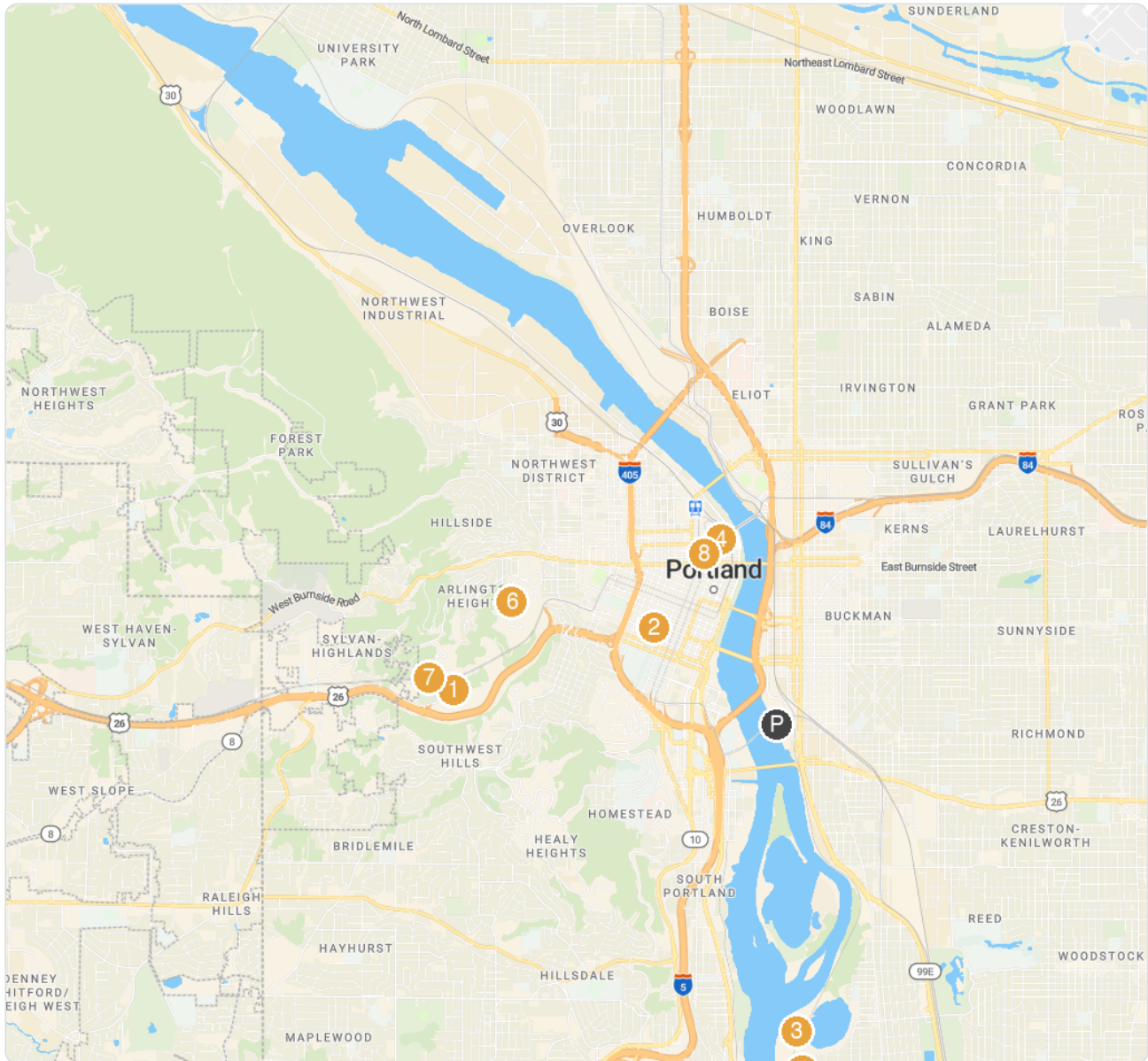
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
