

Porto Santo Island, Madeira, Portugal

Forty-three kilometres northeast of Madeira and a world apart — Porto Santo is all golden sand, volcanic peaks, and unhurried Atlantic light. The whole island is smaller than Manhattan, which means you can cover the highlights on foot, by bike, or in a tuk-tuk before your ship calls you back.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Larger cruise ships usually tender; smaller/expedition vessels berth alongside at the Porto de Abrigo breakwater in Vila Baleira.

Best For: Beach lovers, history buffs (Columbus connection), cycling, and anyone craving a crowd-free port.

Walk to centre: The commercial pier sits ~2 km from the town centre and main beach access — most cruisers take a shuttle, taxi, or short bike ride.

Don't Miss: The full 9 km beach walk, the Casa de Cristóvão Colombo museum, and a glass of local aguardente.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Porto Santo Golden Beach** — The island's famous 9 km crescent of fine golden sand is the main event.
- **Casa de Cristóvão Colombo (Columbus House Museum)** — Christopher Columbus lived on Porto Santo in the 1470s when he was married to Filipa Moniz, whose father was the...
- **Island Scooter or Bike Circuit** — Porto Santo's compact size makes it ideal for a self-guided circuit.
- **Pico do Castelo Hike** — A rewarding walk or short drive to the island's most prominent peak (437 m), topped by the ruins of a 16th-century...
- **Vila Baleira Town Walk** — The island's only town is quiet and pleasant — whitewashed houses, the Igreja Nossa Senhora da Piedade (one of the...

BEST WALKS

- **Beach Promenade Walk** Easy • 2-9 km • flat sand — Start at the pier end of the beach and walk east along the full golden crescent.
- **Town & Columbus Museum Loop** Easy • 1.5 km • flat — From the pier, walk to Largo do Pelourinho (the main square), visit the Columbus museum on Rua Cristóvão Colombo, then loop back via...

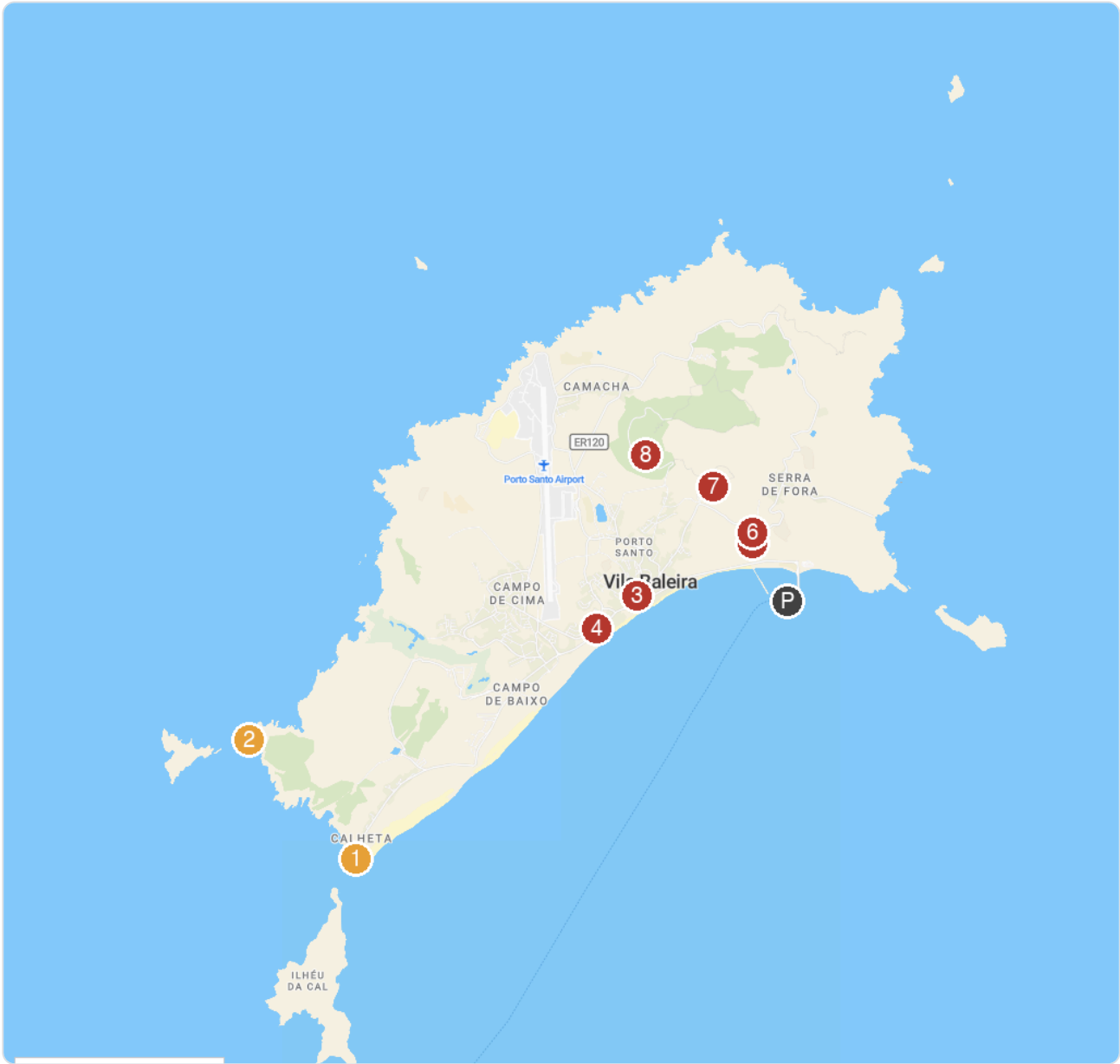
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
