GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Dvořák Embankment, right bank of the Vltava (small Elbe ships dock here; Danube ships arrive by coach from Nuremberg/Passau)

Walk to center: 5 min to Jewish Quarter, 10 min to Old Town Square, 15 min to Charles Bridge

Best For: History, architecture, beer culture, walkability

Don't Miss: Charles Bridge at dawn, Astronomical Clock hourly show, a cold Pilsner at a local pub

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Prague Castle & St. Vitus Cathedral** — Europe's largest ancient castle complex dominates the left bank skyline.
- **Jewish Quarter (Josefov)** — One of Europe's best-preserved Jewish heritage sites.
- **Klementinum Baroque Library Tour** — A guided tour through one of the world's most beautiful libraries — a floor-to-ceiling gilded Baroque hall — and up the...
- **Czech Beer & Food Experience** — The Czech Republic invented Pilsner.
- **Petřín Hill & Lookout Tower** — Ride the historic funicular up wooded Petřín Hill to a mini-Eiffel Tower offering the highest views in Prague.

BEST WALKS

- **River to Old Town Square** 1.2 km · 15 min · flat · free — From the Dvořák Embankment, walk south along the riverside past the grand Art Nouveau Hotel Intercontinental, through the upscale...
- **Charles Bridge Loop** 2.5 km · 30-40 min · mostly flat · free — From Old Town Square, follow Karlova Street to the Old Town Bridge Tower, cross Charles Bridge (lined with 30 Baroque saints), enter...
- **Castle District Self-Guide** 4 km · 2-3 hrs · hilly · free grounds, paid interiors — Take Tram 22 from Náměstí Republiky to the Pražský hrad stop (castle's back entrance, flat approach).

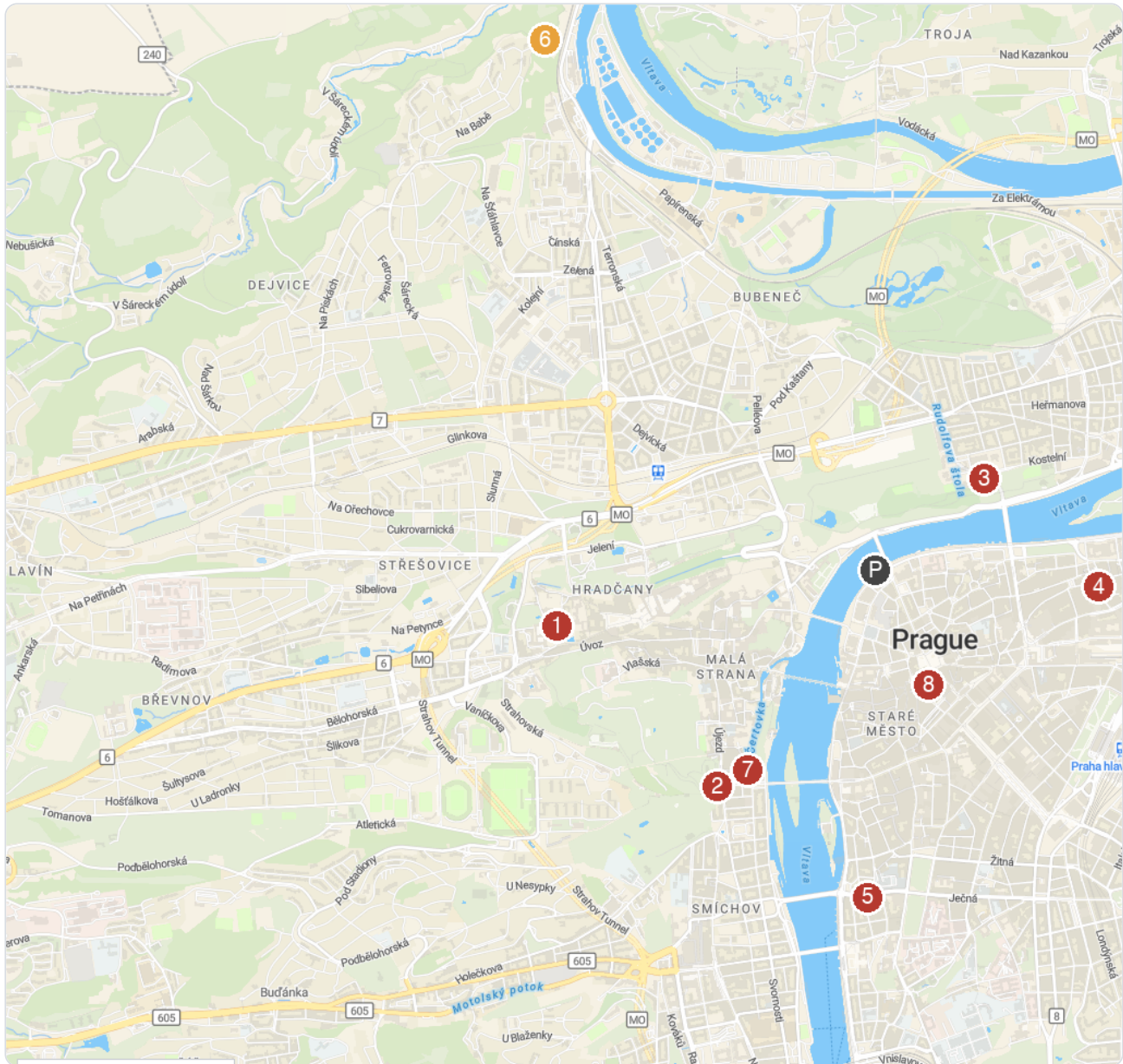
