BEST WALKS

- **The Plateau Loop** Historic Center — A loop around the historic Plateau district, visiting the Presidential Palace and colonial-era buildings.
- **Coastal Promenade** Ocean View — A walk along the waterfront, offering views of the Atlantic and the ships in the harbor.
- **Market Wander** Shopping — A stroll through Sucupira Market, exploring the local trade and culture.

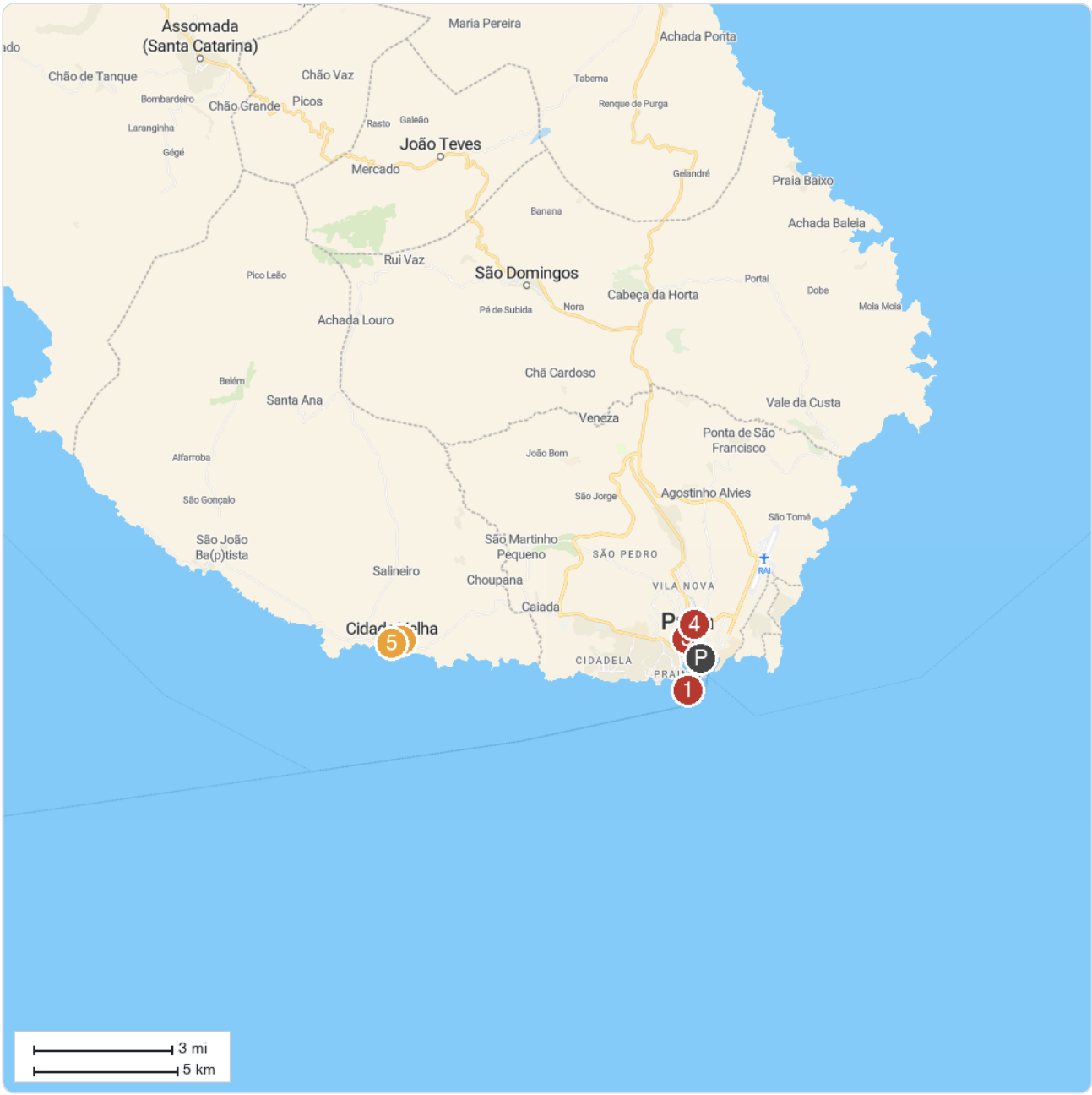
