TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Khutzeymateen Grizzly Bear Sanctuary** — Canada's first protected grizzly habitat, accessible only by floatplane or boat.
- **Great Bear Rainforest by Rail & Road** — A scenic rail journey inland through old-growth rainforest combined with a road segment showcasing glacial valleys and...
- **Whale Watching & Marine Wildlife** — The nutrient-rich waters off Prince Rupert support humpback whales, orcas, Steller sea lions, and bald eagles.
- **North Pacific Cannery National Historic Site** — A remarkably intact 19th-century salmon cannery at Port Edward (~20 min south) that once employed 800 seasonal workers.
- **Museum of Northern BC & Totem Poles** — Housed in a longhouse-style building, this museum tells the story of the Ts'msyen (Tsimshian) Nation and Northwest...

BEST WALKS

- **Cow Bay Waterfront Stroll** 1 km · Easy · 20–30 min — Follow the Atlin Promenade from the cruise terminal along the waterfront into Cow Bay.
- **Downtown Totem Pole & Museum Walk** 2–3 km · Easy · 45–60 min — From Cow Bay, head inland to the Museum of Northern BC on First Avenue, then walk through downtown past several totem poles and...

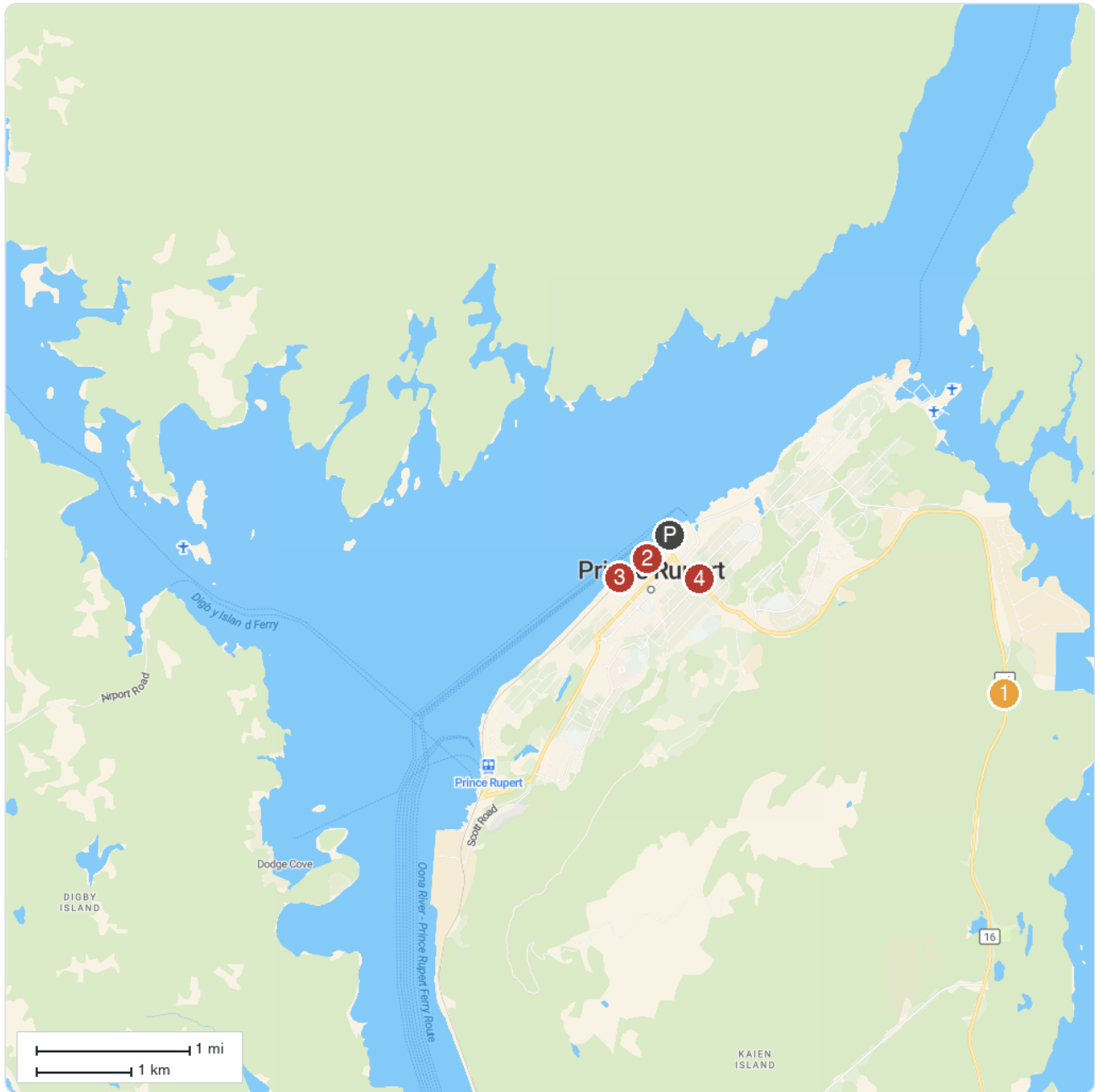
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
