Docking: Tender to MacMillan Pier (most ships); small coastal vessels can dock directly

Walk to center: 1 min — Commercial Street begins at the pier head

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Whale Watch** — Stellwagen Bank National Marine Sanctuary lies just offshore and delivers near-100% sighting rates for humpbacks...
 - Art's Dune Tours** — Off-road vehicles take you into the protected Cape Cod National Seashore dunes, passing historic shacks once used by...
 - Pilgrim Monument & Museum** — The 252-foot granite tower — the tallest all-granite structure in the USA — marks
- where the Mayflower Pilgrims first...

 - Race Point & Herring Cove Beaches** — Race Point faces the open Atlantic — wild surf, seals, and the Race Point Lighthouse.
 - Commercial Street Gallery Walk** — America's oldest continuous art colony fills Commercial Street's East End with dozens of galleries showcasing painters...

BEST WALKS

- Commercial Street End-to-End** 2–3 hrs | Flat | ~1.5 miles one way — Start at the pier entrance and walk Commercial Street west to east.
- Pilgrim Monument Loop** 45 min | Easy–Moderate | 0.5-mile walk + climb — Walk up Bradford Street from the pier to the Pilgrim Monument.

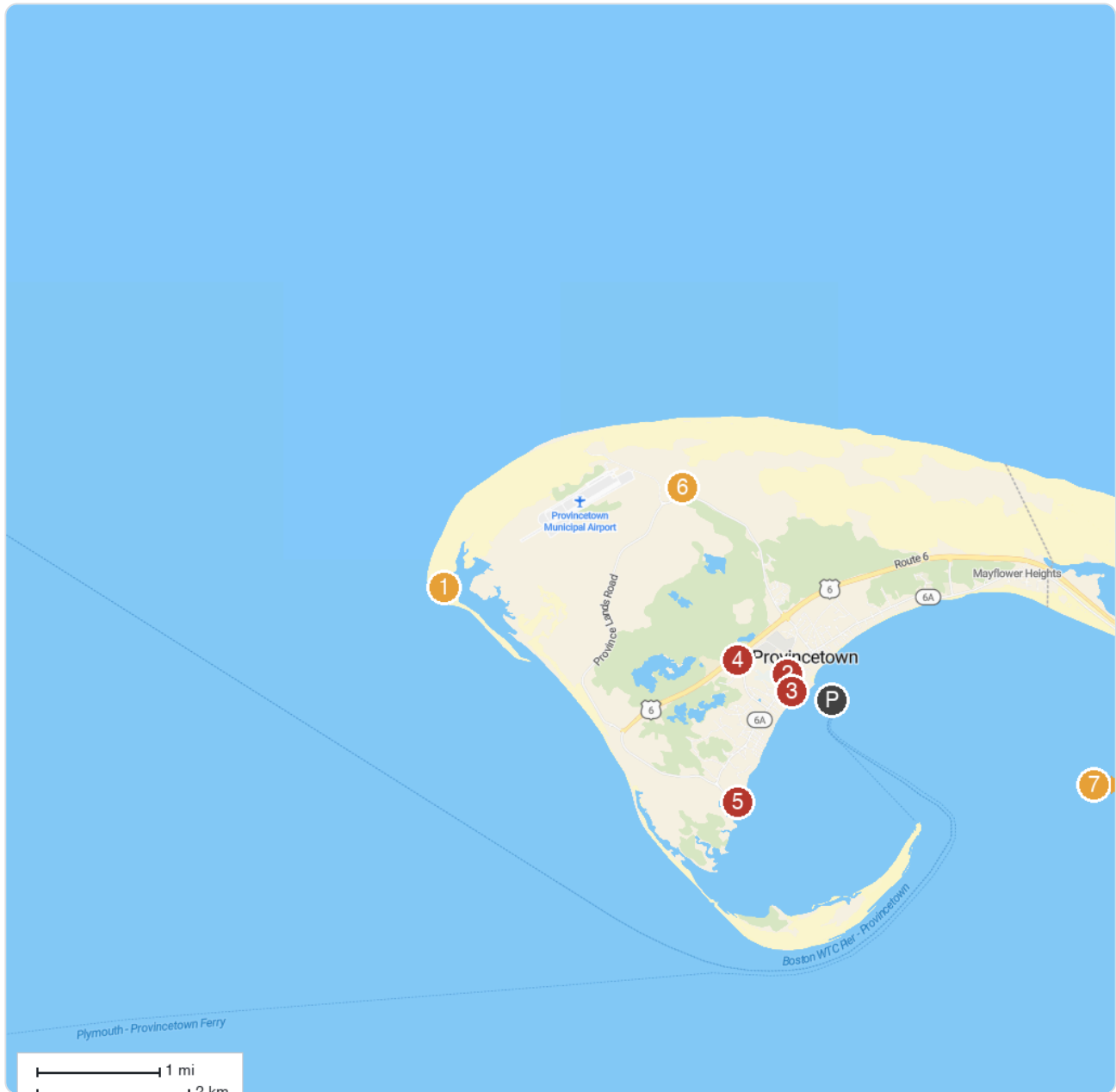
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
