Docking: Tender — ships anchor in the bay, tenders land on the Riva waterfront

Best For: Beaches, wine, wandering medieval alleys, photography

Walk to centre: 2 min from tender pier to Old Town gate

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Old Town & Church of St. George** — Wind through the medieval stone alleys of Stari Grad up to the 15th-century Church of St.
 - Mala & Velika Raduča Beaches** — Two pebble beaches flank the Old Town — Mala Raduča is 5 minutes from the tender pier; Velika Raduča offers pine shade...
- Babić Wine Tasting at Local Vineyards** — The stone-lace Bucavac vineyards outside town — tentative UNESCO World Heritage — produce the region's prized...
 - Krka National Park Day Trip** — Just 35 minutes by road, Krka's spectacular travertine waterfalls and emerald river pools are among Croatia's top...
 - Šibenik UNESCO Old Town** — A 30-minute drive brings you to Šibenik's Cathedral of St.

BEST WALKS

- Old Town Loop & St. George Viewpoint** 1.5 km · 30–45 min · Easy (some cobblestone inclines) — From the tender landing on the Riva, pass through the historic town gate and wind uphill through stone alleys to the Church of St.
- Raduča Peninsula Promenade** 2 km loop · 30 min · Easy — A shaded paved path encircles the forested Raduča peninsula just west of the Old Town, linking Mala Raduča and Velika Raduča beaches...

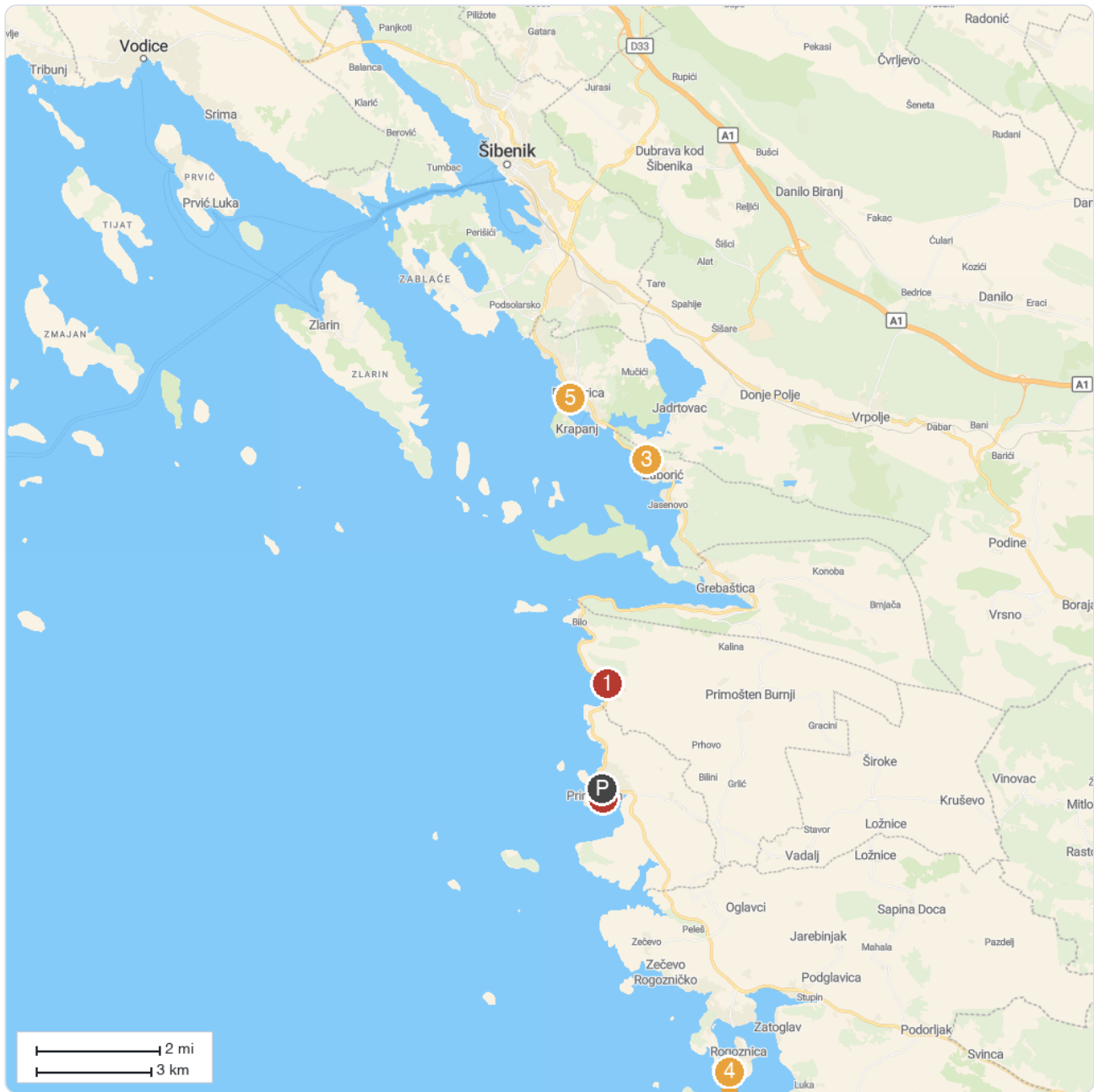
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Wear grippy shoes. The Old Town's polished limestone streets are beautiful but deceptively slippery — even when dry. Leave heels on the ship.
- Pebble beaches: Croatian beaches are almost all pebble, not sand. Pack water shoes or sandals for comfortable swimming.
