GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Docked at the world's longest pier — about 8 km into the Gulf of Mexico

Best For: Mayan ruins, colonial Mérida, cenotes, authentic Mexican culture

Walk to center: Free shuttle bus ~15 min to town; pier cannot be walked

Don't Miss: Cochinita pibil tacos and the Malecón boardwalk

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Colonial Mérida Day** — Catch the AutoProgreso bus (~55 min) into the White City — stroll Plaza Grande, visit the Governor's Palace murals...
 - **Uxmal Mayan Ruins** — One of Mexico's most beautiful Mayan sites — the towering Pyramid of the Magician is extraordinary.
- **Dzibilchaltún Ruins & Cenote Xlacah** — The closest ruins to Progreso (~25 min).
 - **El Corchito Cenotes & Mangroves** — A short taxi from town, this local cooperative runs boat rides through mangrove channels to three swimming cenotes in a...
 - **Xtampú Pink Salt Lakes & Xcambó Ruins** — About 30 minutes east, the Xtampú salt flats turn a vivid pink from algae — spectacular for photos.

BEST WALKS

- **Malecón & Town Center Walk** 1.5 km · Flat · 30–45 min — From the AutoProgreso terminal, walk three blocks south to the waterfront Malecón boardwalk.
- **Callejón del Amor & Beach Clubs** 1 km · Flat · 20 min — Head east along Calle 19 from the main pier drop to find the colorful Callejón del Amor mural alley — a popular photo stop.

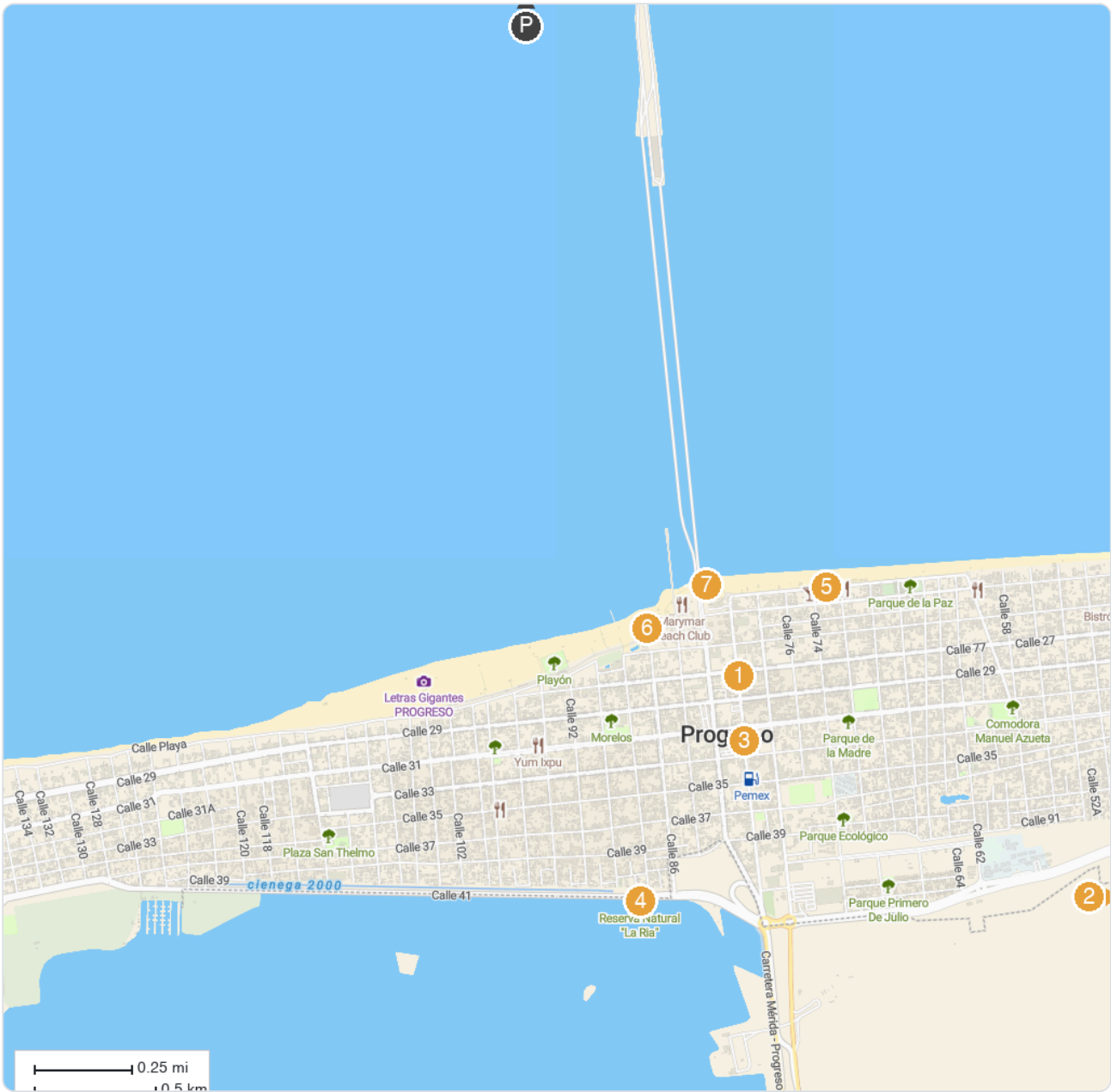
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Add 30–45 min buffer: The 6.5 km pier creates a real bottleneck getting back to the ship. Miss the shuttle window and you'll be swimming.
- Use pesos: USD is accepted everywhere but you'll get significantly better prices at markets, taxis, and food stalls paying in pesos.
